

20-21-19 Long-sleeve Lace Cardigan

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns My Cotton S [100% cotton; 166 yds / 152m per 1.41 oz. / 40g skein]; color #F09 brown; 9 skeins [340g] – *This yarn has been discontinued. Pierrot Yarns suggests Sawayaka Cotton as a substitute.*
- **machine knitting:** standard gauge knitting machine (4.5mm pitch) with punchcard capabilities and lace carriage
 - tension setting (T) = 3.2
- **hand knitting:** 3.3mm (US 3) knitting needle or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.0mm crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge (US B is the closest equivalent)
- 6 buttons (13mm / approx. ½")

Gauge

- pattern stitch: 31 sts and 50 rows = 10cm/4" square

Finished measurements

- bust 96cm/37.8"
- cross back width 36cm/14.2"
- length 55cm/21.7"
- sleeve length 53cm/20.9"

Machine knitting

Body, sleeves: Cast on with waste yarn. Knit in pattern stitch. Knit right front; reverse shaping for left front. Work all increases and decreases fully fashioned one stitch in from the edge.

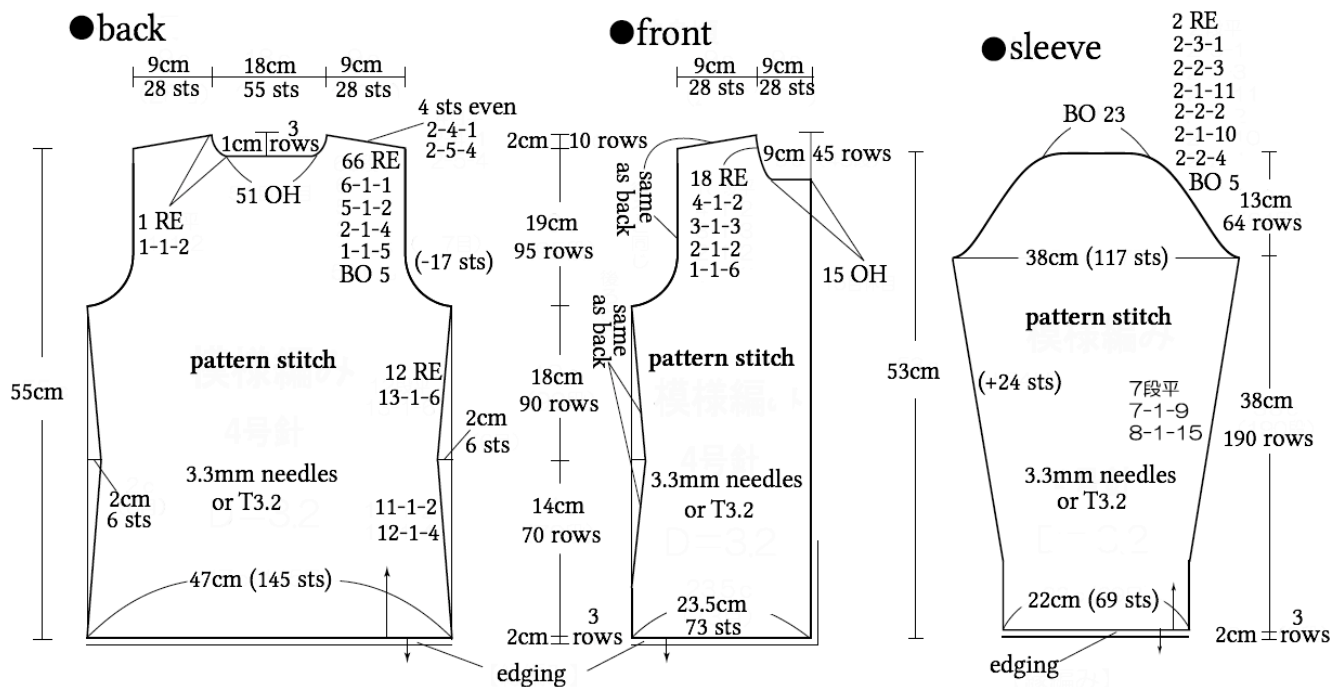
Finishing: With right sides facing, hang shoulders on needles and knit one row. Bind off. Seam sides and sleeves with mattress stitch. Crochet edging around hem, front edges, and neckline. Work buttonholes in edging on right front. Join sleeves to body using slip stitch.

