

# 26-11 Sheer Vest

## **Materials**

- Pierrot Yarns Cutie Mohair [30% nylon, 28% mohair, 28% acrylic, 14% superwash wool; 339 yds/310m per 0.88 oz./25g skein]; color #27 French gray; 3 skeins [60g]
- 3.6mm (US 4 or 5) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.6mm (US 4 or 5) circular knitting needle or size necessary to achieve gauge

## **Gauge**

Gauge is measured in a swatch 10cm/4" square.

- stockinette stitch: 20 sts and 26 rows

## **Finished measurements**

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- cross back width 35cm/13.78"
- length 54cm/21.26"

## **Knitting Tips**

**Body and armholes:** Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method and knit in stockinette stitch. Shape armholes and neckline by binding off stitches and working fully fashioned decreases (1 stitch in from edge). Shape shoulders with short rows. Pick up stitches from provisional cast-on edge at hem and knit in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.


**Finishing:** Join shoulders with three-needle bind-off. Join sides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline and armholes; knit in k1p1 ribbing in the round.

❖ **Note:** entire garment is knit with two strands of yarn held together.

**Abbreviations:** BO = bind off; PU = pick up; RE = row(s) even; rnd(s) = round(s)
