

India Zakka Lace Camisole



Suggested yarn:

Keito-Zakka Stores India Zakka Lace [100% cotton; 612 yds/560m per 3.53 oz./100g skein]; color #06 rouge red, 2 skeins [160g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) and 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 2 flower-shaped buttons (15mm/0.59")

Finished measurements:

bust 88cm/34.65"
length 52cm/20.47"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- with 2.5mm hook: 14.5 nets and 14 rows
- with 3.0mm hook: 14.5 nets and 14.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Back and front body: Chain to create foundation row; work in pattern stitch. Use 3.0mm hook through round 20, then use 2.5mm hook starting from round 21.

Finishing: Seam sides with slip/chain seam (see below). Work edging in the round around body at hem, armholes, and neckline. Crochet shoulder straps and attach to body. Attach buttons.

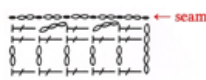
Abbreviations:

ch = chain

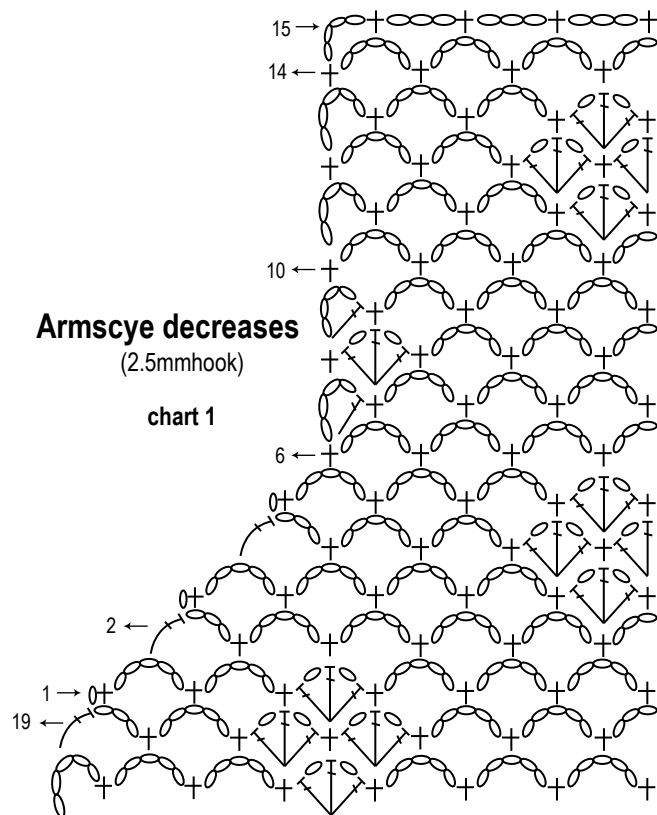
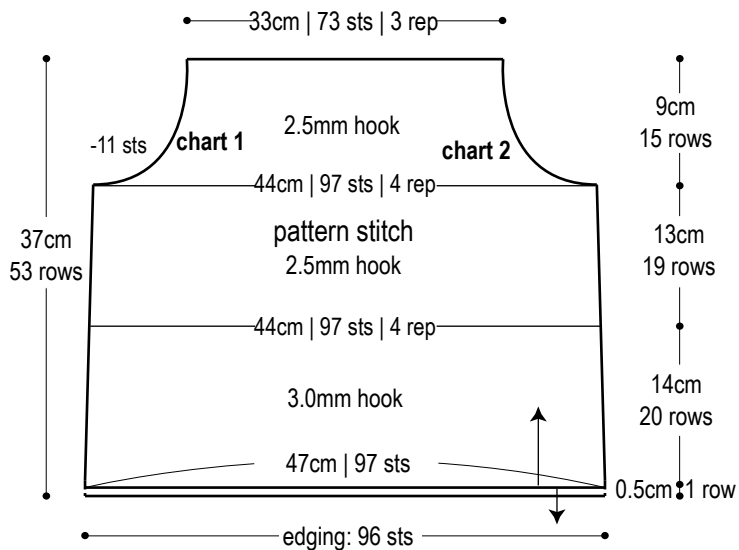
rep = repeat(s)

