25-26-15 Pullover



Suggested yarn:

 Pierrot Yarns Lamé Wool [95% wool, 5% polyester; 179 yds/164m per 3.17 oz./90g hank]; color #905 mint green, 7 hanks [550g]

Tools/Notions:

• 4.2mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 96cm/37.80"
- · cross back width 35cm/13.78"
- length 58.5cm/23.03"
- sleeve length 55cm/21.65"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

stockinette stitch: 20 sts and 27 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Body & sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and start by working k2p2 ribbing for the hem. Continue in stockinette stitch and k2p2 ribbing. Shape armscyes and neckline by binding off where indicated and working decreases at the left/right edge (ssk or k2tog). Shape shoulders with short rows. Work front collar in one piece. Refer to chart for neckline decreases. For back collar, continue from front. Cast on for sleeves as for body; knit according to schematic.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Seam back of collar, then attach to back neckline with stitches-to-rows seam. Join sleeves to body with slip stitch seam.

Abbreviations:

blco = backwards-loop cast-on increase

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

inc = increase

RE = row(s) even

#-#-# = rows-stitches-times
