

24-25-16 Jacket



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Nouvelle Silk [30% silk, 70% wool; 98 yds/90m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #5905 yellow, 8 skeins [300g] - *discontinued; please choose appropriate substitute*
- Pierrot Yarns Super Kid Mohair [75% kid mohair, 25% nylon; 306 yds/208m per 0.88 oz./25g skein]; color #5806 green, 2 skeins [45g] - *discontinued; please choose appropriate substitute*

Tools/Notions:

- 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 4 buttons (18mm/0.71")

Finished measurements:

- bust 96cm/37.80"
- cross back width 36cm/14.17"
- length 60cm/23.62"
- sleeve length 52.5cm/20.67"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 24 sts and 34 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

※When using Super Kid Mohair, use 2 strands of yarn held together.

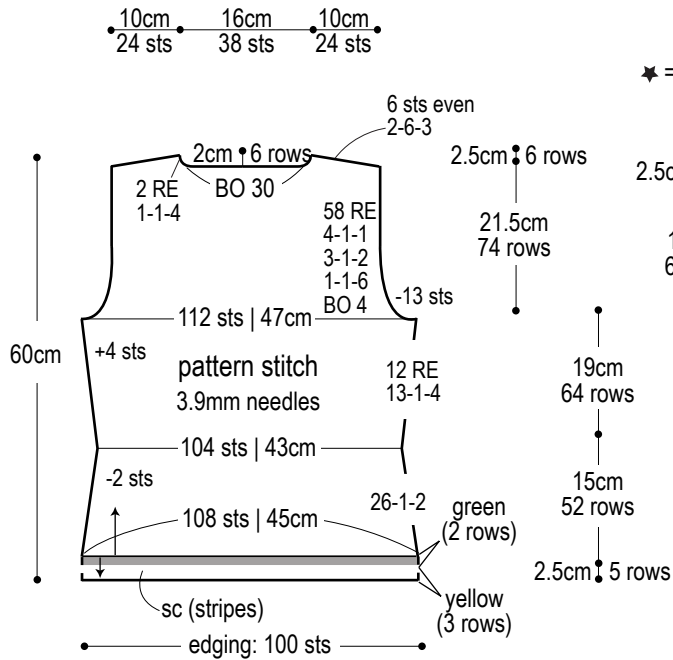
Body and sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. The pattern stitch is a slip stitch (mosaic) pattern with the yellow yarn passed; refer to schematics.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with slip stitch. Work single crochet (US) in stripes along hem, front band, and neckline. Do the same at the cuffs. While working right front band in sc, work buttonholes.

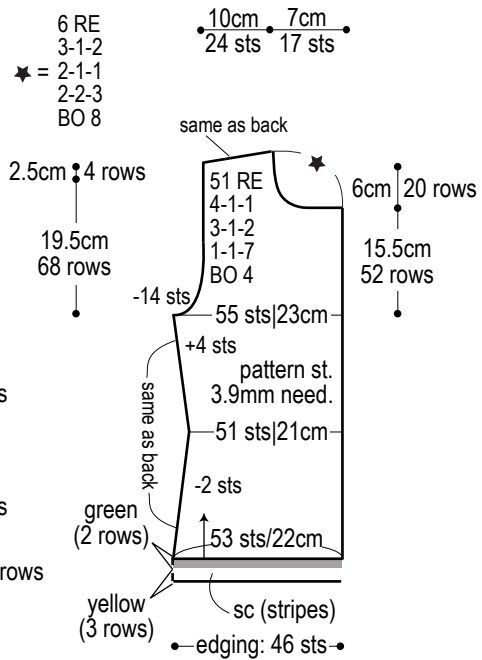
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
PU = pick up
RE = row(s) even
sc = single crochet (US)
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

