

# 211s-4 Amian Fedora



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Amian Space Dyed [100% Japanese paper; 94 yds/86m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
  - ladies' size: color #04 blue/gray mix, 3 skeins [85g]
  - kids' size: color #02 red/brown mix, 2 skeins [60g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 5.0mm (US H) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- ladies' size: head circumference 60cm/23.62"
- kids' size: head circumference 53cm/20.87"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- single crochet (US): 15 sts and 15.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

## Crochet Tips

**Top:** Make chain to create foundation round; single crochet (US) in the round while increasing.

**Crown/brim:** Continuing from top, work crown and brim according to chart, increasing as indicated.

**Finishing:** Referring to finishing tips, block into shape with steam iron.

※Work kids' size in the same manner.


## Hat (5.0mm hook)



## Finishing

At front center, pinch both sides to form indentation. (Do the same for back center.)

Shape hat by making an indentation around the 6th and 7th rounds of the crown.



※Block into shape using steam iron, taking care not to burn yourself.
