

Natural Silk Cotton Tunic



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Natural Silk Cotton [72% cotton, 28% silk; 104 yds/95m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #06 ice blue, 7 skeins [280g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 86cm/33.89"
- cross back width 33cm/12.99"
- length 64.5cm/25.39"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 24 sts and 34 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and work in stockinette stitch. For side and neckline shaping, use fully fashioned increases/decreases (worked 2 stitches in from the edge).

Finishing: Seam shoulders with slip stitch seam. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Work edging A along neckline. Work edging B along armholes and hem, respectively.

Abbreviations:

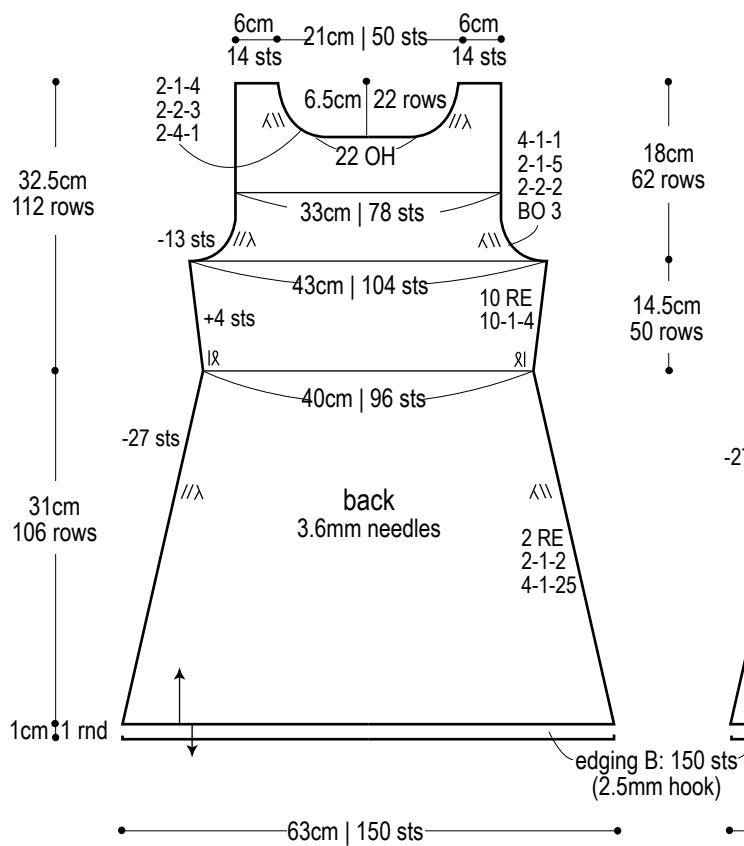
BO = bind off

OH = on hold (place stitches on stitch holder)

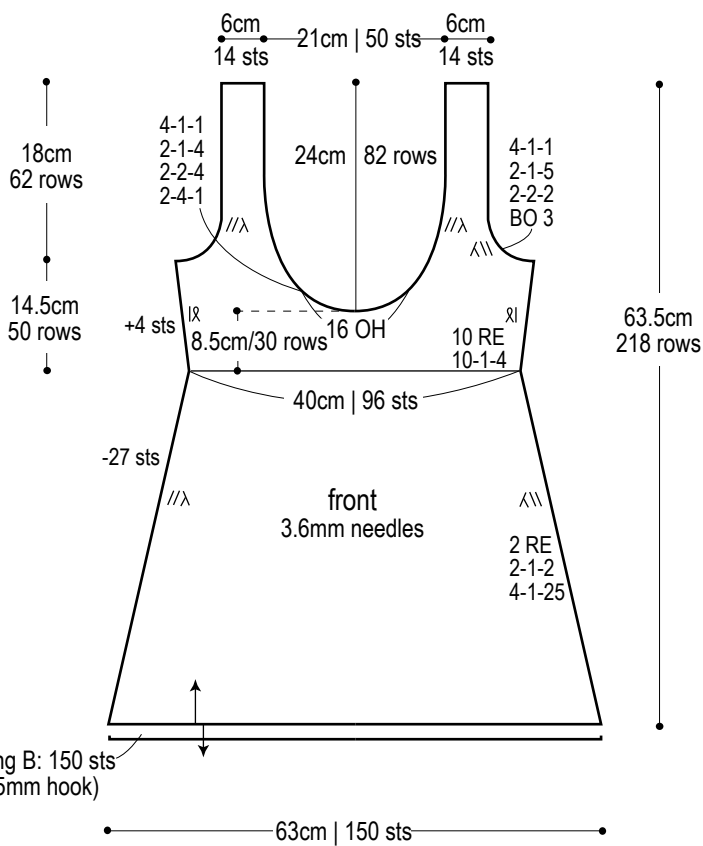
RE = row(s) even

#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

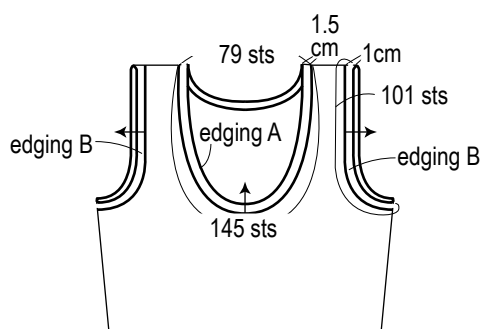
