210-211-19 Drop-shoulder Vest

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Cutie Mohair [28% kid mohair, 28% acrylic, 15% superwash wool, 30% nylon; 310yds/283m per 0.88 oz./25g skein]; color #35 rose pink; 17 skeins [420g]
- Pierrot Yarns Kirara [83% acrylic, 17% polyester; 1750 yds/1600m per 1.76 oz./50g cone]; color #3 rose gold lamé; 1 cone [30g]
- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- darning needle

Gauge

• pattern stitch: 25 sts and 29 rows = 10cm/4" square

Finished measurements

- bust 88cm/34.65"
- length 65.5cm/25.79"

Knitting Tips

Note: entire garment worked with 1 strand of Kirara and 2 strands of Cutie Mohair held together.

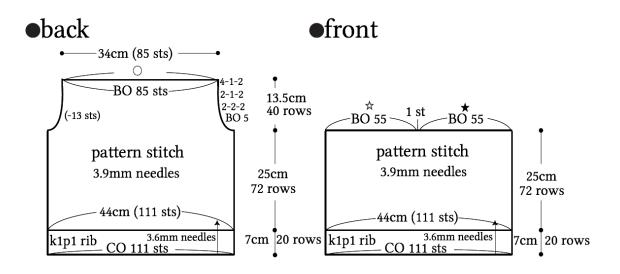
Front and back body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and knit in k1p1 ribbing followed by pattern stitch.

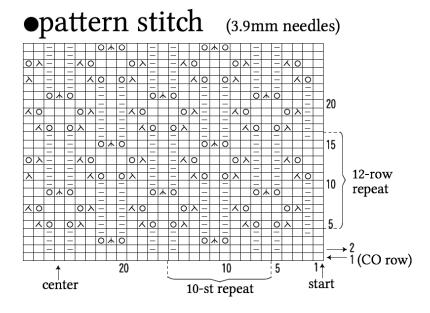
Yoke: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and knit in pattern stitch. Increase according to schematics, knitting in short rows (use Japanese short row method for best results). On last row, while working short-row wraps together with stitches, decrease 32 stitches and bind off. Pick up stitches for left yoke from the cast-on row of right yoke; knit left yoke same as for right yoke but reversing shaping.


Finishing: Join sides with mattress stitch. Align front and back with yoke as shown using designated symbols; join with slip stitch. Work 1 round of single crochet (US) at cuffs and neckline. At center of front body, sc3tog 1 center st together with 1 st each from edge of left and right yokes.


Corsage: Chain to cast on and crochet according to schematics.
