

27-19 Cable-front Tee



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Ramie 100 [100% ramie; 109 yds/100m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #2 beige, 6 skeins [220g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 2½) and 3.3mm (approx. US 3) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (US 2½) circular knitting needle or size necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

Finished measurements:

- bust 84cm/33.07"
- cross back width 35cm/13.78"
- length 56.5cm/22.24"
- sleeve length 11.5cm/4.53"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 24 sts and 30 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Body and sleeves: Use crochet chain cast-on method, then work 5 rows in garter stitch. Continue in stockinette stitch. Work center panel of front body in pattern stitch. Work sleeves in garter stitch and stockinette stitch as well. Shape waist at sides using fully fashioned decreases and increases. Shape armscye by binding off stitches as indicated and decreasing at edges. Place collar stitches on stitch holder.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off. Pick up stitches along neckline and work collar in garter stitch. Bind off loosely from wrong side. Seam sleeves to body with slip stitch.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

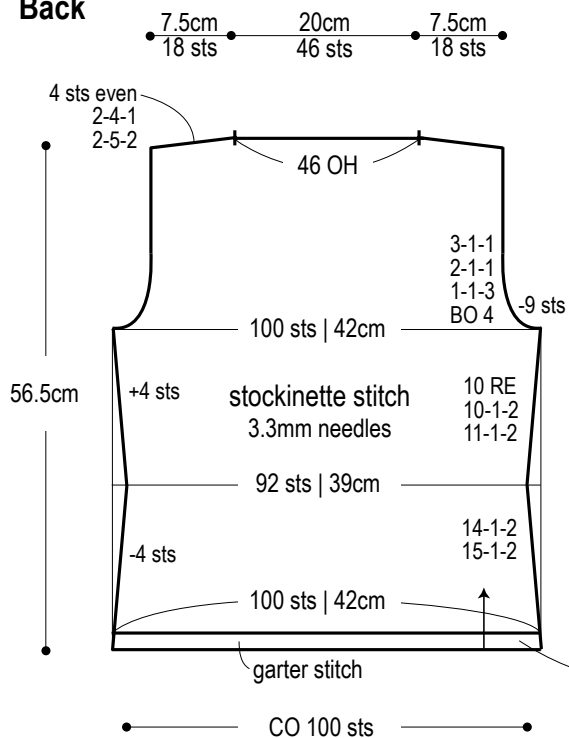
OH = on hold (i.e., place stitches on holder)

