

20-21-23 Silk100 Cardigan



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Silk100 Fingering [100% silk; 344 yds/315m per 1.76 oz./50g cone]; color #6023 dark brown, 8 cones [370g]
- Pierrot Yarns Kirara [89% acetate, 11% polyester; 1892 yds/1730m per 1.76 oz./50g cone]; color #4815, 1 cone [40g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 9 buttons (11.5mm/0.45" diameter)

Finished measurements:

- bust 98cm/38.58"
- cross back width 37cm/14.57"
- length 60cm/23.62"
- sleeve length 53cm/20.87"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 25 sts and 30 rows
- pattern stitch: 30 sts and 30 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

※Entire garment worked with 3 strands of yarn held together: 2 strands of Silk100 Fingering and 1 strand of Kirara.

Body: Cast on with crochet hook as follows: chain required number of stitches, then use knitting needles to pick up stitches from crochet chain. Work in stockinette stitch and pattern stitch. Reverse shaping for left front.

Sleeve: Start as for body, but modify pattern stitch as indicated in chart (and reverse for other sleeve).

Finishing: Seam shoulders with slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Work edging along hem, neckline, and front edge in order, but for last row, work one continuous round along all three. Work edging in the round at cuffs. Attach sleeves to body with slip stitch seam.

※Work first buttonhole in second row of right front buttonband.


Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

RE = row(s) even

#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

■ = no stitch

Reverse shaping from center of pattern stitch.

● = at front edge (both right and left), work 1 extra knit stitch.