※Note: entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

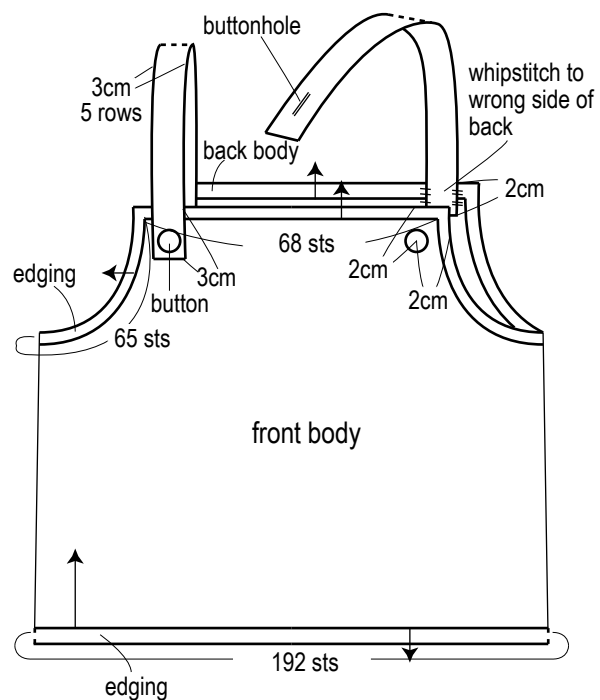
Slip/chain seam: essentially a slip stitch seam with chain stitches interspersed between slip stitches. Slip stitch through both layers of fabric. *ch2, sl st in top of next row*, continue from * to * until end. (Note: use ch2 only for double crochet (US). Use ch1 for hdc, ch2 for dc, ch3 for treble, and so on.)



