

20-21-10 Cowichan-style Jacket



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Washable Gokubuto [60% wool, 40% acrylic; 77 yds/70m per 1.76 oz./50g skein];
-- discontinued; please choose appropriate substitute
 - color #229 navy blue, 12 skeins [590g]
 - color #221 white, 7 skeins [320g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.2mm (approx. US 6) and 4.8mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 4.0mm (US G) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 zipper (50cm/19.69" long)

Finished measurements:

- bust 105cm/41.34"
- cross back width 40cm/15.75"
- length 64cm/25.20"
- sleeve length 51cm/20.08"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 19 sts and 25 rows
- pattern stitch A, B: 19 sts and 21 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Body & sleeves: Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method and work in stockinette stitch and stranded pattern. (For stranded pattern, knit while changing colors as indicated in diagrams.) Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. ✱See diagrams for stranded knitting instructions.✱

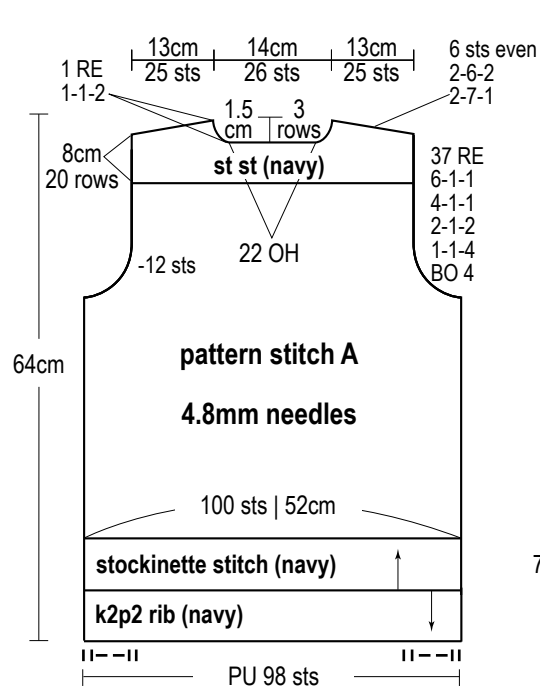
Collar: For back portion, cast on with long-tail cast-on method and begin knitting. Pick up stitches for front collar from back collar and knit. Lay collar along neckline and with mattress stitch and Kitchener stitch.

Finishing: Attach sleeves to body with slip stitch seam. Fasten zipper to front bands.

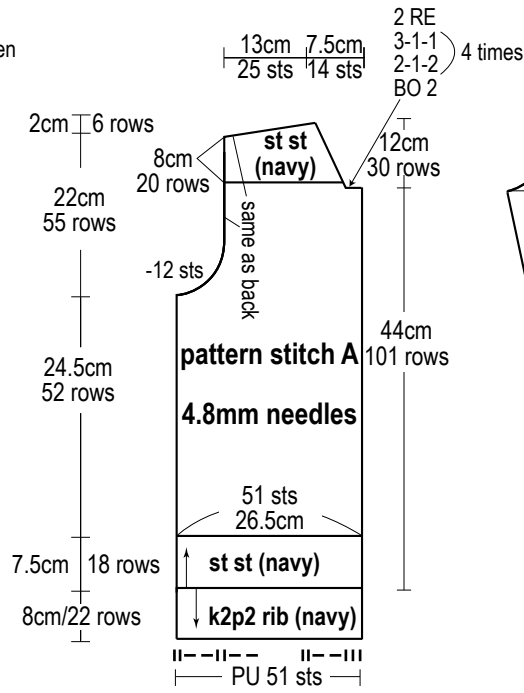
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
OH = on hold (place on a stitch holder)
PU = pick up
RE = row(s) even
st st = stockinette stitch
= rows-stitches-times