Hand knitting

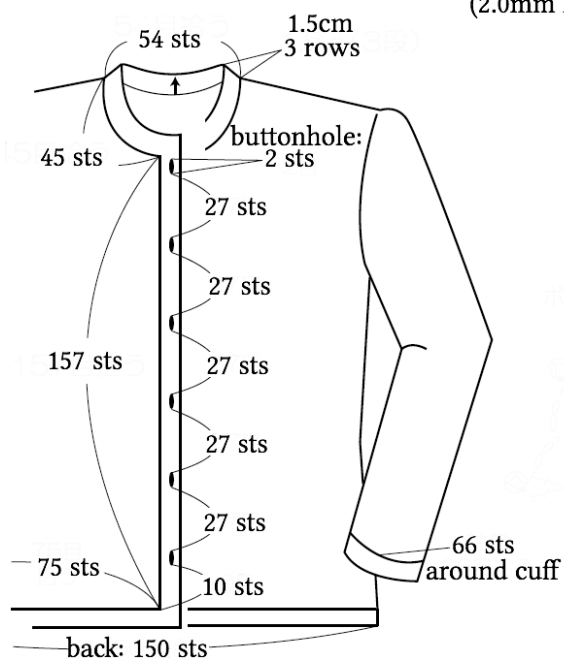
Body, sleeves: Cast on with provisional cast on method. Knit in pattern stitch.

Finishing: Join shoulders with slip stitch. The rest of the finishing steps are the same as for machine knitting.

Abbreviations: BO = bind off; T = tension dial; RE = row(s) even; OH = on hold

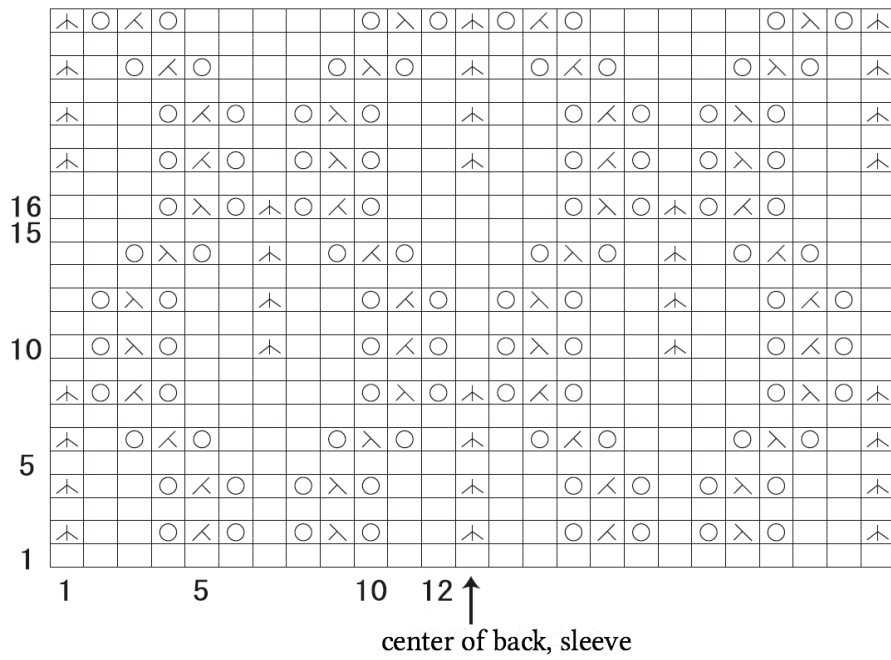


●edging for hem, front edges, collar (2.0mm hook)

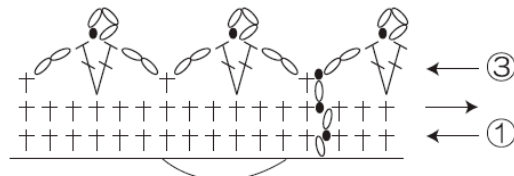


●pattern stitch

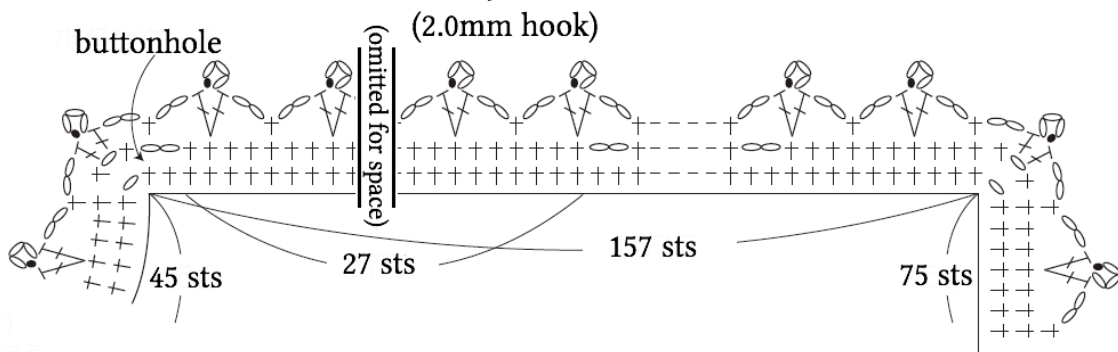
□ = □ knit stitch
