

amicomo7-3 Cardigan

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Yuyake no Sora [100% wool; 427 yds/390m per 3.17–3.53 oz./90–100g hank]; color #106 variegated red; 4 hanks [310g]
- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) and 4.5mm (US 7) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Gauge

Gauge is measured in a swatch 10cm/4" square.

- stockinette stitch: 18 sts and 26 rows
- pattern stitch A: 18 sts and 30 rows
- pattern stitch B: 19 sts and 26 rows

Finished measurements

- bust 91cm/35.83"
- length 50cm/19.69"
- cross back width 36cm/14.17"
- sleeve length 54cm/21.26"

Knitting Tips

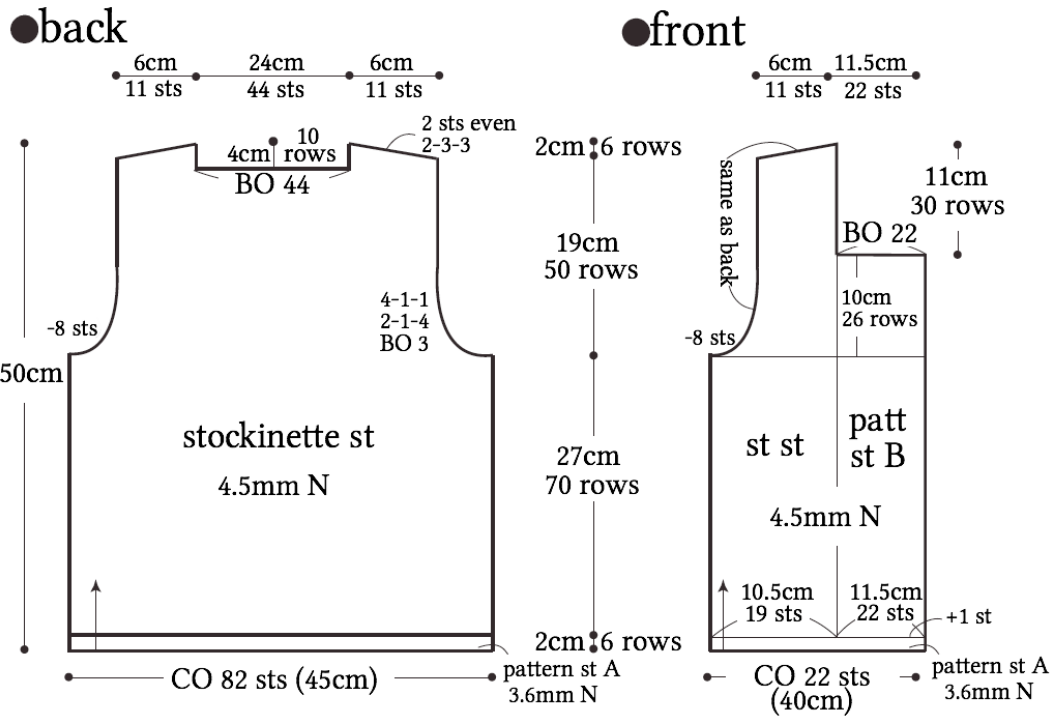
※ Entire garment knit with two strands of yarn held together.

Front and back: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and knit back body in pattern stitch A, then continue to stockinette stitch. Work front body in pattern stitch A, then continue in pattern stitch B and stockinette stitch.

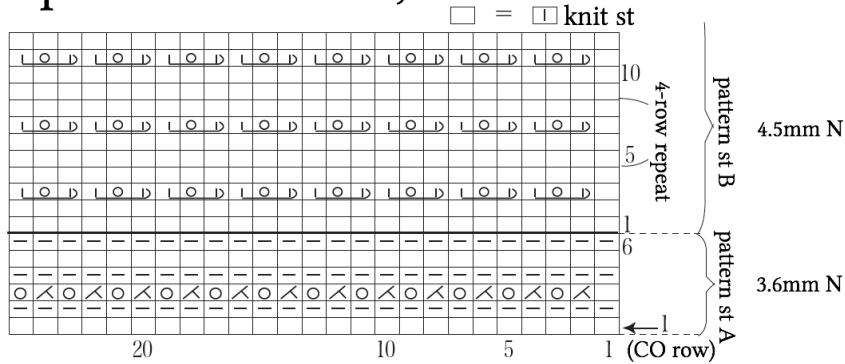
Sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and work in pattern stitch A and B. Continue in stockinette stitch.

Finishing: Join shoulders with slip stitch seam, and join sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Work neckline in pattern stitch A', knitting 4 corners as indicated in schematic. Also work front placket in pattern stitch A'. When finished with neckline and front plackets, bind off in pattern. Join sleeves to body with slip stitch seam.

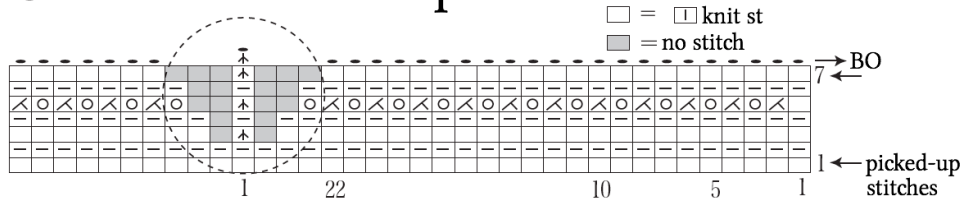
Abbreviations: BO = bind off; CO = cast on; N = needles; patt = pattern; PU = pick up; RE = row(s) even; st st = stockinette stitch



●pattern stitch A, B

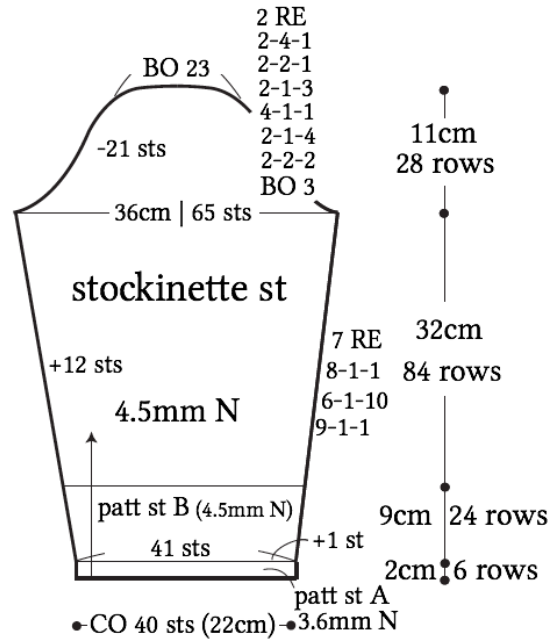


●collar corners & pattern st A'
