- Pierrot Yarns Tre [100% cotton; 98 yds/ 90m per 1.06 oz./ 30g skein];
 - o small (110cm size):
 - color #2 vanilla cream; 2 skeins [60g]
 - color #3 honey apricot; 5 skeins [130g]
 - o large (130cm size):
 - color #2 vanilla cream; 3 skeins [80g]
 - color #4 brown sugar; 6 skeins [165g]
- 3.3mm (US 3) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge



Gauge

Gauge is measured in a swatch 10cm/4" square.

- pattern stitch A: 29 sts and 29 rows
- pattern stitch B: 24 sts and 14 rows

Finished measurements

Japanese children's clothing sizes are based on the child's height in centimeters. 110cm size (43.3") and 130cm size (51.2") correspond roughly to US children's sizes 4 and 7.

- small (110cm/43.3" size):
 - o chest 74cm/29.1"
 - o cross back width 27cm/10.6"
 - o length 47.5cm/18.7"

- large (130cm/51.2" size):
 - o chest 80cm/31.5"
 - o cross back width 30cm/11.8"
 - o length 57cm/22.4"


Knitting Tips


Body: Cast on with provisional cast-on and knit back of skirt in pattern stitch A (stripes). Bind off loosely in pattern. Repeat for front of skirt. Pick up stitches from provisional cast-on edge and knit two rows, decreasing as indicated. Bind off loosely in pattern. Crochet bodice in pattern stitch B upward from bound-off knitted edge. Repeat for front of garment.


Finishing: Seam sides of knitted skirt portion with mattress stitch. Seam crocheted underarm portion with slip stitch and single crochet (US) as follows: work 1 sc into any chain or sc, but sl st across sides of double crochet (US) or other long stitches. Use as many sl sts as necessary to have a firm but not puckered seam (for example, 3 sl st along the side of one dc). Join shoulders with same method. Crochet edging A around hem. Work 2 rows of single crochet (US) at back placket. Crochet edging B around neckline and armholes. Crochet button and button loop and attach to dress.

Abbreviations: CO = cast on; BO = bind off; PU = pick up; rep = repeat(s)


