

Fiore Overskirt



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Fiore [100% cotton; 148 yds/135m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #1 blue/pink/grape/red mix, 3 skeins [100g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US D), 3.5mm (US E) and 4.0mm (US G) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- please see schematics

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch (with 4.0mm hook): 21 sts and 14 rounds

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

❖ **Note:** Work skirt with 1 strand of yarn, but work ribbon with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Skirt: Chain to make foundation row consisting of 132 stitches. Referring to schematic, work in pattern stitch in the round, changing hook size when indicated. Crochet until final round, then work edging A. Work 132 stitches into the foundation chain and work edging B in the round.

Waist ribbon: Work a chain, leaving a long yarn tail on the end. Work 1 decoration at end. Thread ribbon through waist area, then crochet 1 more decorations at beginning with yarn tail left for this purpose.

Abbreviations:

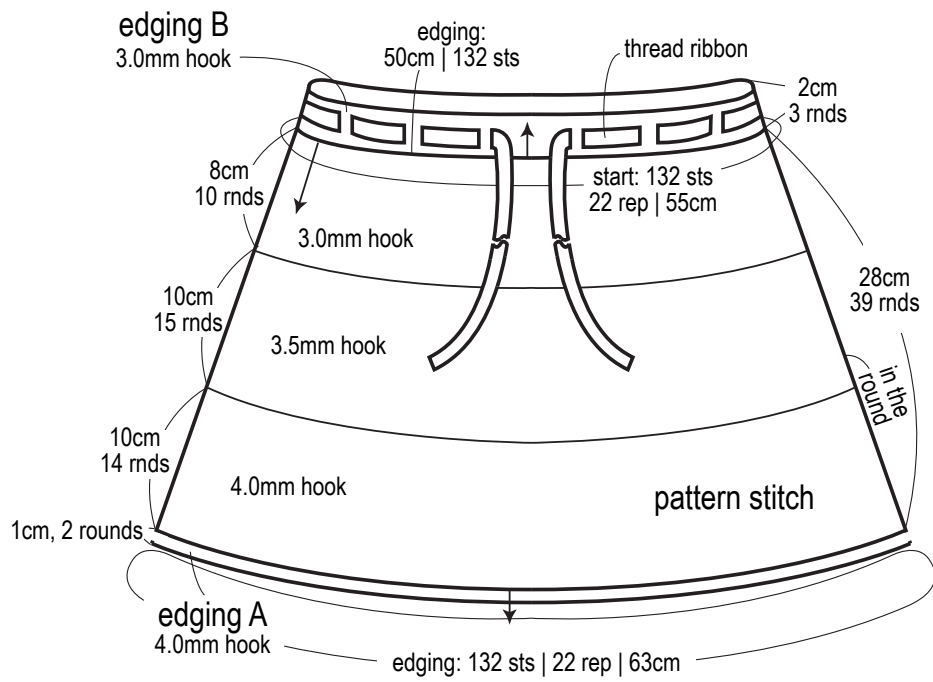
ch = chain

m = magic ring

rep = repeat(s)

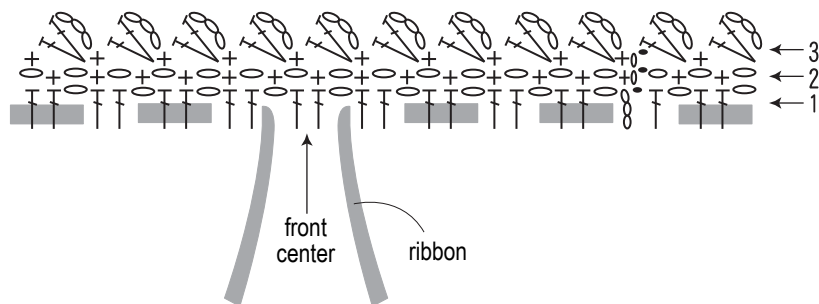
rnd(s) = round(s)

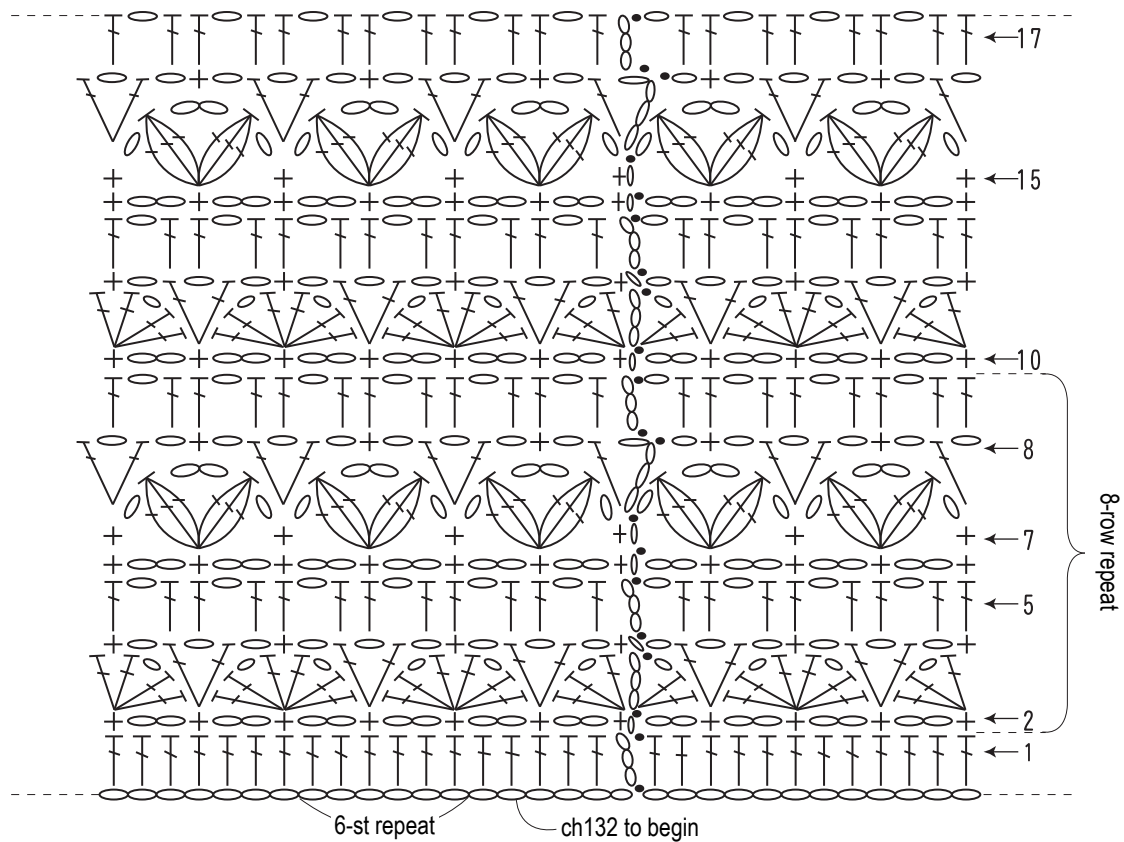
Edging B & ribbon threading instructions

3.0mm hook



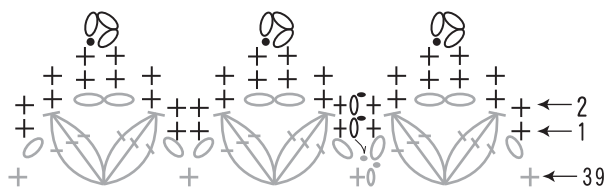
Pattern stitch
