

26-49 Tunisian Crochet Scarf

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Pure Cashmere 100 [100% cashmere; 79 yds/72m per 0.71 oz./20g skein];
 - version A (black): color #8 black; 3 skeins [60g]
 - version B (white): color #1 ivory; 3 skeins [60g]
- Pierrot Yarns Standard Lace [100% polyester; 891 yds/815m per 1.76 oz./50g cone];
 - either version: color #5102 silver lamé; 1 cone [15g]
- 3.9mm (approx. US G) Tunisian crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Gauge

- pattern stitch: 17.5 sts and 14 rows = 10cm/4" square

Finished measurements

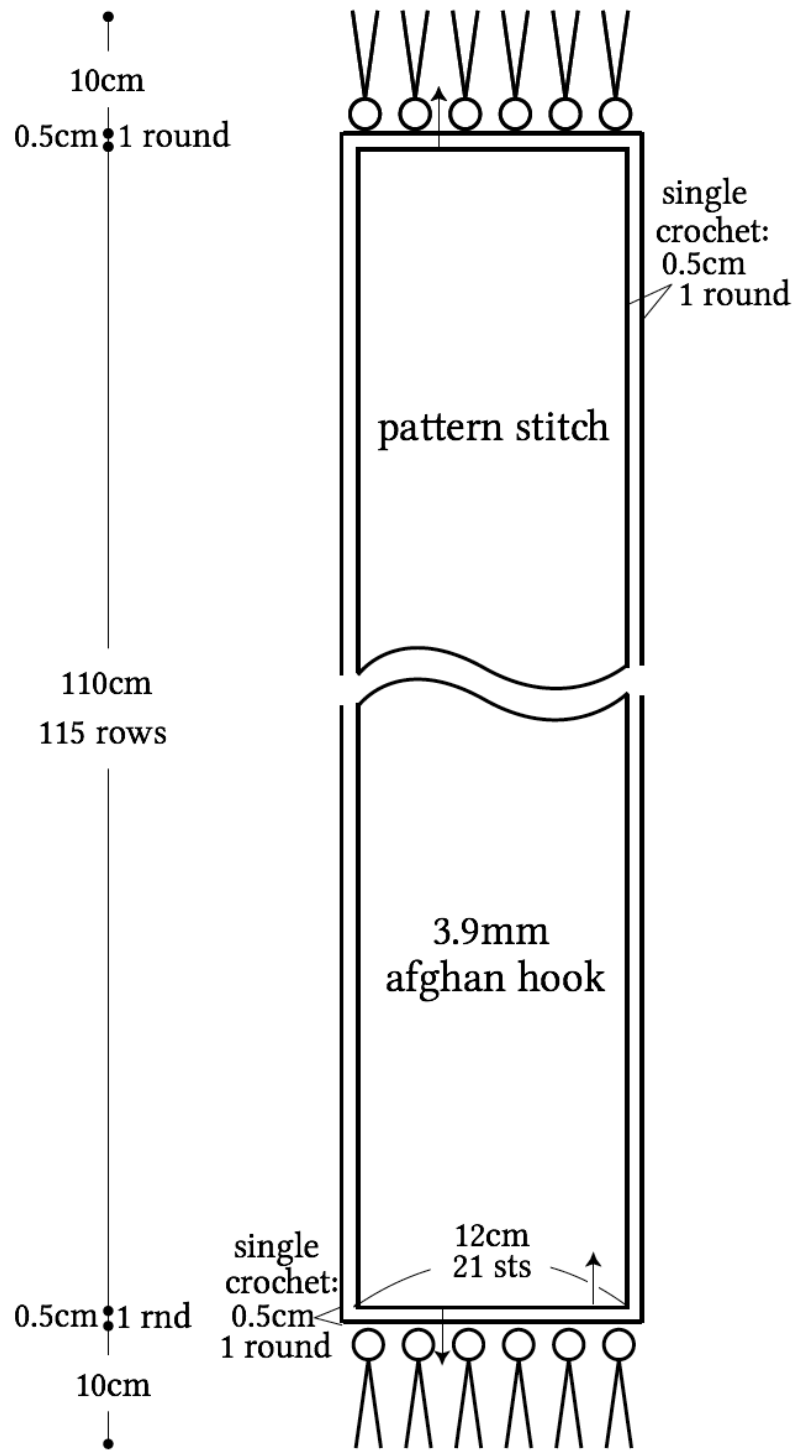
- width 13cm/5.12"
- length 131cm/51.57"

Crochet Tips

Chain to cast on and begin crocheting, working first row into bottom loops of chain. Because the yarn is thin, when working the return pass (i.e., when working left-to-right), take care not to pull the yarn too tightly. When finished, bind off in pattern. Crochet one round of single crochet around all edges of scarf. Attach fringe in 6 places on each short edge.

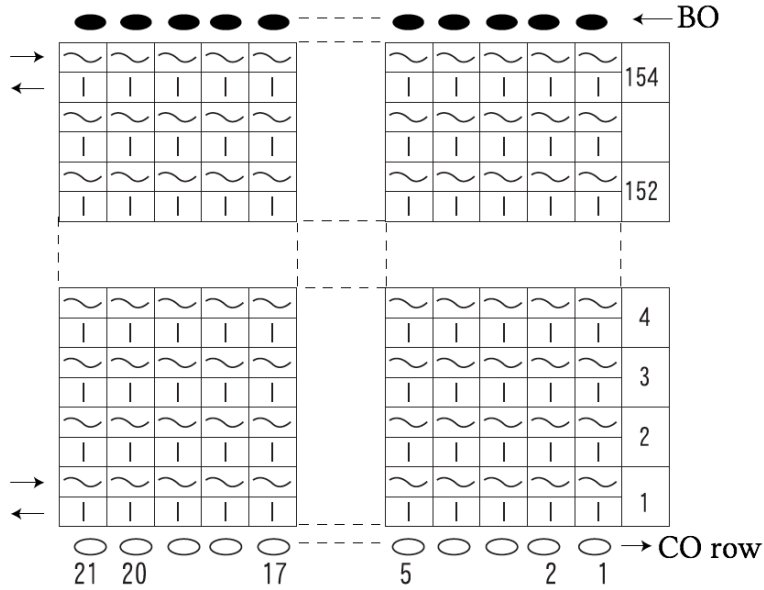
❖ For body of scarf, use 1 strand of Pure Cashmere 100 and 1 strand of Standard Lace held together. For edging, use 1 strand of Pure Cashmere 100.

Abbreviations: BO = bind off; CO = cast on



● pattern stitch

Tunisian simple stitch (Tss), 3.9mm afghan hook



★ Tunisian crochet is worked back-and-forth in 2 stages: the forward (right-to-left) pass and the return (left-to-right). Count the 2 stages as one row.

● edging
