211-6h Marshmallow Cotton Dress Set



Suggested yarn:

Pierrot Yarns Marshmallow Cotton [100% cotton; 153 yds/140m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; 3 skeins [140g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 2½) and 3.3mm (approx. US 3) double-pointed and straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3 buttons (20mm/0.79")
- 1 piece elastic for waistband (1cm/0.39" wide, 50cm/19.69" long)

Finished measurements:

- · dress:
 - chest 64cm/25.20"
 - cross back width 27cm/10.63"
 - length 37cm/14.57"
 - sleeve length 16cm/6.30"
- · pants:
 - hip measurement 60cm/23.62"
 - rise 22cm/8.66"
- · socks:
 - · foot length 13cm/5.12"
 - mouth of cuff 10cm/3.94"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch (with 3.3mm needles): 28 sts and 32 rows
- k1p1 ribbing (with 3.0mm needles): 38 sts and 33 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Dress:

Front and back: Cast on with long-tail cast-on; work in stockinette stitch. Work decreases where indicated at chest, changing to k1p1 ribbing.

Sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast on method and work in stockinette stitch.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Crochet edging in the round around cuffs and hem. Work 1 row of edging along neckline and back neck slit; reattach yarn and work second row of edging in the same direction as the first. Make and attach loops; attach buttons. Join sleeves to body with slip stitch seam.


Pants (front and back): Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then continue in stockinette stitch. Seam crotch with Kitchener stitch. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Fold waistband to inside and secure with whipstitch. Thread elastic through casing. Work k1p1 rib as edging around leg cuffs (in the round). Bind off with 1x1 tubular bind-off method.

Socks: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and work in the round from cuff down. Work in k1p1 ribbing, then continue in stockinette stitch. Work heel back-and-forth in rows according to chart, leaving instep stitches on hold. When finished with toe, graft stitches with Kitchener stitch. Work second sock.

BO = bind off N = needles CO = cast on PU = pick up dec = decrease RE = row(s) even

inc = increase #-#-# = rows-stitches-times




