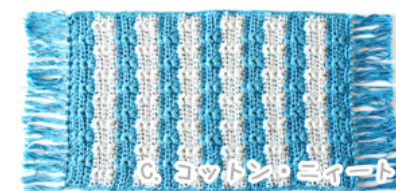


# 29-46 Floor Mat

## Materials

- **version A:** Pierrot Yarns Basic Cotton [100% cotton; 60 yds/55m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
  - CC: color #1 white milk; 5 skeins [130g]
  - MC: color #3 chocolate brown; 6 skeins [170g]
- **version B:** Pierrot Yarns Pastel Color Nep [40% rayon, 39% linen, 21% cotton; 54.7yds/50m per 1.23 oz./35g skein];
  - CC: color #8 pale speckled green; 5 skeins [205g]
  - MC: color #9 beige; 4 skeins [160g]
- **version C:** Pierrot Yarns Cotton Neat [100% cotton; 58 yds/53m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
  - CC: color #602 light blue; 5 skeins [180g]
  - MC: color #605 blue; 6 skeins [240g]
- **version A:** 4.0mm (US G) crochet hook *or size necessary to achieve gauge*; **versions B and C:** 5.0mm (US H) crochet hook *or size necessary to achieve gauge*

## Gauge

Gauge measured in a swatch 10cm/4" square.

- version A: 11 sts and 7 rows in pattern stitch
- version B: 10.5 sts and 7 rows in pattern stitch
- version C: 10.5 sts and 7 rows in pattern stitch

## Finished measurements

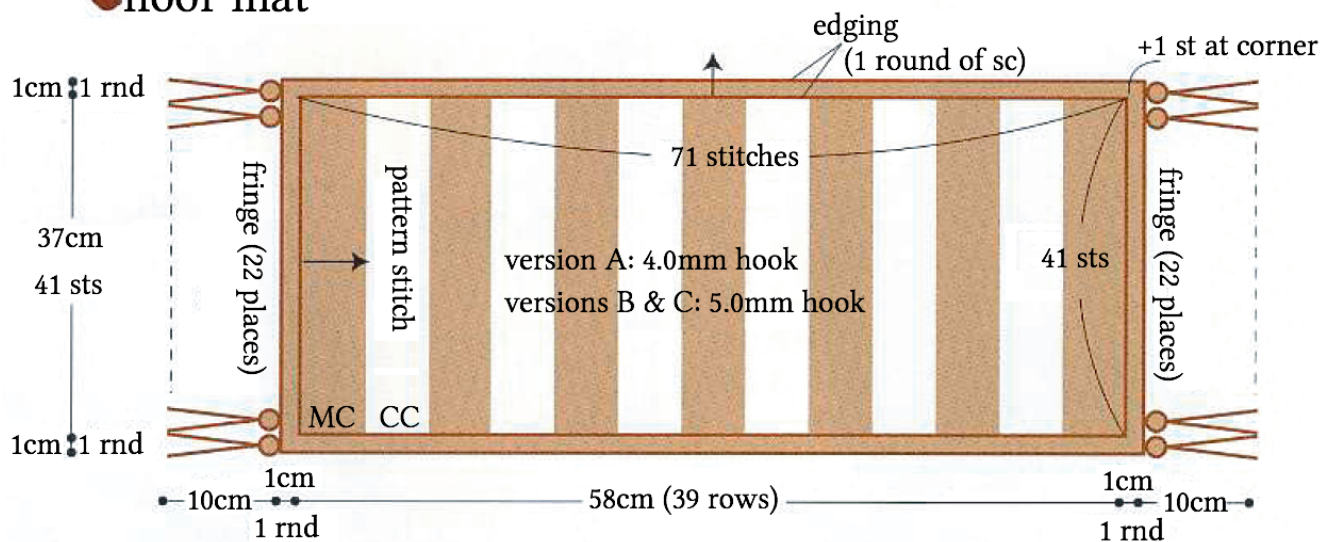
- version A: width 80cm/31.50", height 39cm/15.35"
- version B: width 80cm/31.50", height 42cm/16.54"
- version C: width 80cm/31.50", height 42cm/16.54"

## Crochet Tips

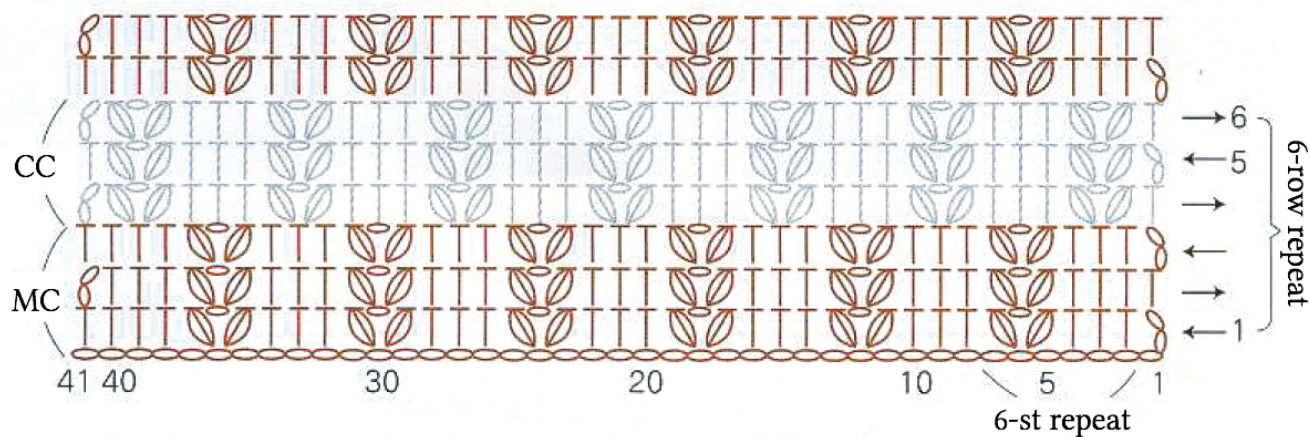
With MC, ch41 to cast on. Crochet in pattern stitch, changing colors every three rows. Work one round of single crochet (US) around edges. Attach fringe in 22 places on both ends.

**\*Note:** all three versions are worked with two strands of yarn held together.

● fringe: fold 4 lengths (each 24cm) of MC in half; attach to L and R edges of mat

## ● color sequences

| MC=              | col.3   | CC= | col.1   |
| Pastel Color Nep |         |     |         |
| MC=              | col.8   | CC= | col.9   |
| Cotton Neat      |         |     |         |
| MC=              | col.605 | CC= | col.602 |
