Hooded Raglan Cardigan

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Coloring Color [75% acrylic, 25% wool; 87 yds / 80m per 1.41 oz. / 40g skein]; color #199 gray; 10 skeins [400g]
- 3.9mm (US 6 and 4.5mm (US 7) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3 buttons (25mm / 1")

Gauge

• stockinette stitch: 16 sts and 21 rows = 10cm/4" square

Finished measurements

- bust 99.5cm/39.2"
- length 50cm/19.7"
- center back neck-to-cuff 39.5cm/15.6"
- hood depth 30cm/11.8"

Knitting Tips


Body: Cast on using tubular 1x1 ribbing cast on. Knit in reverse stockinette stitch with strips of pattern stitch A at front. At raglan seams, work fully fashioned decreases 2 stitches in from edge.


Sleeves: Cast on using long-tail cast-on and knit in reverse stockinette stitch. Work decreases along sleeve seam 1 stitch in from edge. Work strip of pattern stitch B for sleeve cuffs, then seam to sleeve using row-to-stitch mattress stitch.


Hood: Cast on 5 sts using long-tail cast-on. Knit in reverse stockinette stitch. Use backwards loop cast-on for increases. Make right and left sides in mirror image, then join using Kitchener stitch.

Finishing: Join body and sleeve top with Kitchener stitch. Join raglan seams with mattress stitch. Join sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around front edge (right front, hood edge, left front) and knit k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.


Abbreviations: CO = cast on; BO = bind off; RE = row(s) even; OH = on hold.
