

29-210-8 Cabled Vest

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Junmo Namibuto2 [100% merino wool; 78.7yds/72m per 1.41 oz / 40g skein];
 - color #2 ivory; 5 skeins [180g]
 - color #16 deep navy blue; 1 skein [10g]
 - color #20 deep red; 1 skein [10g]
- 3.9mm and 4.2mm knitting needles (US 6 and 7 are the closest equivalents) or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.9mm double-pointed needles (US 6 is the closest equivalent) or size necessary to achieve gauge

Gauge

- in 10cm/4" square with larger needles:
 - 21 st and 26 rows in stockinette stitch
 - 26 st and 26 rows in pattern stitch

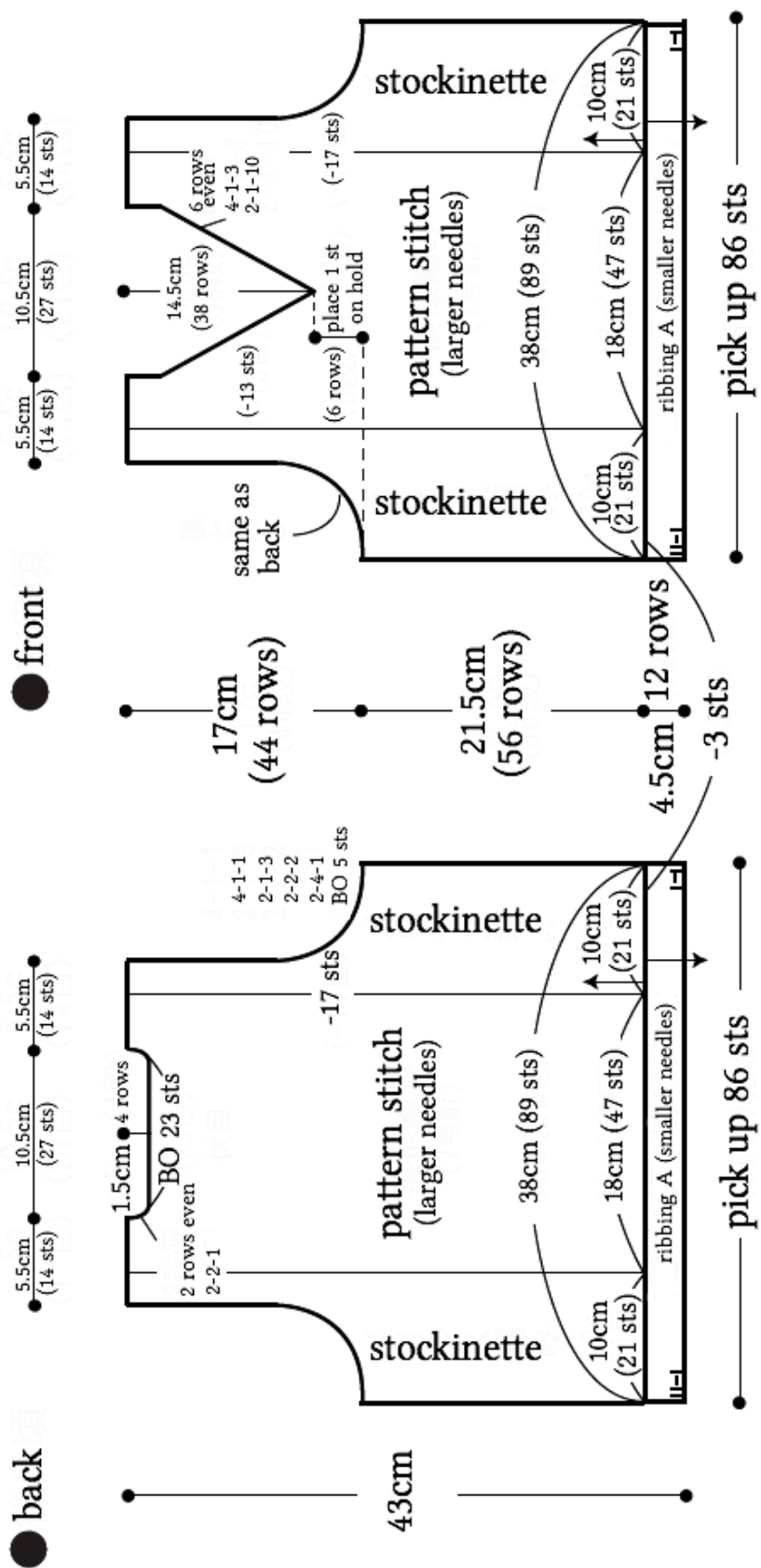
Finished measurements

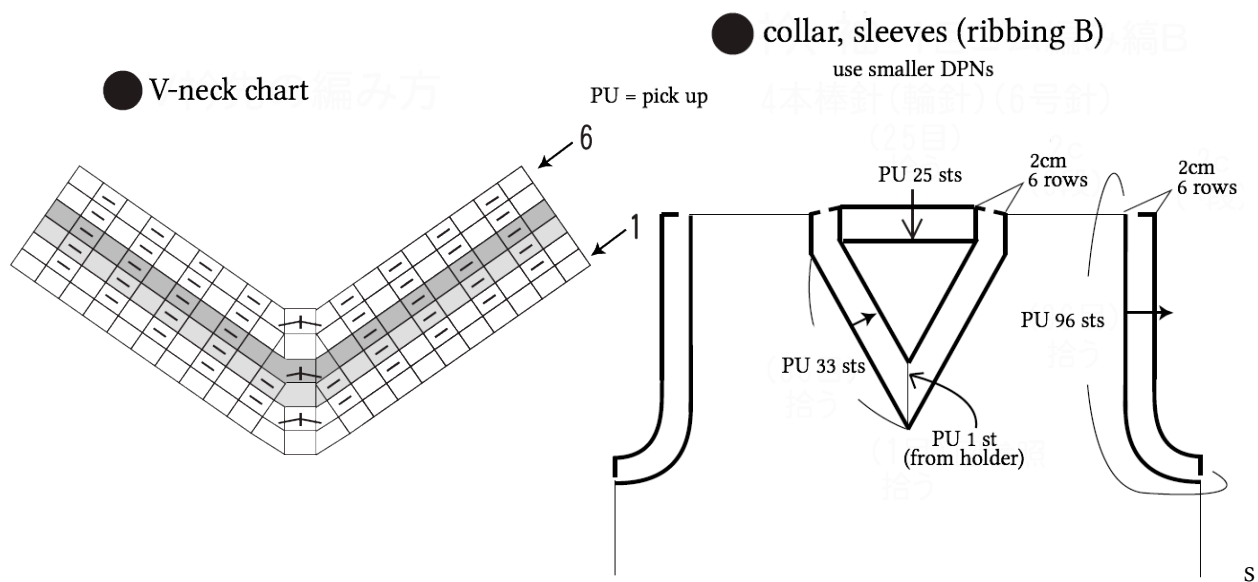
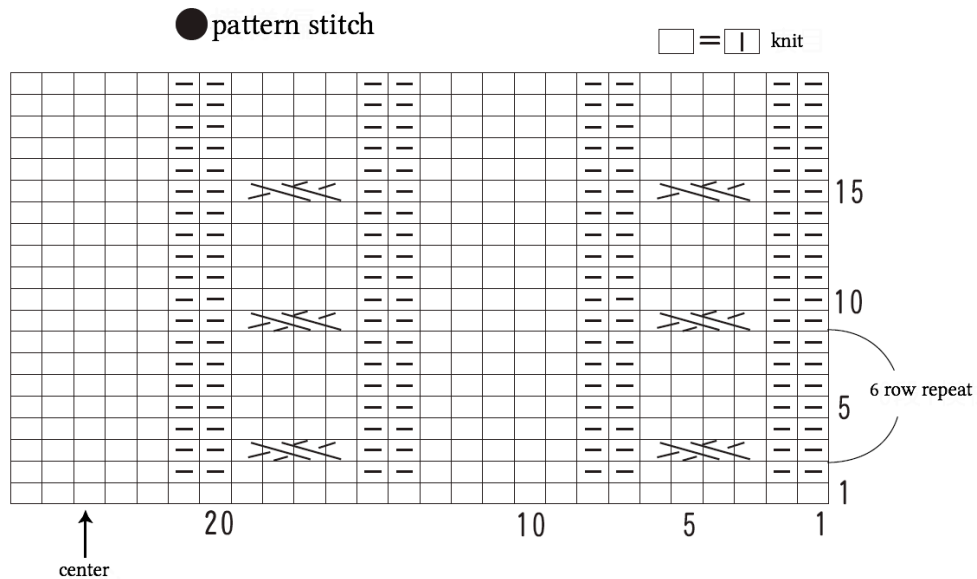
- chest 76cm/29.9"
- back width 25.5cm/10"
- back length 43cm/16.9"

Knitting Tips

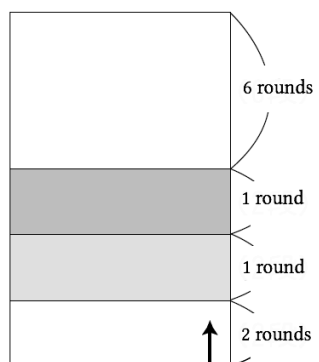
Body: Use crochet provisional cast on. Begin knitting according to chart, with stockinette and pattern stitch. Work armhole shaping by binding off stitches, then decreasing according to chart. Place the center neckline stitch of front piece onto a stitch holder, dividing front into left and right sides. Work neckline decreases according to chart.

Finishing: Pick up live stitches from provisional cast on edge and work ribbing A. Join shoulders by placing pieces with right sides together and working slip stitch through all stitches along edge. Join sides using mattress stitch. Work edging B around armholes and neckline according to chart. See special chart for V-neck shaping.
