

amicomo6-1 Openwork Gilet

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Beauty Silk Cotton [90% mohair, 10% silk; 180 yds / 165m per 1.06 oz. / 30g skein]; color #11 violet brown; 6 skeins [160g]
- 3.9mm (US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Gauge

- pattern stitch: 19 sts and 28 rows = 10cm/4" square

Finished measurements

- back width 35cm/13.8"
- length 35.5cm/14.0"

Knitting Tips

❖ **Note:** entire garment is worked with two strands of yarn held together.

Right and back front, back yoke: Cast on using long-tail cast-on and knit right front in pattern stitch. To start back yoke, slip 16 stitches, then bind off remaining stitches. Knit 98 rows for back yoke, chain 67 stitches to cast on for left front, then knit left front in pattern stitch. Work single crochet (US) edging on left and right front edges.

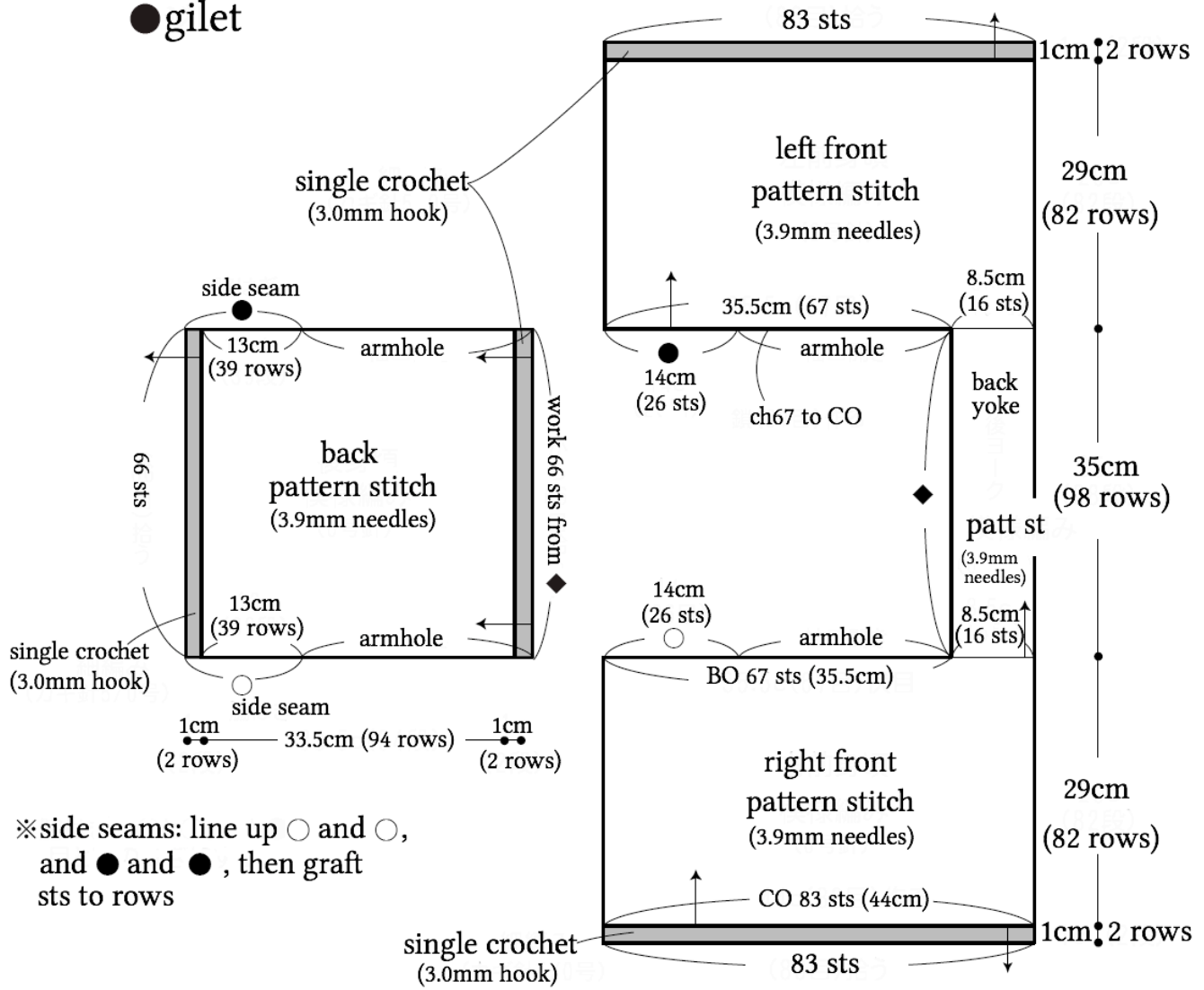
Back: Work single crochet from back yoke, then knit in pattern stitch as indicated. Work single crochet edging, then graft sides (stitches-to-rows).

Abbreviations: BO = bind off; CO = cast on
