Materials

- Keito-Zakka Stores Funwari Cotton Time [100% cotton; 62 yds/57m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; small amounts light gray, medium gray, dark gray, and black
- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Gauge

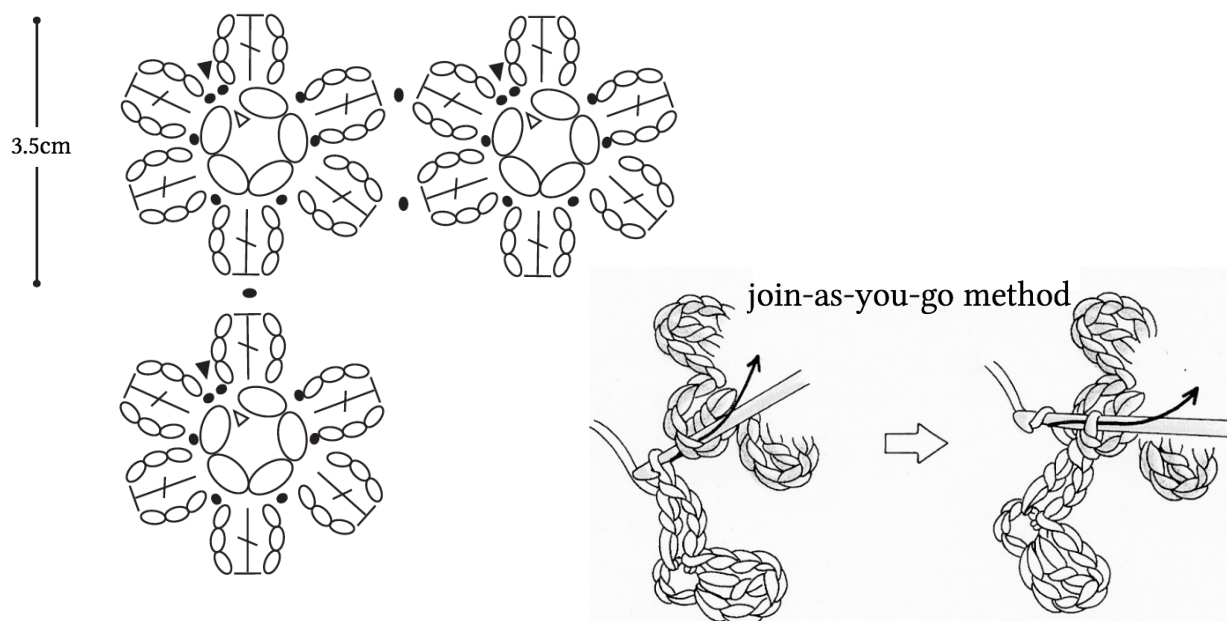
- each motif should measure 3.5cm/1.38" in diameter

Finished measurements

- based on personal preference

Crochet Tips

Crochet motifs by ch5 to cast on, ch3 for turning post, then working *dc, ch3, sl, ch3*, a total of 5 times, ch3, sl to join. Starting from the second motif, join motifs by slip stitching through dc stitches. The scarf is complete when you have completed desired number of motifs.



After working dc, remove hook from current stitch. Insert hook into dc of adjoining motif, pick up loop from dc just worked, and pull through dc on adjoining motif.

Work slip stitch.
