

Crochet Tunic

Materials

- Keito-Zakka Stores Merino Warm Fingering [50% merino wool, 50% other wool; 164 yds/ 150m per 1.41 oz. / 40g skein]; color #26 wine; 5 skeins [200g]
- 3.0mm (US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Gauge

- pattern stitch A: 22 sts and 10.5 rows = 10cm/4" square
- pattern stitch B: 23.5 sts and 11 rows = 10cm/4" square

Finished measurements

- cross back width 30cm/11.8"
- length 63.5cm/25"

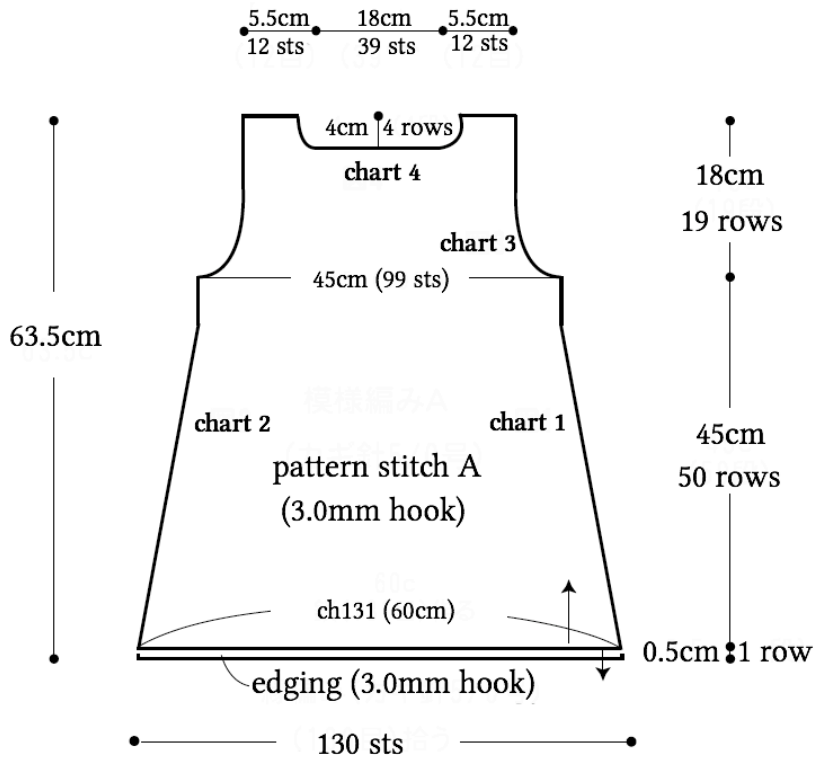
Crochet Tips

Back: Chain 131 and work pattern stitch A according to schematics.

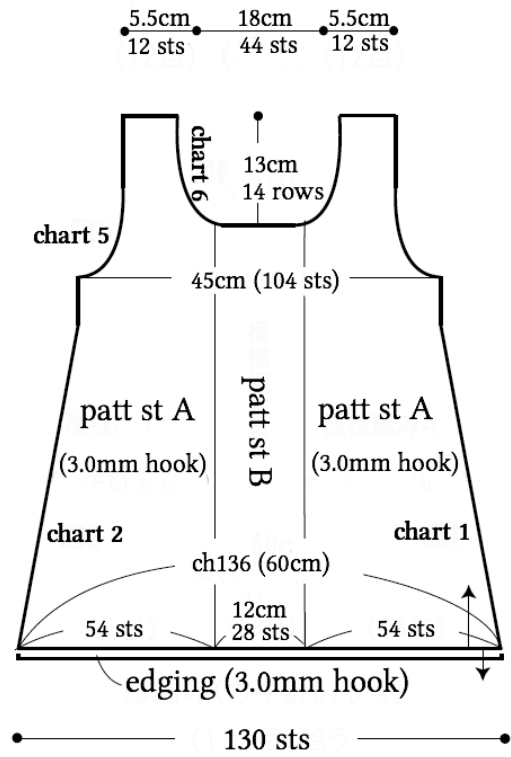
Front: Chain 136 and work pattern stitch A and B according to schematics.

Finishing: Join shoulders with woven seam, and join sides with single crochet. Crochet edging around hem, armholes, and neckline. Crochet edging along the front post double crochet (US) stitches that form the sides of the front center panel (pattern stitch B).

