

# 211w-24 Bruna Hooded Poncho



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Bruna [49% acrylic, 43% wool, 8% rayon; 60 yds/55m per 1.76 oz./50g skein];
  - 90cm/35.43" size: color #10 brown, 6 skeins [290g]
  - 120cm/47.24" size: color #06 orange, 8 skeins [375g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 5.7mm (approx. US 9) and 6.0mm (US 10) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 5.7mm (approx. US 9) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- darning needles
- 1 button (30mm/1.18") per poncho

## Finished measurements:

Japanese children's clothing sizes are based on the child's height in centimeters. 90cm size (35.43") and 120cm size (47.24") correspond roughly to US children's sizes 3T and 6.

- 90cm/35.43" size: length 34.5cm/13.58"
- 120cm/47.24" size: length 41cm/16.14"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch, stockinette stitch: 12 sts and 18 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Knitting Tips

**Front and back body:** Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch and stockinette stitch, working evenly spaced decreases. Starting from the slit at front (where front placket will be), work right front and left front separately. Pick up live stitches from hem and work k1p1 ribbing around hem. Place stitches at cuff area on stitch holder; bind the rest off in pattern. Seam front and back of poncho together using mattress stitch. Pick up stitches from cuff area at hem and work cuff in k1p1 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern (as for the hem). Seam area from cuff to main hem opening of poncho by placing wrong sides of front and back hem together and whipstitching them together.


**Hood:** Pick up stitches around front and back neckline; knit hood according to schematics. Seam bind-off edges together with RIGHT sides facing using slip stitch. Pick up stitches around hood and neck slit. Work front placket and hood edging in 1p1 ribbing, working buttonholes in upper left placket. Bind off as for hem. Seam bottom of upper front placket to neck slit (stitches on hold) using rows-to-stitches mattress stitch. Seam lower front placket to upper front placket on the wrong side of upper front placket using blind stitch. Attach buttons to lower front placket.





## Abbreviations:

BO = bind off  
CO = cast on  
DPNs = double-pointed needles  
PU = pick up  
RE = row(s) even  
rep = (pattern) repeat(s)  
### = rows-stitches-times
