

27-28-779M Sparkling Snow Mittens

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns ett [100% merino wool; 82 yds / 75m per 0.88 oz. / 25g skein];
 - color #8 aqua mint; 2 skeins [40g]
 - color #7 pale gray; 1 skein [20g]
 - color #1 ivory; 1 skein [10g]
- 2.7mm (US 2) and 3.0mm (US 2½) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 4 big buttons (18mm / approx. ¾")
- 4 small buttons (8mm / approx. 0.31")
- 30 heart-shaped sequins (6mm / approx. ¼")
- 30 small round beads (clear)

Gauge

Gauge is measured in a swatch 10cm/4" square.

- stockinette stitch: 27 sts and 40 rows

Finished measurements

- hand circumference 18cm/7.1"

Knitting Tips

Body of mittens: With smaller needles and color #7, cast on 50 stitches. Join into ring and work 10 rounds of k1p1 ribbing. Change to larger needles and knit one round of stockinette. Change to color #8 and knit 21 rounds of stockinette. Knit 8 stitches on next round with waste yarn (this will be used for thumb later). Continue through round 40 with color #8, then knit one round with color #7. Change to smaller needles and knit 9 rounds of k1p1 ribbing, then bind off in pattern.

Removable mitten caps: With smaller needles and color #7, cast on 50 stitches and join to knit in the round. Knit 10 rounds of k1p1 ribbing followed by one round of stockinette. Change to color #7 and knit 20 rounds of stockinette. Decrease on rounds 20 to 25. Graft remaining 26 stitches.

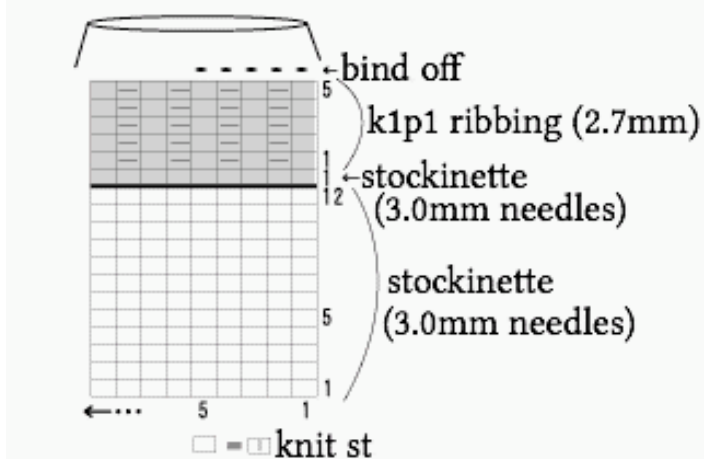

- Knit Stitches:** A row of **k1p1** (knit 1, purl 1) stitches is indicated by a horizontal line across the bottom section.

First row: from the hole created with waste yarn for the thumb, pick up 9 stitches from the bottom and 8 stitches from the top, for a total of 17 stitches. Join to work in the round.
