

99-6-2 Silk Bolero



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Sarasara Silk [30% silk, 70% acrylic; 766 yds/700m per 3.53 oz./100g skein]; color #8602, 3 skeins [280g] - *discontinued; please choose appropriate substitute*

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 95cm/37.40"
- cross back width 38cm/14.96"
- length 54cm/21.26"
- sleeve length 54cm/21.26"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 21 sts and 11 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

※Entire bolero worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Body: Start body at center of back and work right and left sides according to schematics. Reverse shaping for left side. Start sleeve at center and work according to chart; reverse shaping for other half of sleeve.

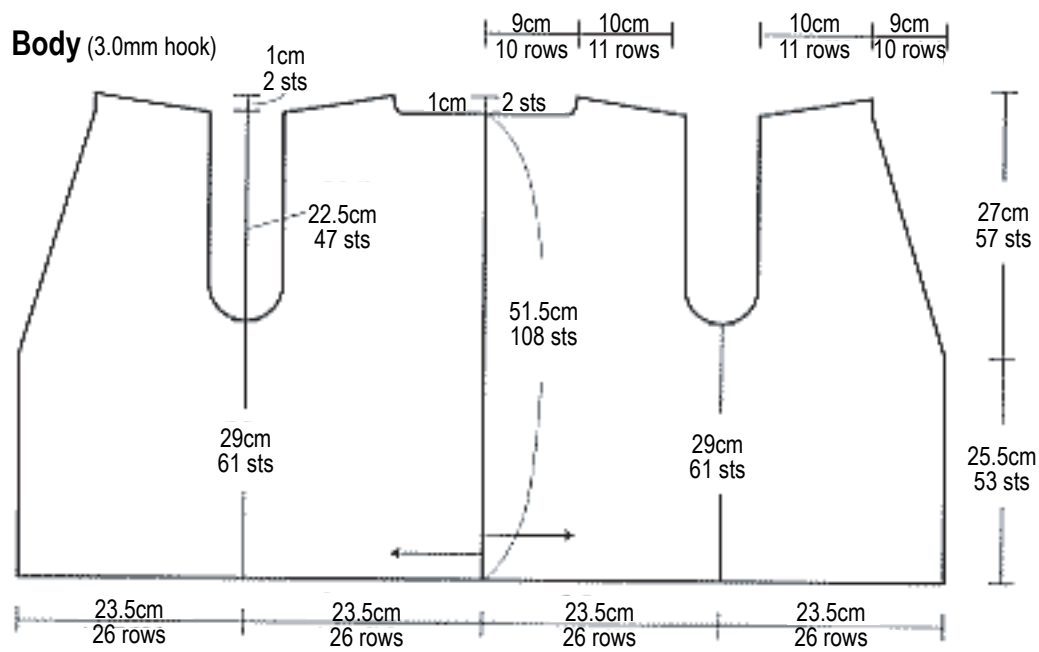
Finishing: With right sides facing, seam shoulders by working *slip 1, ch2* across. Seam sleeve to body by working *slip 1, ch1* around armscye.

Abbreviations:

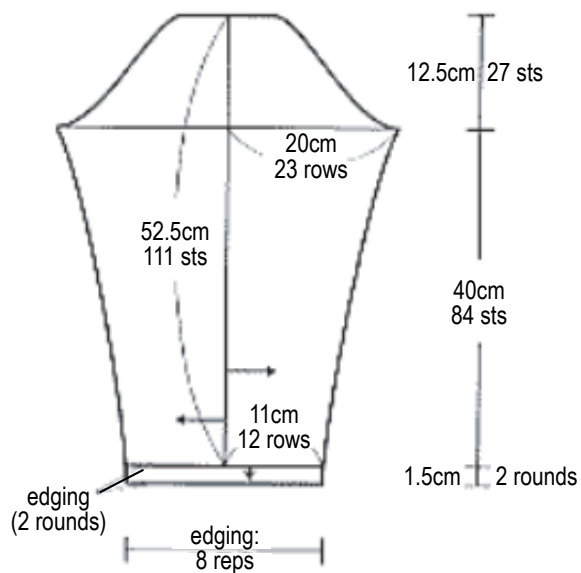
ch = chain

rep = repeat(s)

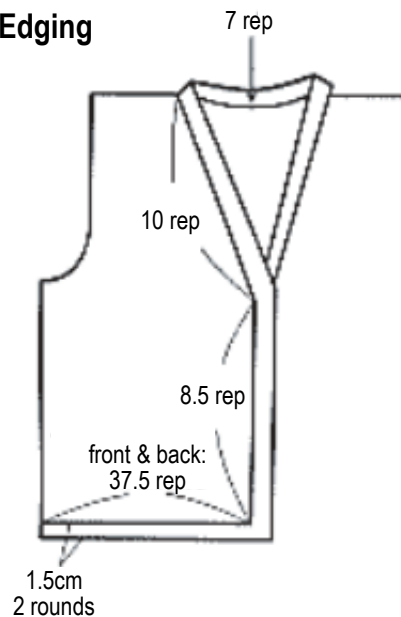
sc = single crochet (US)

Work 2 rounds of edging around collar, front edge, and hem.
Also work edging around each cuff.
