

23-34 Silk Shawl



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Silk100 Fingering [100% silk; 344 yds/315m per 1.76 oz./50g cone]; color #6012 light heliotrope, 4 cones [195g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- width 45cm/17.72"
- length 129cm/50.79"

Gauge:

- pattern stitch: 43 sts and 14 rows = 10cm/4" square
- each motif should measure 7cm/2.76" across

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.


Crochet Tips

Start motifs with magic ring, then crochet according to schematic. Make 6 motifs, joining together as you go, then crochet body of shawl. Work 1 row of double crochet (US), connecting to strip of motifs as you go. Work two rows of edging along long sides of shawl.

Abbreviations:

m = magic ring
