

28-BK4 Sleeveless Baby Shirt



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns UV Cut Baby [100% cotton; 93 yds/85m per 0.88 oz./25g skein];
 - color #3 baby pink or 4 baby blue, 2 skeins [45g]
 - color #1 white, 2 skeins [40g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 5 buttons (15mm/0.59")

Finished measurements:

- size 12 months:
 - chest 58cm/22.83"
 - cross back width 22cm/8.66"
 - length 30.5cm/12.01"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 21 sts and 23.5 rows

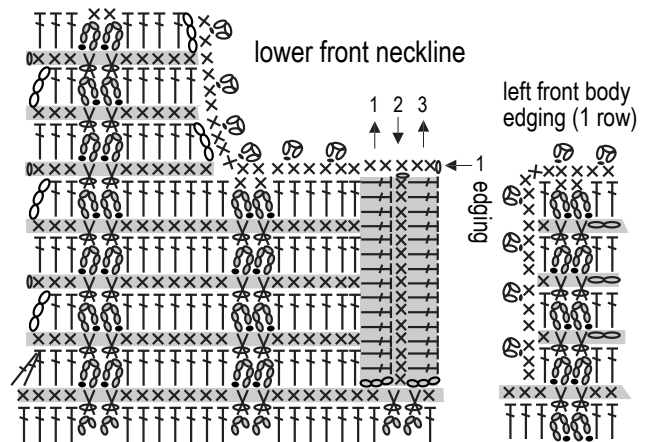
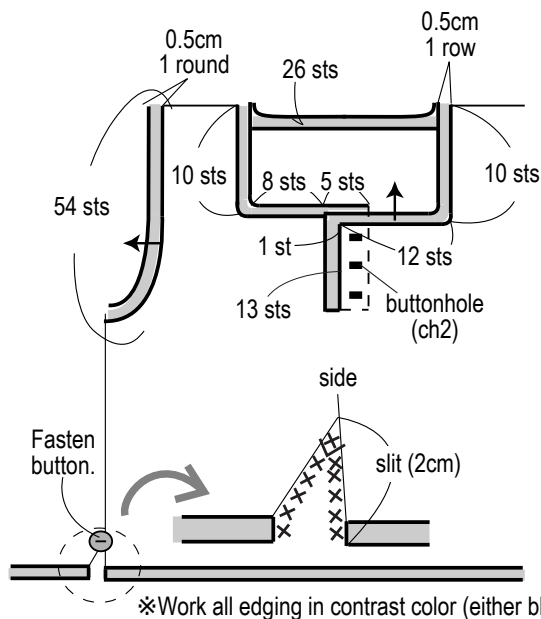
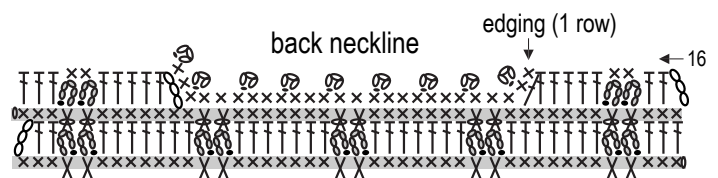
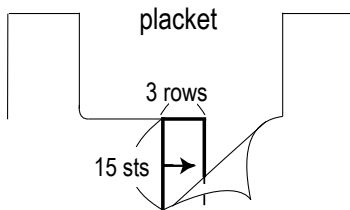
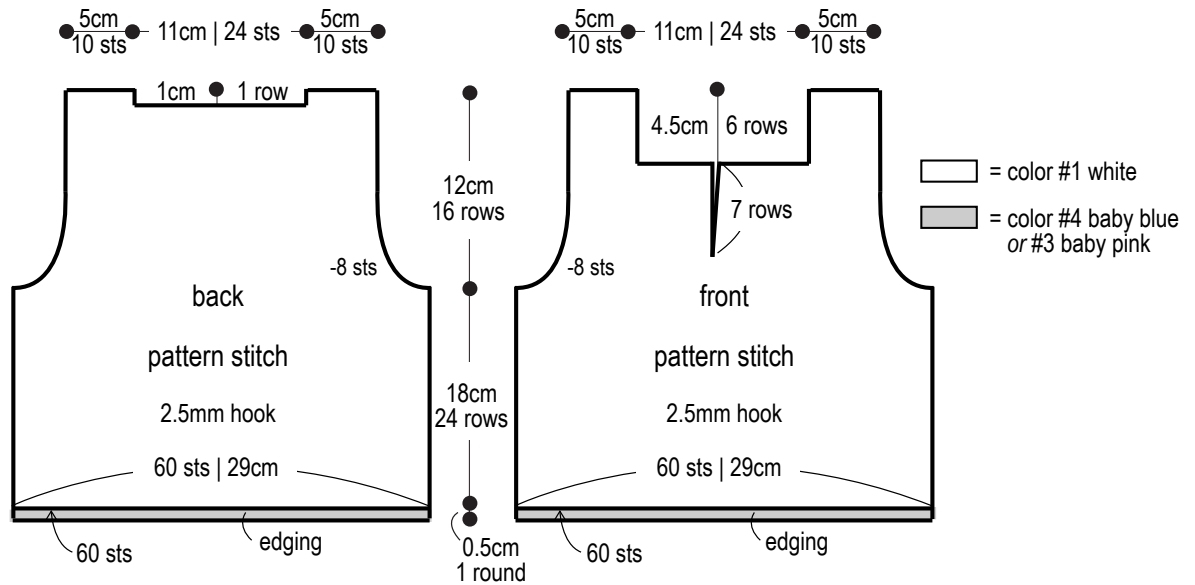
Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Body: With color #4 (baby blue), chain to create foundation row. [For girls, use color #3 (baby pink).] Work back and front body in pattern stitch, changing color every row as shown in schematic. Seam shoulders with color #4 using chain seam. Working into right front body, work front placket. Seam side with chain seam, leaving first 3 rows unseamed. Work edging along hem, neckline, front placket, and armholes. Fasten buttons to front placket and each side of hem.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain



※Work all edging in contrast color (either blue or pink).

※For girl's vest, make right front placket on top of left front placket.
