

211F-19 Bird Bag



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Fine Merino [100% extra fine merino; 103 yds/94m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
 - color #214 crimson, 1 skein [10g]
 - color #223 saffron yellow, 5 skeins [145g]
 - color #229 brown, 3 skeins [70g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 4.0mm (US G) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- fabric for lining (34cm/13.39" wide, 66cm/25.98" long)

Finished measurements:

- width 32cm/12.60"
- length 31.5cm/12.40"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stranded pattern stitch: 17 sts and 21 rows
- single crochet (US): 17 sts and 20 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Body of bag: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method and work in stranded pattern stitch. Bind off in pattern.

Handles: Chain to create foundation row; work in single crochet (US). Leaving 5cm/1.97" unfolded on each edge, seam cast-on edge to bind-off edge using whipstitch.

Lining: Finish raw edges by folding in three and sewing across. With wrong sides facing, sew sides.

Finishing: With wrong sides facing, seam cast-on row with slip stitch seam. With right sides facing, seam sides with mattress stitch. Work single crochet in the round around mouth of bag (bind-off edge). Insert lining into bag and sew in place. Seam handles to bag.

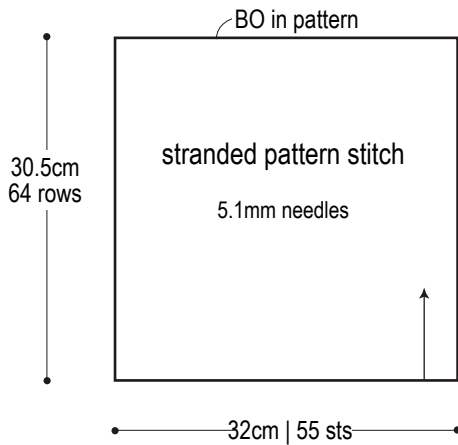
※Entire bag worked with yarn held doubled.

RS = right side
sc = single crochet (US)

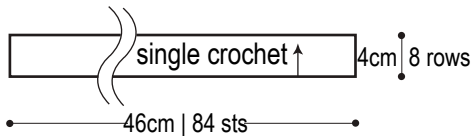
Body of bag (make 2)

Handle (make 2) 4.0mm hook

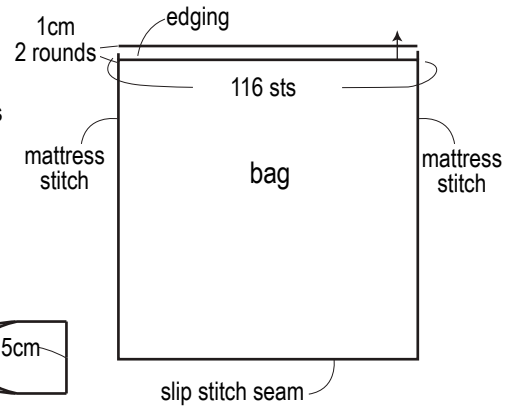
#223 saffron yellow

Finishing & edging (4.0mm hook)

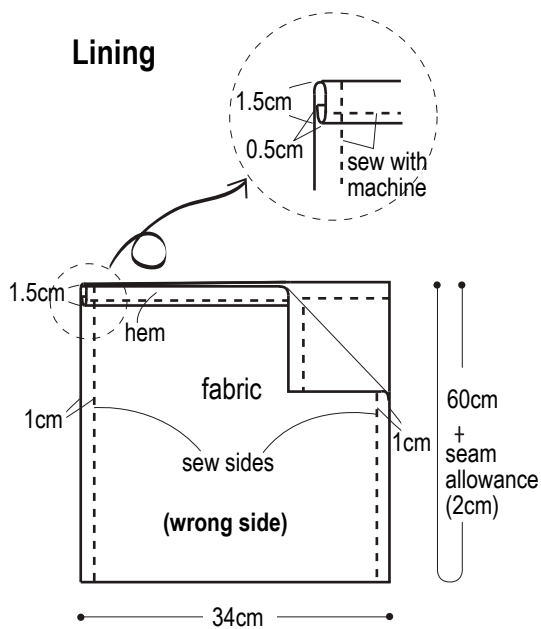


Edging (4.0mm hook)

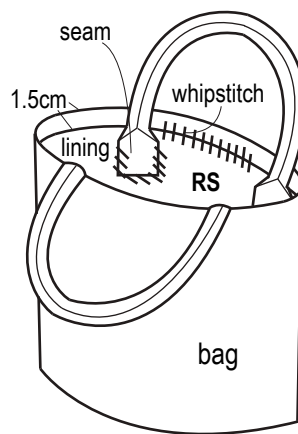

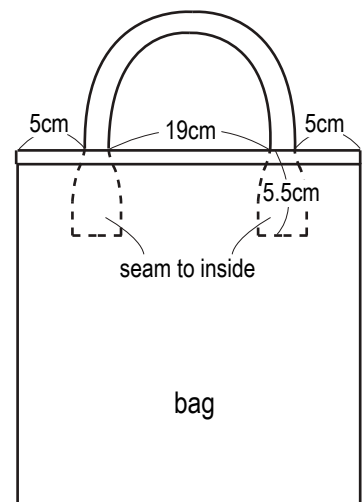
Lining
