Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Silk100 Fingering [100% silk; 344 yds/ 315m per 1.76 oz. / 50g skein]; color #6021 crimson; 5 cones [220g]
- 2.3mm (US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Gauge

- pattern stitch A: 29.5 sts and 10 rows = 10cm/4" square
- pattern stitch B: 29.5 sts and 11 rows = 10cm/4" square
- pattern stitch C (base): 1 pattern repeat = 3.8cm/1.5" wide and 13 rows = 10cm/4" tall

Finished measurements


- bust 90cm/35.4"
- cross back width 35cm/13.8"
- length 70.5cm/27.8"
- sleeve length 20cm/7.9"


Crochet Tips


Body: Chain to cast on; crochet upper body of garment in pattern stitch A. Working into the bottom loops of the cast-on row, work lower body of garment in pattern stitch B and C. Crochet sleeves first in pattern stitch A, then pattern stitch B.

Finishing: Join shoulder seams with woven seam. Join sides and sleeve undersides with single crochet seam. Work edging A around hem and cuffs, and edging B around neckline.


