

211w-25 Marshmallow Cotton Hooded Baby Blanket and Doughnut Baby Rattle



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Marshmallow Cotton [100% cotton; 153 yds/140m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; undyed natural white, 16 skeins [470g]
- Pierrot Yarns Hidamari [75% cotton, 25% ramie; 82 yds/75m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
 - color #74 pale mandarin orange, 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #78 pale pink, 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #79 wasabi, 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #80 lavender, 1 skein [small amount]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.2mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C), 3.0mm (approx. US C or D), and 3.5mm (US E) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 10g/0.35 oz. polyfiber stuffing
- 1 plastic bell (15mm/0.59" diameter)

Finished measurements:

- blanket: 90cm/35.43" square
- rattle: refer to schematics

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 21 sts and 31 rows
- single crochet (US): 17 sts and 25 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Doughnut Rattle: Chain to cast on and work sc (US) in the round. Insert stuffing and plastic bell; whipstitch cast-on and bind-off edges together. Crochet bobbles and fasten to rattle.

Body of blanket: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method; work in stockinette stitch and pattern stitch.

Hood: Cast on as for body of blanket; work in stockinette stitch. Work edging B along cast-on edge.

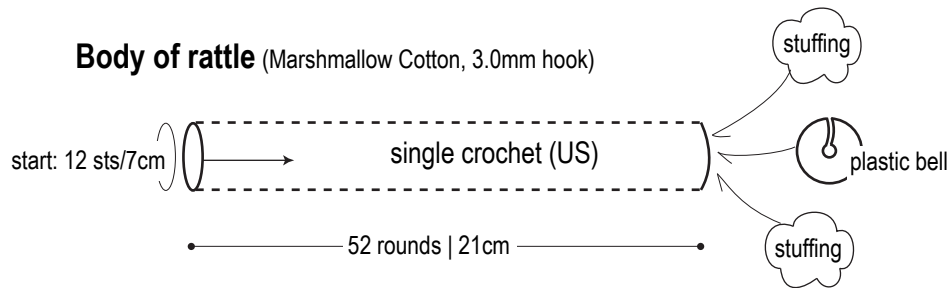
Finishing: Place hood and blanket together with wrong sides facing as shown. Seam together by working 1 row of edging.

※Always work Marshmallow Cotton with 2 strands held together. Work Hidamari with a single strand.

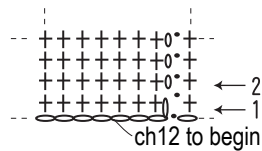

CO = cast on
dc = double crochet (US)
rep = pattern repeat(s)
RS = right side
sc = single crochet (US)
WS = wrong side
= rows-stitches-times

Doughnut rattle

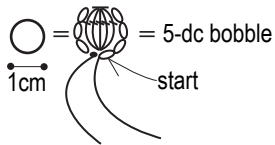


Body instructions (Marshmallow Cotton, 3.0mm hook)

2.5mm hook



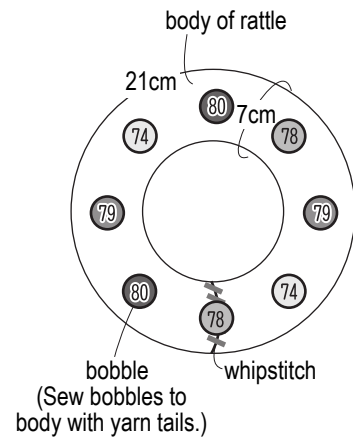
Leave 12cm/4.72" tail at beginning and end.

- = #80 lavender

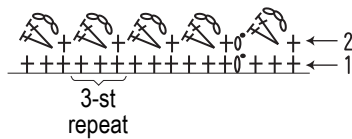

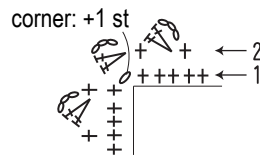
Edging A (Marshmallow Cotton)

3.5mm hook



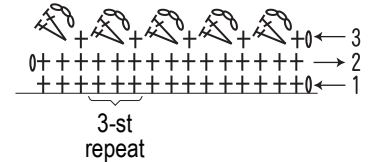
Corners (Marshmallow Cotton)
