

# 210-211-32 Tunic



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Shine Merino [95% merino wool, 3% polyester, 2% cupra rayon; 131 yds/120m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #02 flamingo pink, 7 skeins [260g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 5), 3.9mm (approx. US 6), and 4.2mm (approx. US 7) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- bust 88cm/34.65"
- cross back width 34cm/13.39"
- length 68.5cm/26.97"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A (with 4.2mm needles): 23 sts and 28 rows
- pattern stitch B: 24 sts and 30 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Knitting Tips

**Back and front body:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and work in garter stitch followed by pattern stitch A and B. Change needle size while working pattern stitch A to alter gauge.

**Finishing:** Seam sides with mattress stitch. Seam shoulders with slip stitch. Crochet 2 rounds of edging around armholes and neckline.

## Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

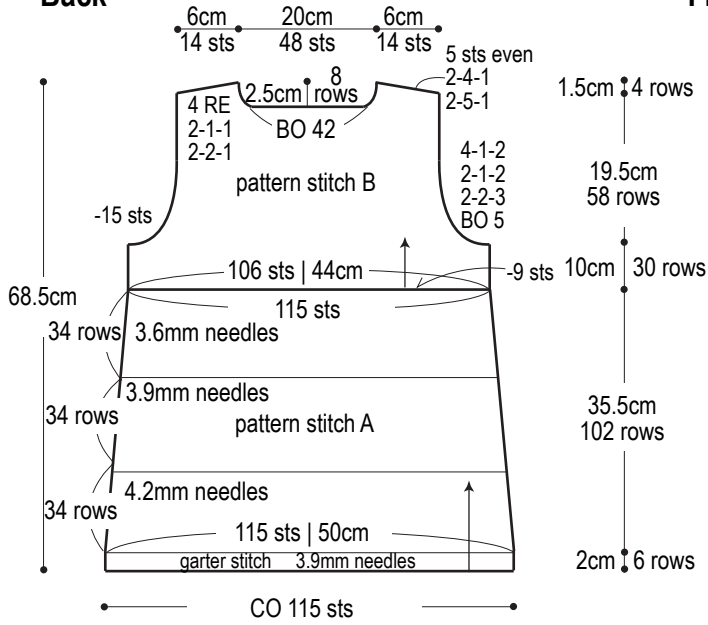
CO = cast on

RE = row(s) even

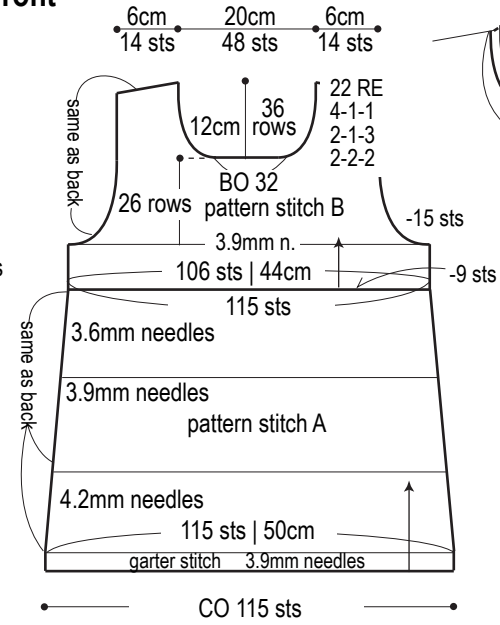
sc = single crochet (US)

### = rows-stitches-times

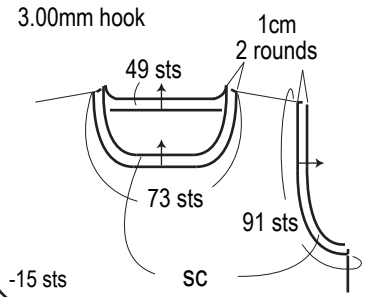

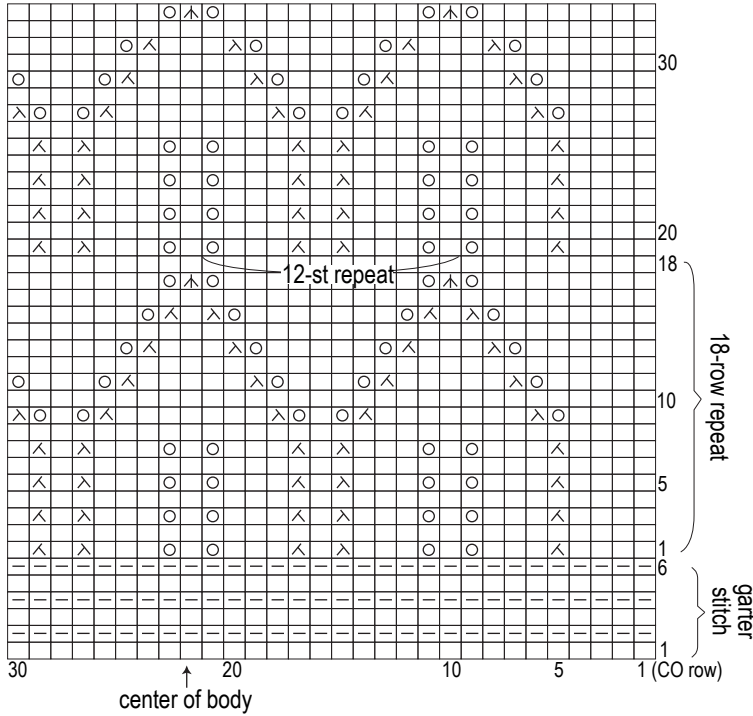


## Collar & arm edging (sc)