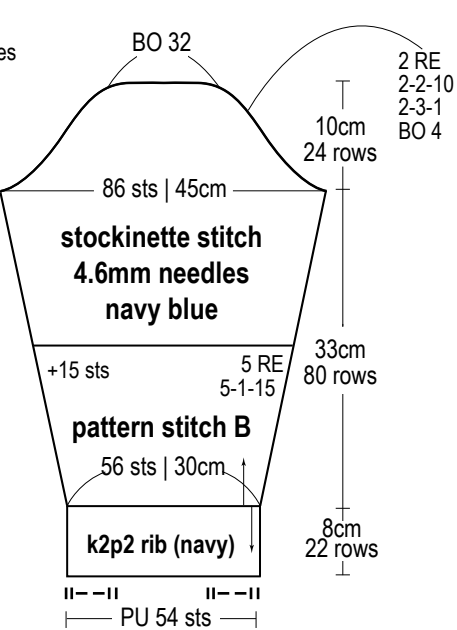

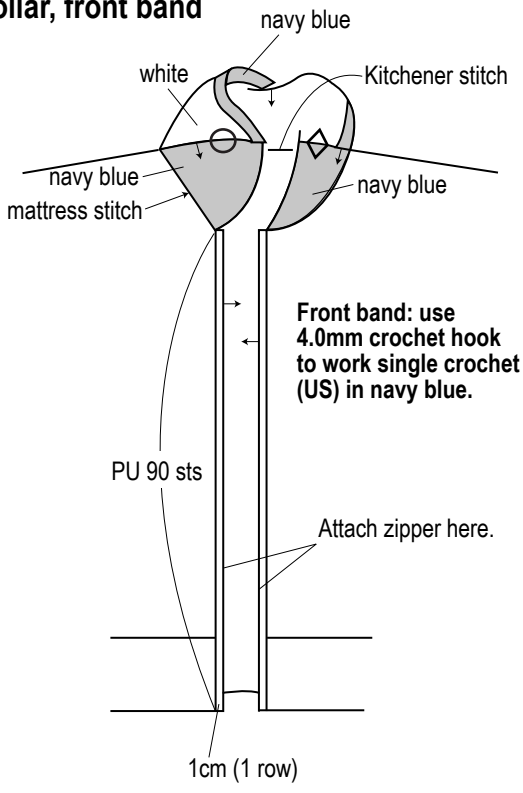
Front



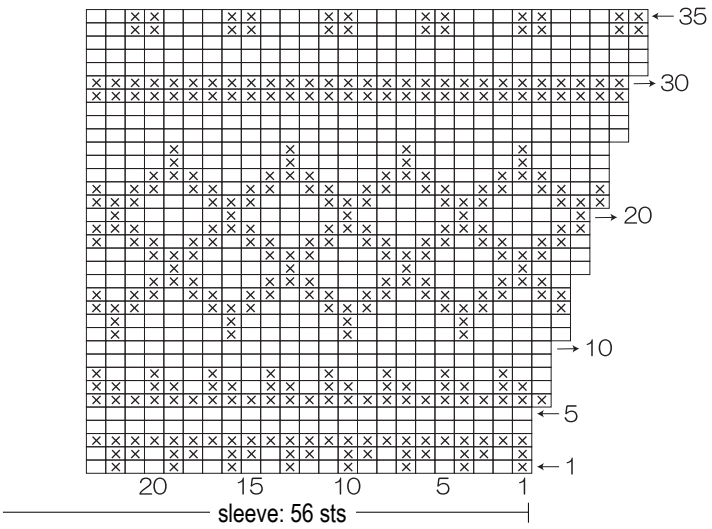
