

# 210-211-30 Vest

## Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Fine Merino [100% extra-fine merino; 103 yds/94m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #224 olive green; 7 skeins [200g]
- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) and 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 5 buttons (20mm / 0.79" diameter)
- tapestry needle

## Gauge

Gauge is measured in a swatch 10cm/4" square.

- stockinette stitch, pattern stitch A & B: 20 sts and 30 rows

## Finished measurements

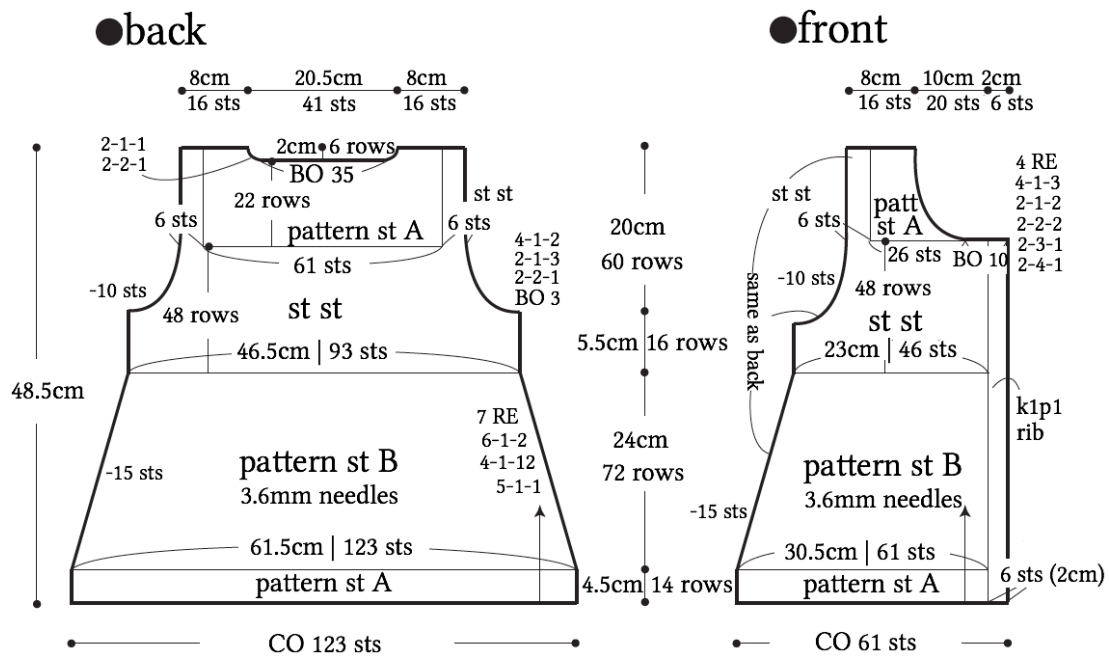
- bust 97.5cm/38.39"
- cross back width 40.5cm/15.94"
- length 49cm/19.29"

## Knitting Tips

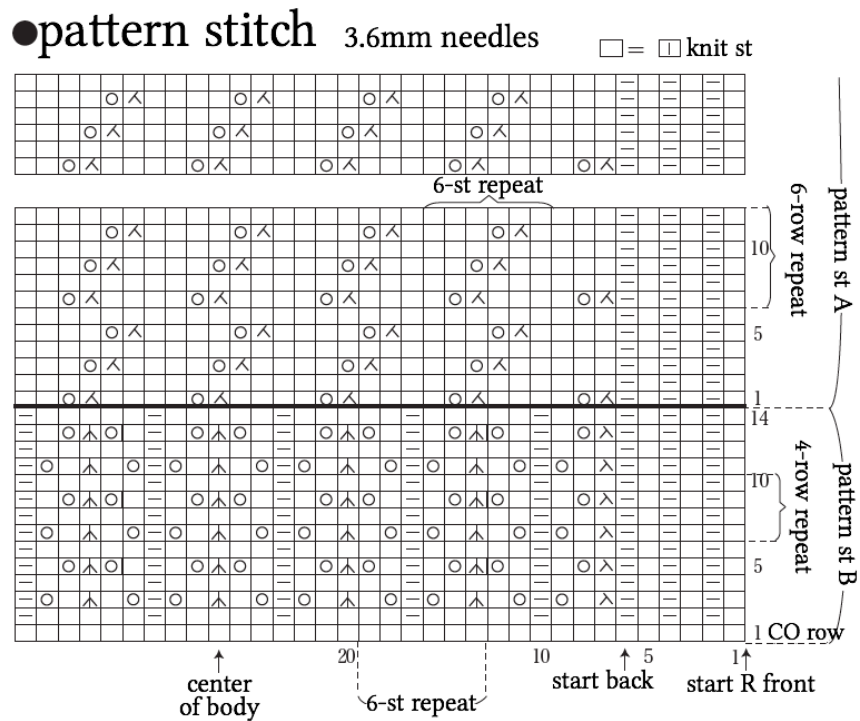
**Front and back body:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and work in pattern stitch A, pattern stitch B, and stockinette stitch.

**Finishing:** Join shoulders with slip stitch and join sides with mattress stitch. Work stockinette stitch in the round at each armscye. When finished knitting neckline and armscye, bind off in pattern. Work edging along front plackets and hem. Work buttonholes in right front placket, and attach buttons to left front placket.

**Abbreviations:** BO = bind off; CO = cast on; DPNs = double-pointed needles; PU = pick up; RE = row(s) even; rep = repeat(s); st st = stockinette stitch

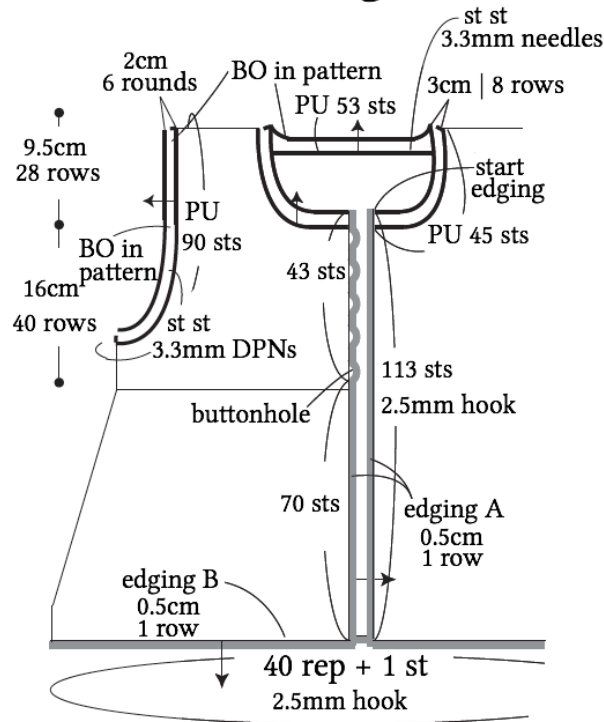


※ Reverse shaping for left front.



※ For back, always knit stitches at both edges to create selvedge.
