2728-OMO54 Cutie Mohair Fisherman's Rib Scarf



- Suggested yarn:
 Pierrot Yarns Cutie Mohair [30% nylon, 28% mohair, 28% acrylic, 14% wool; 339 yds/310m per 0.88 oz./25g
 - color #22 sky blue, 5 skeins [120g]
 - color #23 pale pink, 5 skeins [120g]
 - color #24 light papaya, 5 skeins [120g]

Tools/Notions:

• 8.0mm (US 11) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- width 18cm/7.09"
- length 217cm/85.43"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• fisherman's rib: 11.5 sts and 17 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips


Cast on with long-tail cast-on and work in fisherman's rib. Always slip the first stitch stitch of every row. Work row 2 in k1p1 ribbing, but k2 at each edge rather than k1. Starting from row 3, k1b for knit stitches only (that is, not for purl stitches). K1b for knit stitches on row 4 as well. When finished, bind off tightly in pattern. Fasten fringe to each end in 10 places each.

*The entire scarf is worked with 6 strands of yarn held together (2 strands of each color of Cutie Mohair).

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

k1b = knit 1 into stitch below the one on the left needle



gauge (10cm/4" square): fisherman's rib: 11.5 sts & 17 rows

★ Fringe: Tie in 10 places on each end as follows: fold 24 strands (8 strands of each color) in half and tie where indicated. Each strand should be 34cm/13.39" in length.