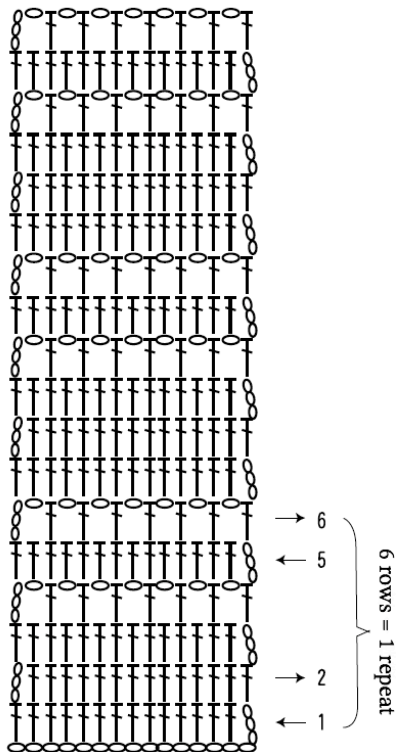
●back



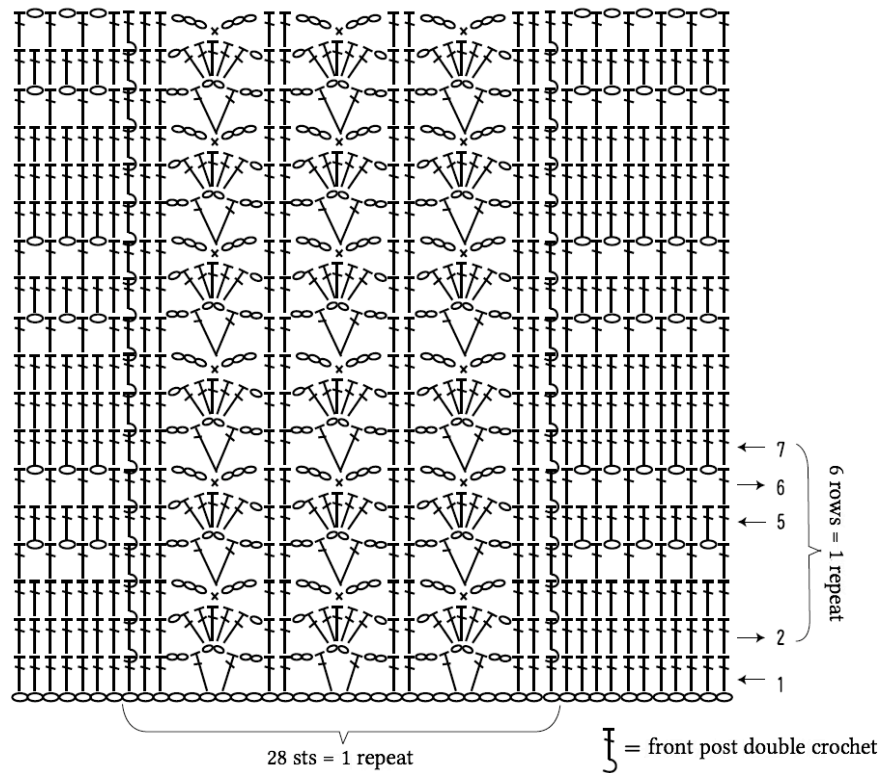
●front



●pattern stitch A



