

210-211-05 Neckwarmer & Armwarmers

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Pop Merino [100% merino wool; 68 yds/62m per 1.23 oz./35g skein]; color #4 scarlet/sepia; 6 skeins [190g]
- **neckwarmer:** 4.5mm (US 7) and 5.1 (approx. US 8) double-pointed or circular knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- **armwarmers:** 5.1 (approx. US 8) straight knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- **both:** 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- tapestry needle

Gauge

Gauge is measured in a swatch 10cm/4" square.

- pattern stitch A: 18.5 sts and 24 rows
- pattern stitch B: 16.5 sts and 24 rows

Finished measurements

- neckwarmer length 36.5cm/14.37"
- armwarmer length 28cm/11.02"

Knitting Tips

Neckwarmer: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and begin working in pattern stitch B (k4p3). While working evenly spaced decreases, work in k1p1 ribbing. Change needles and knit 16 rounds, then change needles again and knit 20 more rounds. Bind off in pattern. (Alternatively, bind off with 1x1 tubular bind-off method.)

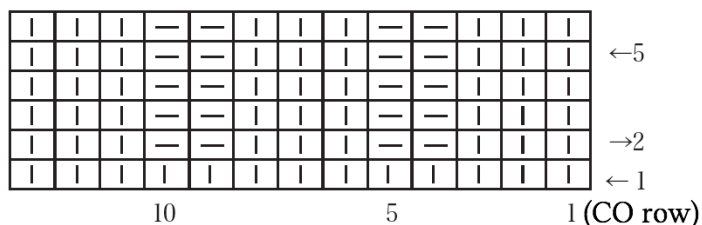
Finishing: Work 4 rounds of edging B around cast-on edge.

Armwarmer: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and begin working in pattern stitch A. When finished, bind off in pattern.

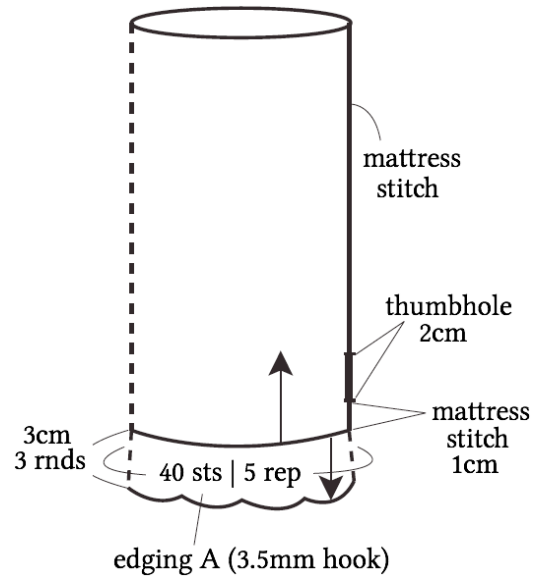
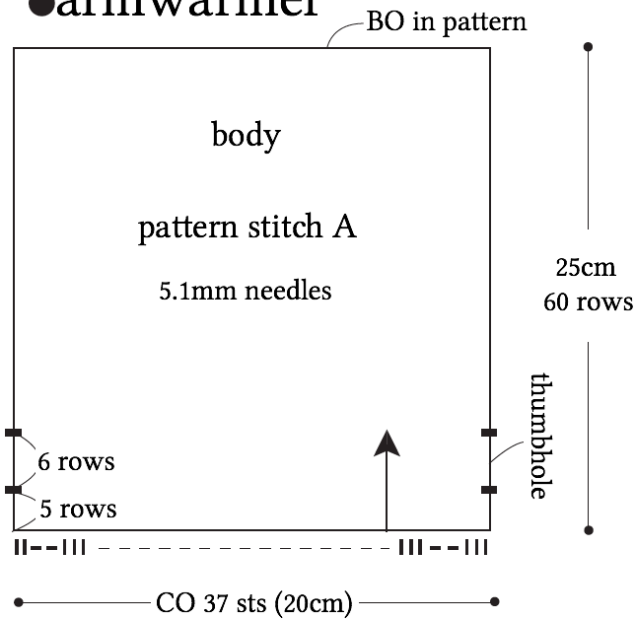
Finishing: Seam with mattress stitch, leaving a gap for thumb. Work 3 rounds of edging A around cast-on edge.