Sleeve



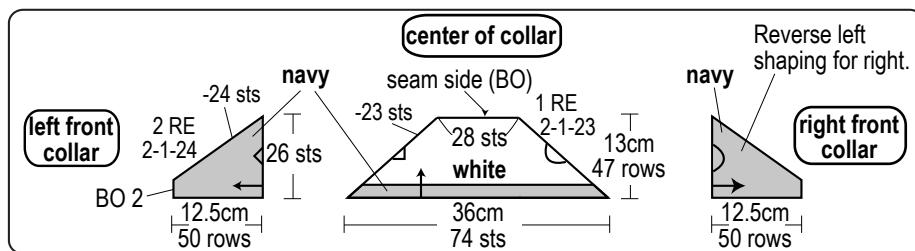
Collar, front band



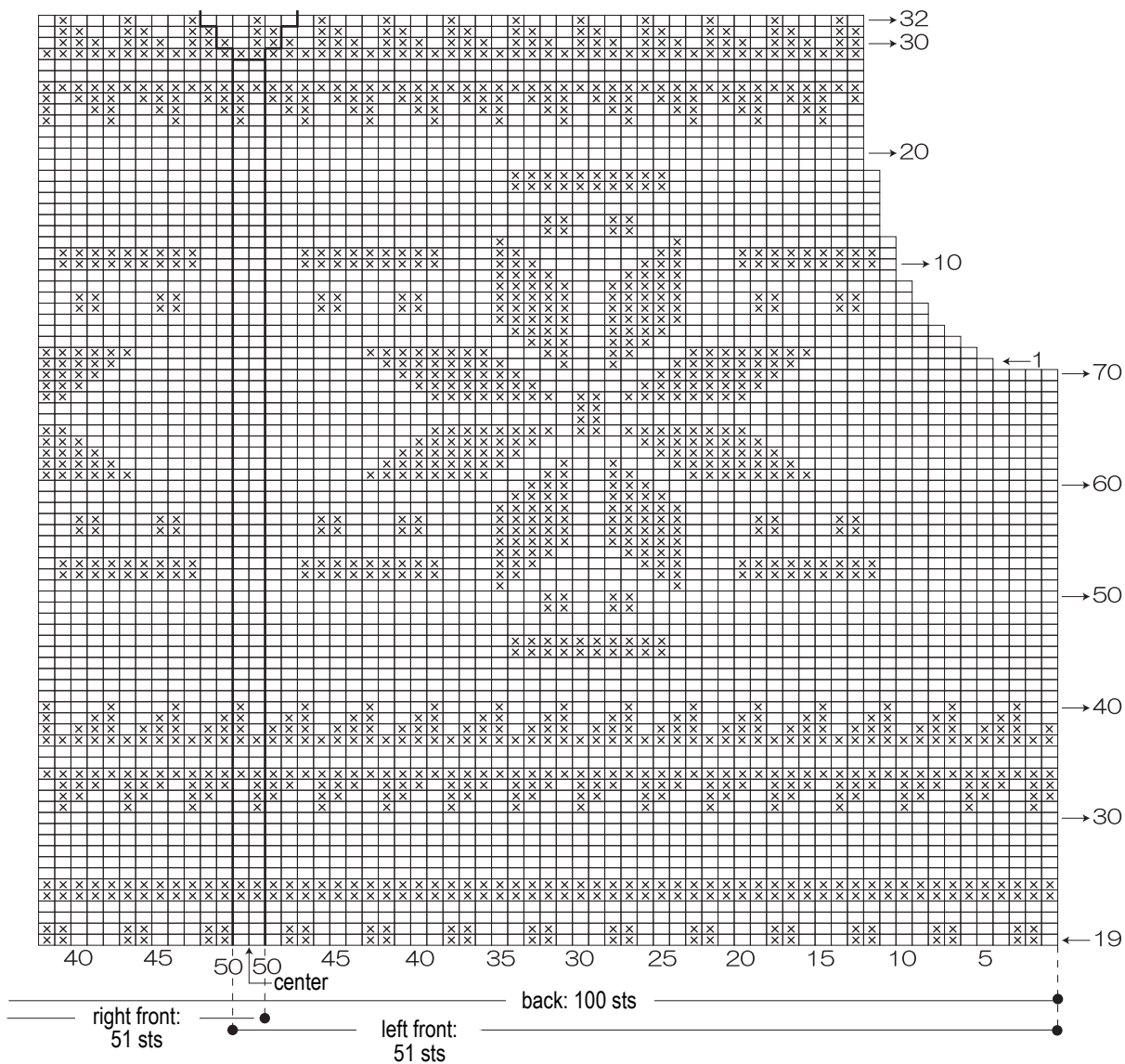
Pattern stitch B
