27-3K Whale Amigurumi

Materials

- Pierrot Yarns Yuttari Acrylic [100% antibacterial deodorant acrylic; 73 yds/67m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #93 dark gray; 2 skeins [approx. 80g]
 - color #84 saxe blue; 1 skein [small amount]
- 4.0mm (US G) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 20cm/7.87" length of wire
- small amount red and white felt
- small amount cotton or polyfiber stuffing

Gauge

• single crochet (US): 15 sts and 16 rows = 10cm/4" square



Crochet Tips

Create magic ring and crochet through round 9 according to schematics, increasing as indicated. Work round 10-16 even, and starting from round 17, work decreases. Insert stuffing into body. Crochet two flippers, place them together, and seam them together by working single crochet (US) edging around both of them. Crochet two fins. Whipstitch various body parts to body. Draw lines on white felt to create mouth; attach to body. Make eyes out of felt and attach to body. Create water spout by working single crochet (US) stitches around wire; attach to body.

* If desired, attach frog and seagull to back of whale amigurumi.

Abbreviations: m = magic ring; sc = single crochet (US)