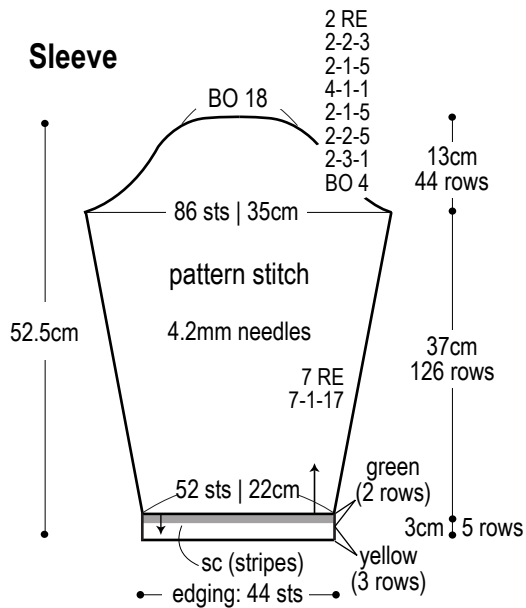

Front

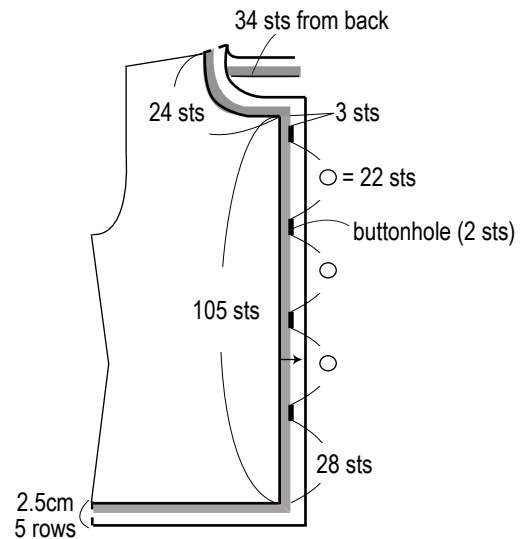


Sleeve

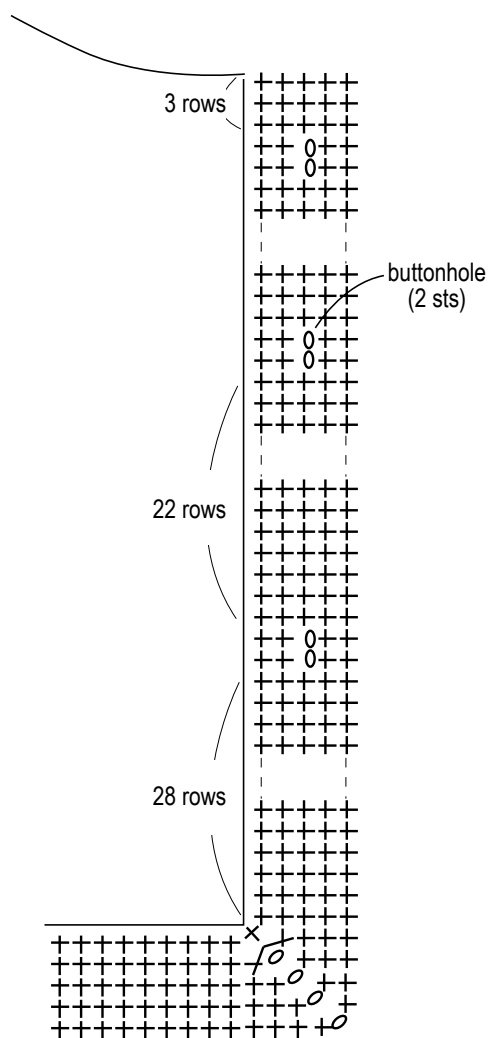


Collar, front band, hem

(2.5mm hook)

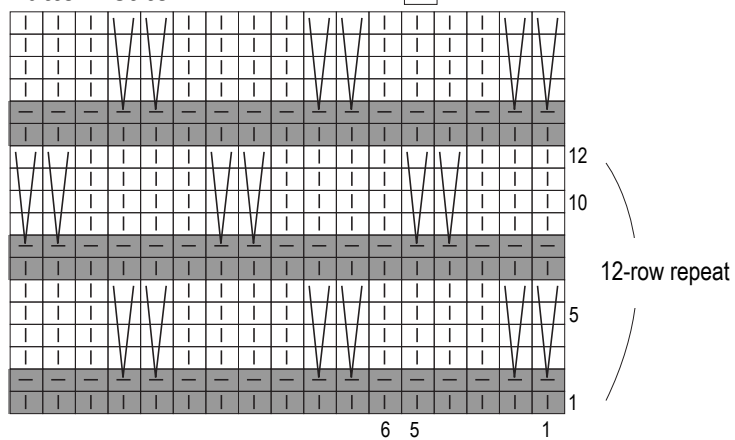


Edging (2.5mm hook)
