21-22-12 Smocked Sweater

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Junmo Namibuto2 [100% superwash wool; 79 yds/72m per 1.41 oz. / 40g skein]; color #25 pink; 7 skeins [270g]
- 4.2mm knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge (US 6 is the closest equivalent)
- 3.0mm (US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Gauge

- stockinette stitch: 17 sts and 26 rows = 10cm/4" square
- pattern stitch: 21 sts and 26 rows = 10cm/4" square

Finished measurements

- bust 94cm/37.0"
- cross back width 32cm/12.6"
- length 56cm/22.0"


Knitting Tips

Body: Cast on and knit according to schematics with central panel in pattern stitch. Work fully fashioned (one stitch in from edge) decreases and increases at sides for waist shaping. For armholes and neckline, bind off and decrease (one stitch in from edge) as indicated.

Finishing: Join shoulders with slip stitch, and join sides with mattress stitch. Crochet edging around hem, armholes, and neckline.

Abbreviations: BO = bind off; RE = row(s) even
