

25-31 Short-Row Scarf

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Atoll Slub Knot [80% rayon, 20% polyester; 77 yds/70m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #4; 2 skeins [60g]
- Pierrot Yarns Super Kid Mohair [75% mohair, 25% nylon; 306 yds/280m per 0.88 oz./25g skein]; color #5801; 1 skein [20g] – discontinued; please choose appropriate substitute.
- 5.7mm (approx. US 9) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Gauge

- pattern stitch: 11.5 sts and 18 rows = 10cm/4" square

Finished measurements

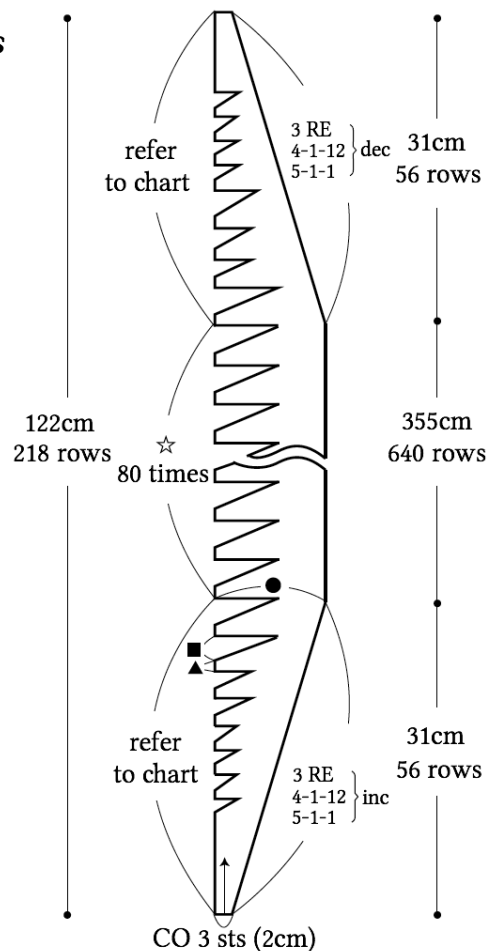
- width 25cm/9.84"
- length 122cm/48.03"

Knitting Tips

※ Entire scarf knit with two strands held together: one strand Atoll Slub Knot and one strand Super Kid Mohair.

Using crochet hook, work chain to cast on. Knit first row of stitches into bottom loops of crochet chain. Knit according to schematics, working short rows on left side and increases on right side. When working other tip of scarf, work short rows on left side and decreases on left side. Bind off in pattern.

Abbreviations: CO = cast on; dec = decrease; inc = increase; RE = rows even; YO = yarn over



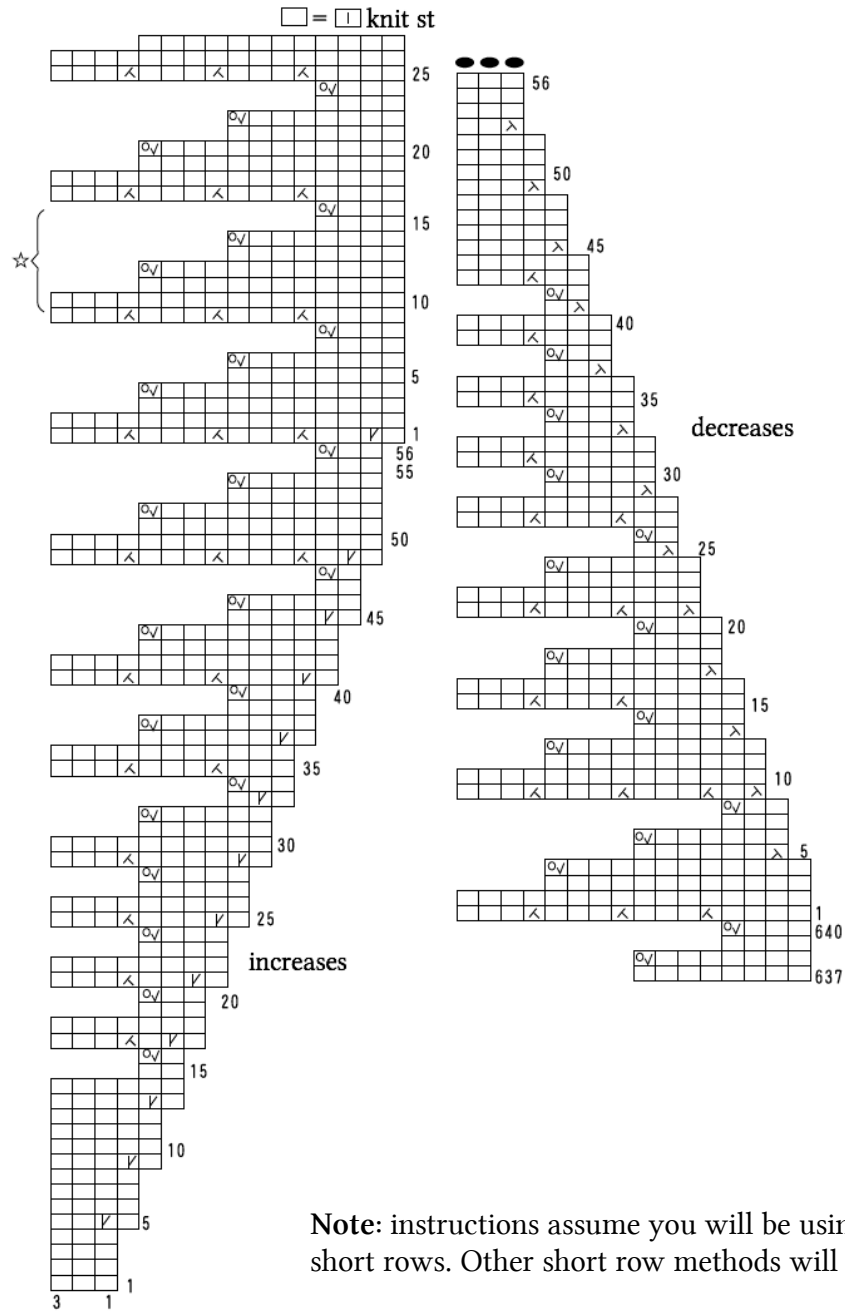
☆ = { 2-4-3 / 2 RE }

● = 11.5cm (16 sts)

■ = 6 rows

▲ = 2 rows

Note: instructions assume you will be using Japanese short rows. Other short row methods will also work.

◁ = When closing up short rows, knit YO together with slipped stitch.

○▽ = Knit to marked stitch, turn work, YO, slip 1 stitch.
