

211s-9 Silk Garden Tunic



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Silk Garden [100% silk; 208 yds/190m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #09 red, 9 skeins [350g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.5mm (approx. US 4) straight knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- cross back width 30cm/11.81"
- length 74cm/29.13"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 23 sts and 33 rows
- pattern stitch B: 23 sts and 32 rows
- stockinette stitch: 23 sts and 31 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Front and back: Cast on with long-tail cast-on and work in pattern stitches A and B. Continue in stockinette stitch, but decrease 26 stitches evenly spaced across the first row of stockinette stitch.

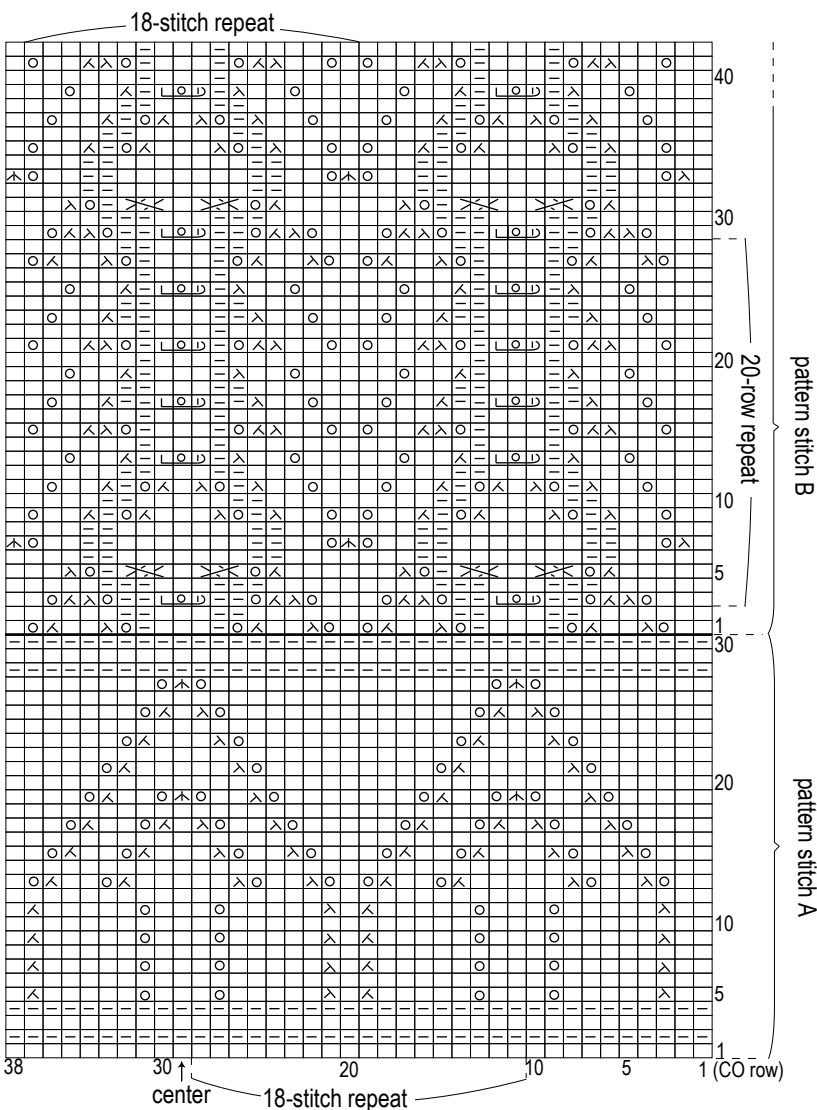
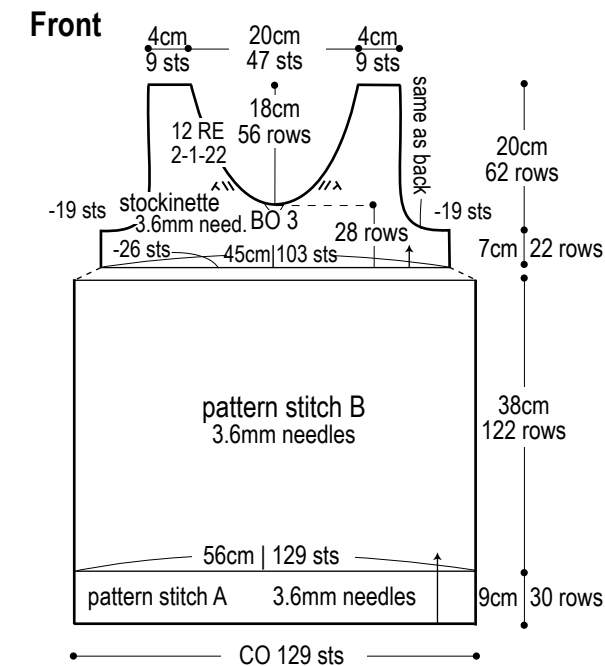
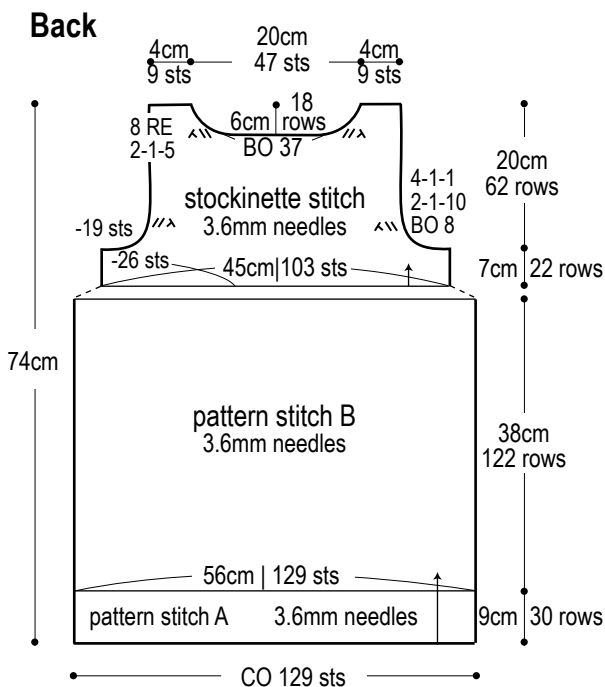
Finishing: With right sides facing, seam shoulders with slip stitch. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches from around armscyes and neckline and work garter stitch in the round. Bind off in pattern.

※Entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

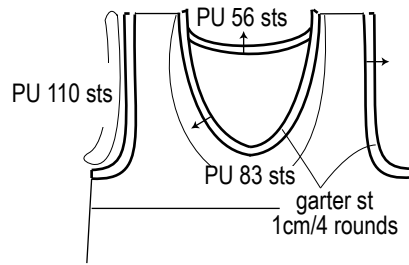
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
DPNs = double-pointed needles
PU = pick up
RE = row(s) even
YO = yarn over
= rows-stitches-times

Collar, arm edging (3.3mm DPNs)

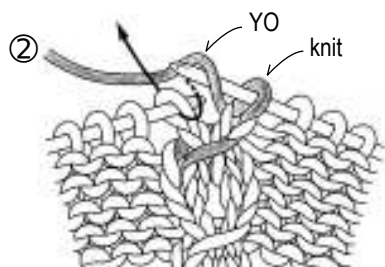


* [] = knot with slipped left stitch (see page 1)
