

# 27-175C Turtle Amigurumi

## Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Meine Rollen Acrylic [100% antibacterial deodorant acrylic; 61 yds/56m per 1.59 oz./45g skein];
  - color #13 beige; 1 skein [20g]
  - color #7 May green; 1 skein [small amount]
  - color #8 green; 1 skein [small amount]
- 5.0mm (US H) crochet hook
- 2 shank buttons (7mm/0.28")
- small amount polyfiber stuffing

## Gauge

- No gauge information is provided in the original pattern. Use hook size needed to yield fabric such that stuffing does not show through.

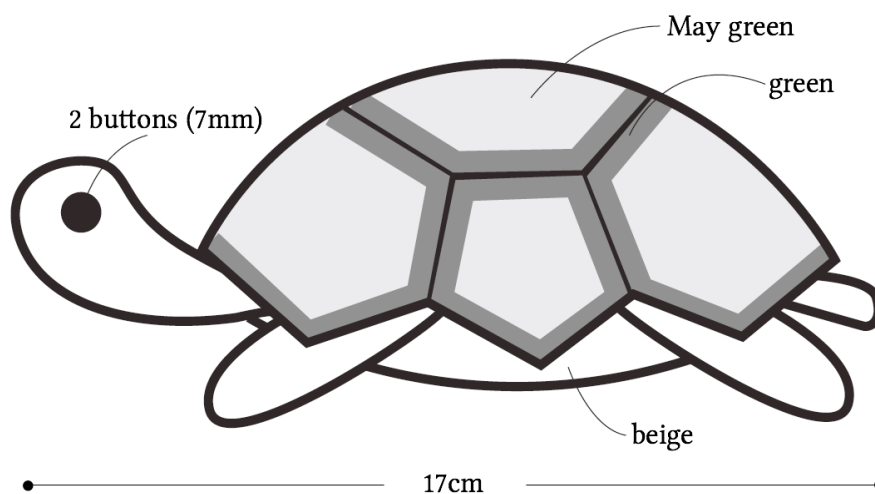
## Finished measurements

- length 17cm/6.69"

## Crochet Tips

Crochet each part by creating magic ring and work in single crochet (US) following charts, increasing and decreasing as indicated. When finished, leave yarn tails. Use those yarn tails to sew all parts together. Insert stuffing into head, legs, flippers, and tail, then sew smoothly to abdomen. Seam shell to abdomen with whipstitch, aligning approximately 3 stitches on one side to every 2 stitches on the other. Insert stuffing and seam remaining openings.

**Abbreviations:** m = magic ring; rnd = round

rnd	# of sts	color
1	6 sts	May green
2	12 sts	May green
3	18 sts	green



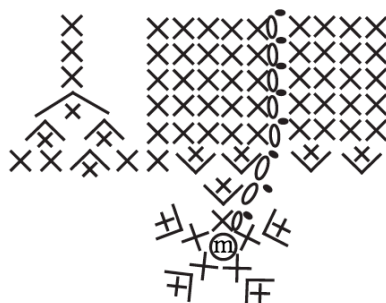
## Shell B (make 6)

rnd	# of sts	color
1	5 sts	May green
2	10 sts	May green
3	15 sts	green



## Head (make 1)

rnd	# of sts	color
1	5 sts	beige
2	10 sts	
3	13 sts	
4	11 sts	
5-8	10 sts	



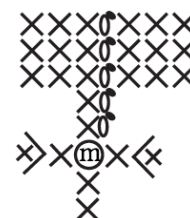
## Tail (make 1)

rnd	# of sts	color
1-4	4 sts	beige



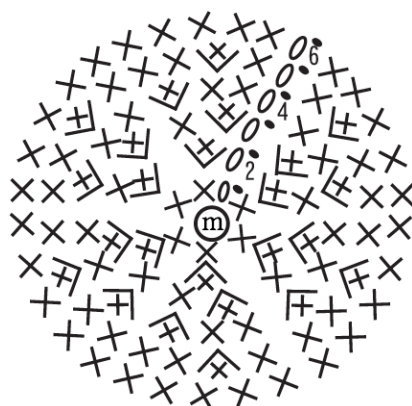
## Flippers and Legs (make 2 of each)

rnd	# of sts	color
1	4 sts	beige
2-5	6 sts	



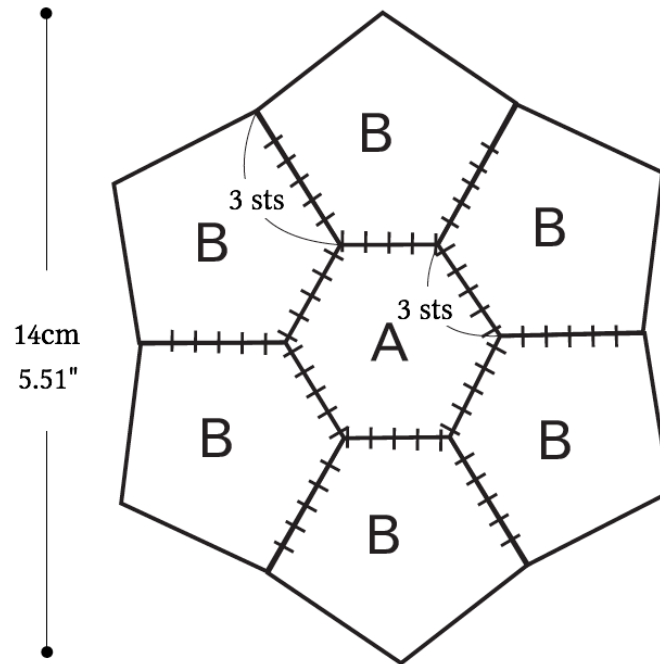
## Abdomen (make 1)

rnd	# of sts	color
1	6 sts	beige
2	12 sts	
3	18 sts	
4	24 sts	
5-6	30 sts	



## Finishing

※ Picking up a half stitch at a time, seam 3 stitches.



## View from top

※ Attach various parts in space between shell and abdomen.