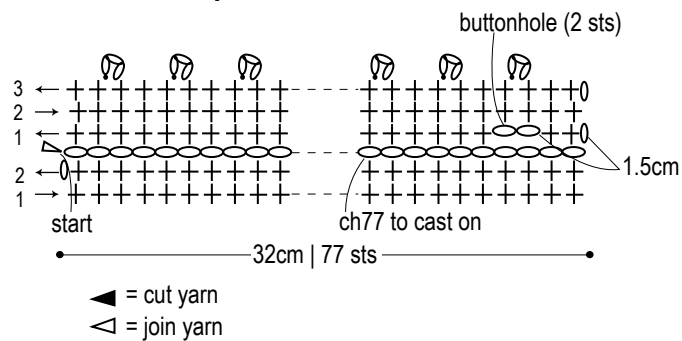
Front and back



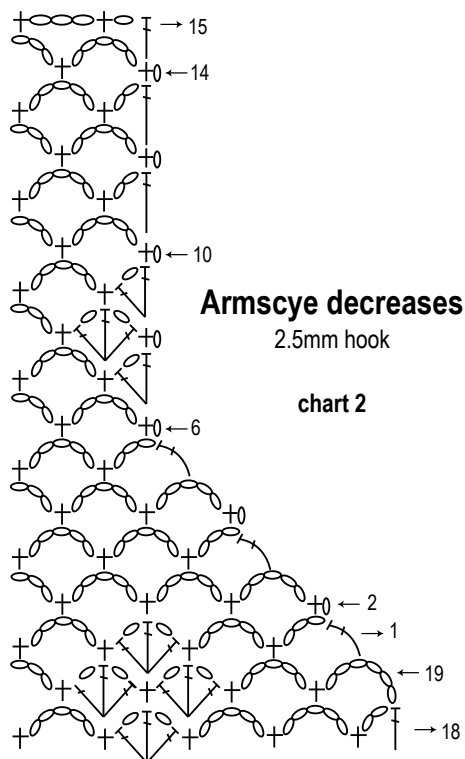
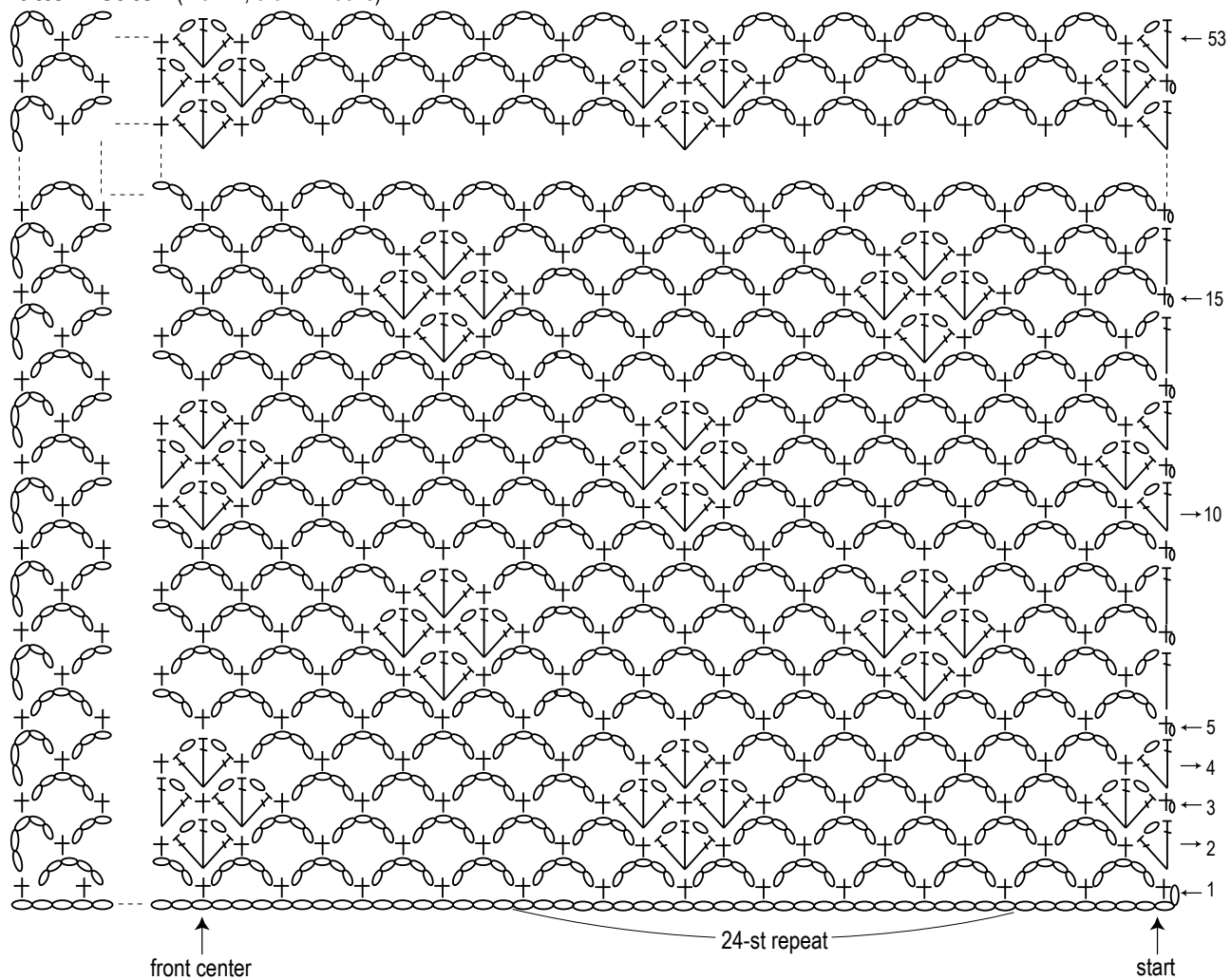