PU = pick up

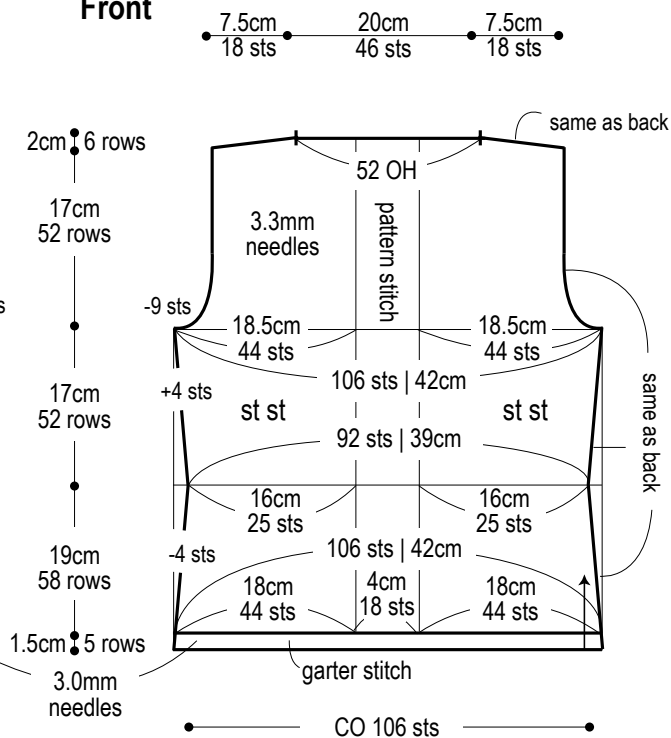
RE = row(s) even

= rows-stitches-times

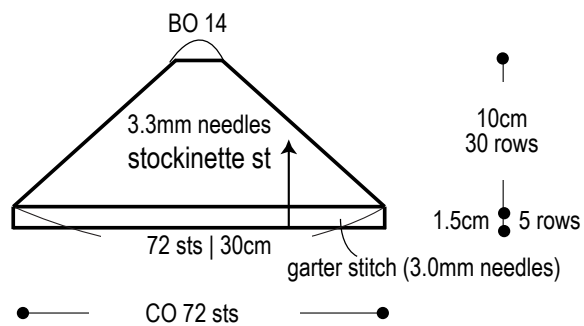

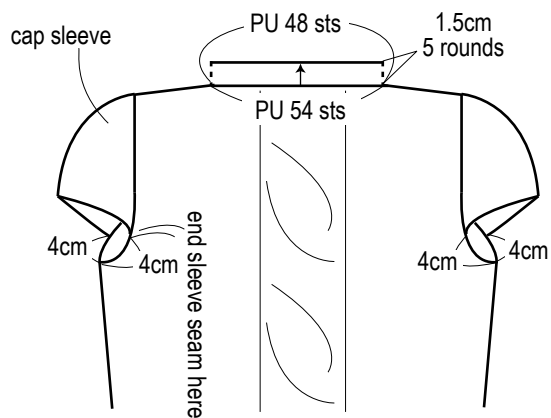
Front



Sleeve

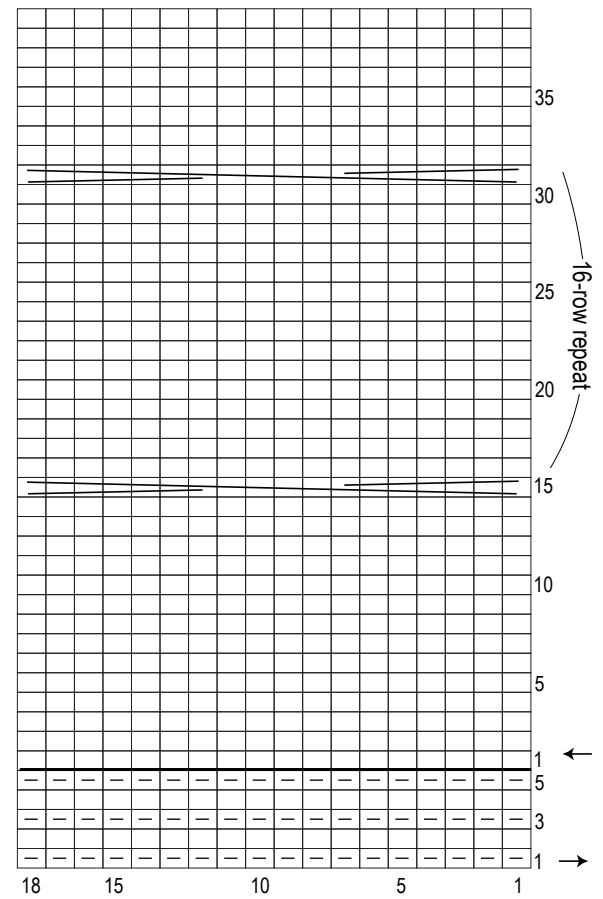


Collar (garter stitch, 3.0mm circular needle)



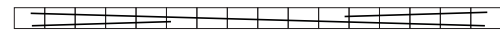
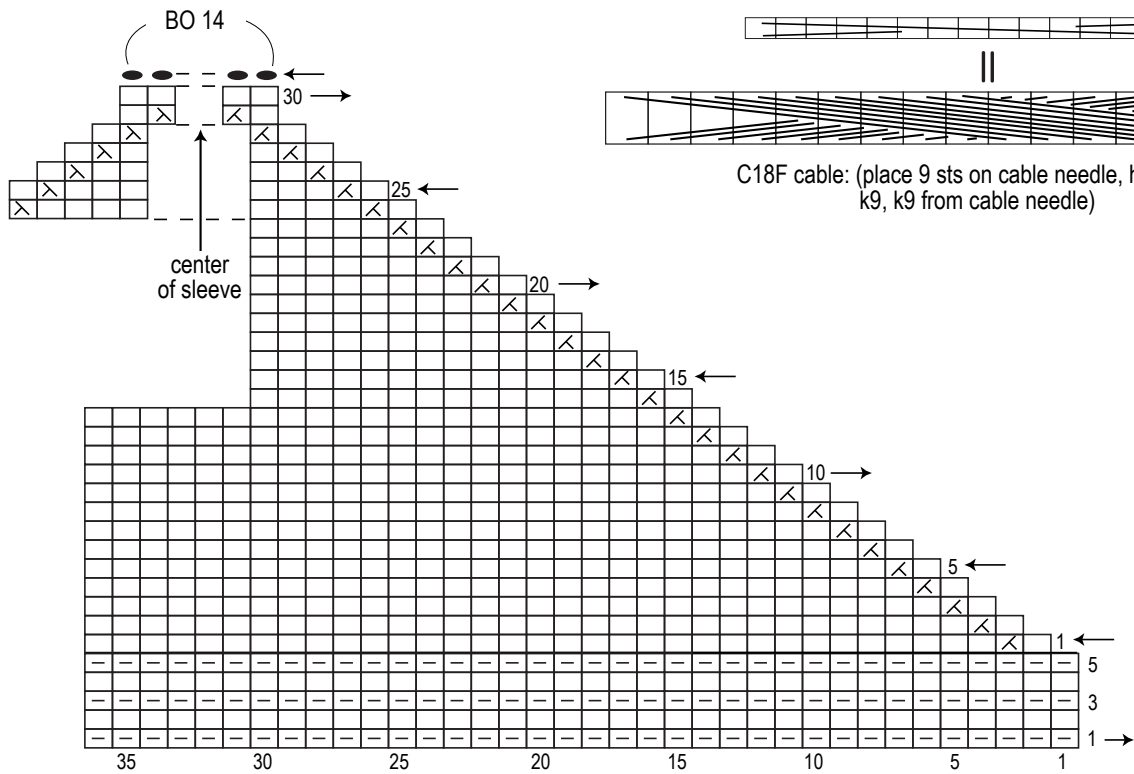
Pattern stitch

□ = □ knit

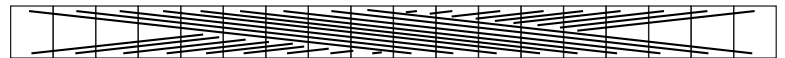


Sleeve instructions
