# 210-195-hat Pompom Beanie



#### Suggested yarn:

- · ladies' size:
  - Pierrot Yarns Carnival Rover [100% wool; 24 yds/22m per 3.53 oz./100g hank]; color #10 matcha, 2 hanks [200g]
  - Pierrot Yarns Standard [66% rayon, 34% polyester; 481 yds/440m per 1.76 oz./50g cone]; color #5401 gold lamé, 1 cone [10g]
  - Pierrot Yarns Kirara [89% acetate, 11% polyester; 1892 yds/1730m per 1.76 oz./50g cone]; color #4824 black, 1 cone [5g]
- · kids' size:
  - Pierrot Yarns Carnival Rover [100% wool; 24 yds/22m per 3.53 oz./100g hank]; color #8 brown, 2 hanks [170g]
  - Pierrot Yarns Cocotto Wool [97% wool, 3% polyester; 81 yds/74m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
    - color #21 off-white, 1 skein [10g]
    - color #24 orange, 1 skein [10g]
    - color #25 pink, 1 skein [10g]



#### **Tools/Notions:**

• 10.0mm (US N) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

#### Finished measurements:

- both sizes: head circumference 57cm/22.44"
- · length (ladies' size): 20cm/7.87"
- length (kids' size): 18.5cm/7.28"

#### Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- double crochet (US): 4.5 sts and 2.5 rows
- single crochet (US): 4.5 sts and 6 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

#### **Crochet Tips**

Create magic ring, ch3 for turning post, and crochet according to chart.

For ladies' size, make pompom A and B; attach to side of hat. For kids' size, make pompom C; attach to top of hat.

#### Abbreviations:

ch = chain


dc = double crochet (US)

m = magic ring

sc = single crochet (US)



# **Pompom instructions**







Make pompoms by wrapping yarn around some cardboard. Remove yarn from cardboard and tie a knot in the middle. Cut each loop on both sides.

If necessary, trim ends to achieve round shape.

\*As lamé yarn is thin and relatively inelastic, please tie it tightly with strong thread such as kite string to avoid breakage.
