

211-32h Cutie Mohair Sleeveless Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Cutie Mohair [30% nylon, 28% mohair, 28% acrylic, 14% superwash wool; 339 yds/310m per 0.88 oz./25g skein];
 - color #25 mandarin orange, 2 skeins [30g]
 - color #29 light beige, 1 skein [20g]
 - color #30 mocha brown, 1 skein [20g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.2mm (approx. US 6) and 4.5mm (US 7) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 91cm/35.83"
- cross back width 46cm/18.11"
- length 45.5cm/17.91"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 18.5 sts and 25 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips


Body and sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and work in order from ① to ② to ③ to ④ in stockinette stitch. For ①, work 28 rows in 2 colors using intarsia method. Change colors, work 28 more rows, and bind off in pattern. For ②, pick up 42 stitches from side edge of ① and work in stripe pattern. Continue to ③, knitting section as shown and placing stitches on stitch holder when finished. Work ④ and bind off in pattern. Seam bind-off edge of ① and side of ④ using mattress stitch.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off. Work collar in garter stitch; bind off in pattern. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Work edging around hem, cuff, and front collar.

*Note: entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.


Abbreviations:

- BO = bind off
- CO = cast on
- OH = on hold (i.e., place on stitch holder)
- PU = pick up
- sc = single crochet (US)




Work sections in order from ① to ② to ③ to ④. Then seam bind-off row of ① to edge of ④ with mattress stitch.

□ = #29 light beige ■ = #25 mandarin orange ▨ = #0 mocha brown



Front collar edging (3.5mm hook)



*Use #25 mandarin orange for collar, front collar edging, cuffs, and hem edging.