Abbreviations: BO = bind off; CO = cast on; dec = decrease(s); RE = row(s) even; rep = repeat(s); rnd(s) = round(s); st(s) = stitch(es)

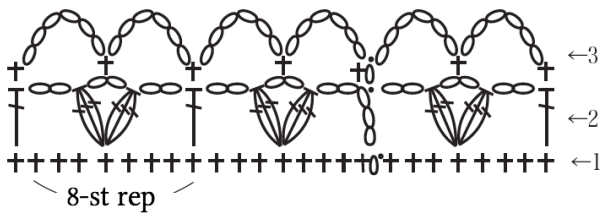
● pattern stitch A (5.1mm needles)



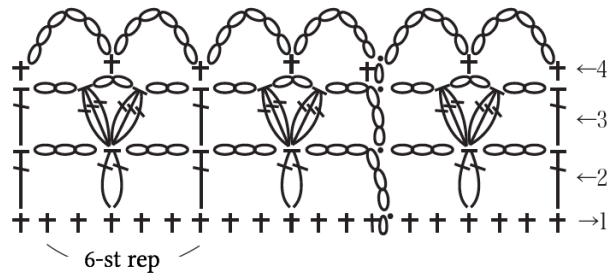
●armwarmer



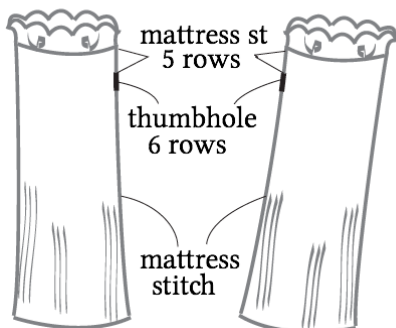
●edging A (3.5mm hook)

●finished armwarmers

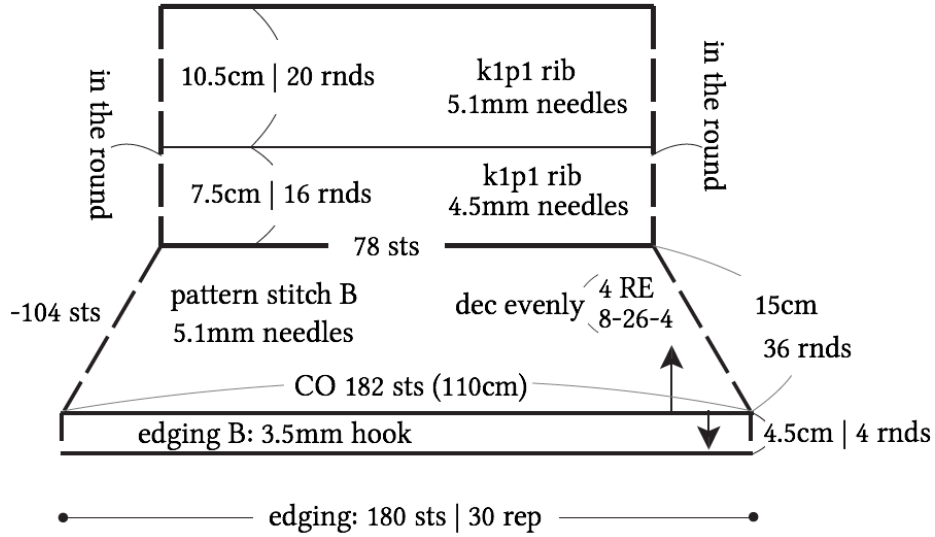


●finished neckwarmer



※ By changing needle size from 4.5mm to 5.1mm – but keeping the same number of rows and stitches – you can knit a girl's skirt instead.