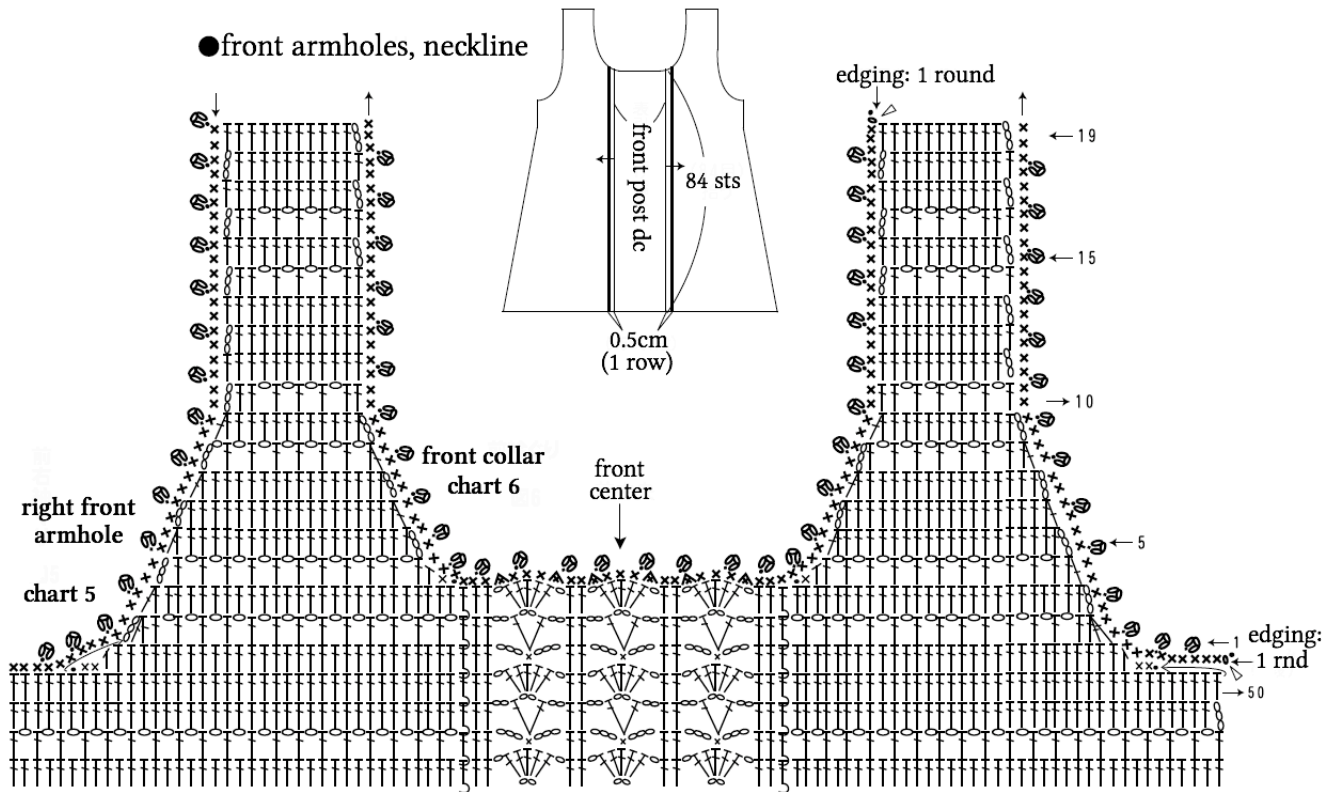
●pattern stitch B



●edging for front center panel

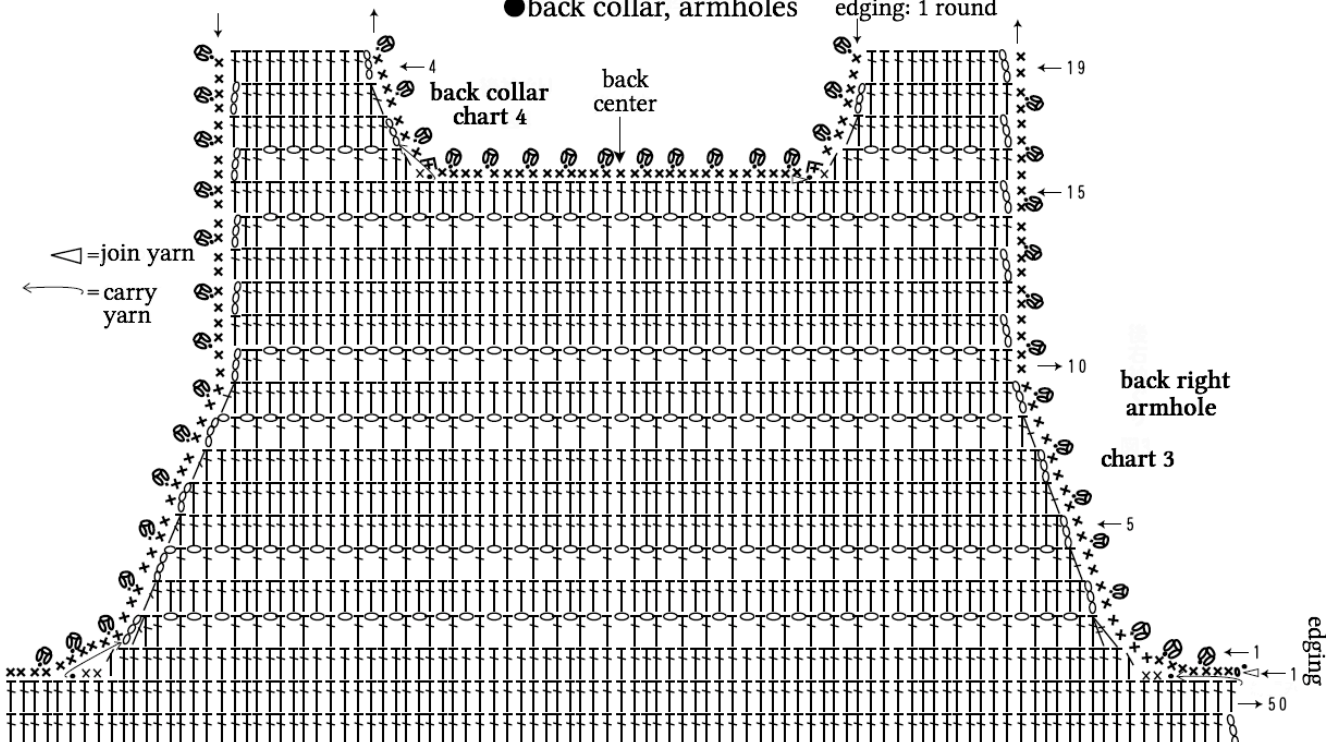
(3.0mm hook)
