22-23-17 Fluid Waves Sweater

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Super Kid Mohair [75% kid mohair; 25% nylon; 306 yds / 280m per 0.88 oz. / 25g skein]; color #5807; 4 skeins [100g] *discontinued*
- Pierrot Yarns Silk Lamb Wool Lace [70% wool; 30% silk; 208 yds / 190m per 0.88 oz. / 25g skein]; color #7363; 12 skeins [285g] *discontinued*
- 3.9mm straight knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge; US 6 is the closest equivalent
- 3.6mm circular knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge; US 4 or 5 is the closest equivalent

Gauge

• pattern stitch: 28 sts and 33 rows in 10cm/4" square

Finished measurements

- bust 96cm/37.8"
- back width 35cm/13.8"
- length 53cm/20.9"
- sleeve length 53cm/20.9"

Knitting Tips

♦Note that the entire garment is worked with one strand of Super Kid Mohair and two strands of Silk Lamb Wool Lace held together (total: three strands).

Body and Sleeves: Cast on using crochet provisional cast on method. Knit in pattern stitch according to chart. In order to allow for complete pattern repeats in sleeves, work left and right sleeve sides in k2p2 ribbing and middle in pattern stitch as indicated in schematic.

Collar: Pick up stitches and work k2p2 ribbing, taking care that ribbing pattern aligns with pattern already established in front and back stitches on hold. Bind off all stitches in pattern.

Finishing: Pick up stitches around hem and sleeve cuffs and work one row of k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern. Join shoulders with three-needle bind-off, and seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Join sleeves to body with slip stitch.
