

amicomo9-16 Dress-up Set



Suggested yarn:

- clothing: Grignasco Flavia Baby [100% merino wool; 219 yds/200m per 1.76 oz./50g skein];
 - color #070 navy, 1 skein [8g]
 - color #173 brown, 1 skein [8g]
 - color #195 cardinal red, 1 skein [8g]
 - color #184 green tea, 1 skein [15g]
 - color #638 cream, 1 skein [10g]
- bear: Pierrot Yarns Yuttari Acrylic [100% antibacterial deodorant acrylic; 73 yds/67m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #90 cocoa, 2 skeins [75g]
 - color #92 smoke beige, 1 skein [20g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) and 5.0mm (US H) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- tapestry needle
- 3 buttons (10mm/0.39") for clothing
- 2 buttons (11.5mm/0.45") for bear's eyes
- cotton or polyfiber stuffing

Finished measurements:

- see schematics

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- No gauge information is provided in the original pattern.

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Trouser legs: ch31 and join into the round; crochet two tubes. Place the two tubes together so that the column of turning posts on each one aligns with the other. Whipstitch 10 stitches at the top of the tubes, joining the trouser legs.

Torso: Work 39 stitches into bind-off edge of trousers and work 3 rows. Slip stitches and leave yarn uncut (it will be used later). For back section only, work 1 row. Using yarn tail, begin working in the round (rounds 4-10).

Finishing: Work stitches into front edge; work overall bib. Work edging, referring to schematics. Crochet straps and attach.

Bear: Create magic ring and work individual parts in single crochet (US) according to schematics, increasing and decreasing as indicated. When finished, leave yarn tail to be used for seaming later. Seam parts together with yarn tails. Insert stuffing into head; attach eyes, nose, and ears where shown. In the event seaming is difficult, temporarily remove some stuffing. Without inserting stuffing into ears, fold each ear in two, and making front side somewhat round, whipstitch to head. Embroider tip of nose with brown yarn. Insert stuffing into head and torso as well as arms and legs; attach smoothly.

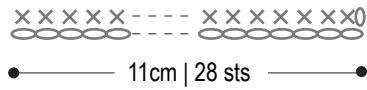
※ Finished size of amigurumi is an estimate. Gauge and tightness of stuffing will change the final size to some extent.

- sc = single crochet (US)

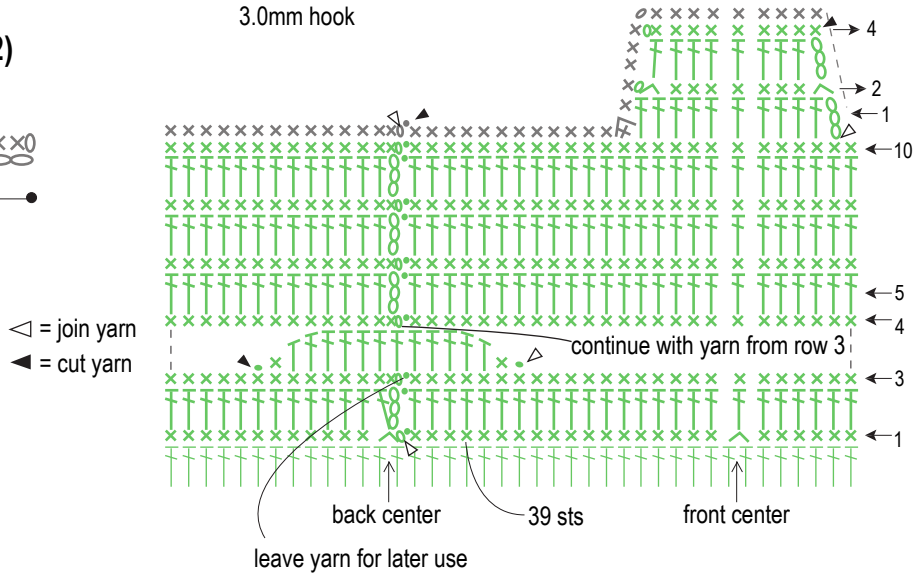
Shoulder straps (make 2)

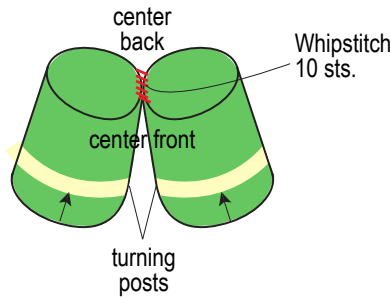
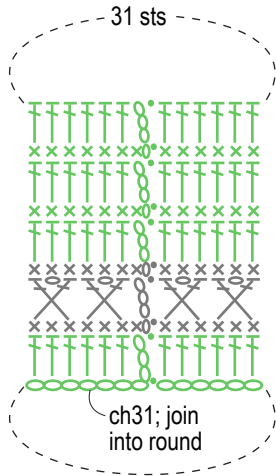
Torso/bib

3.0mm hook

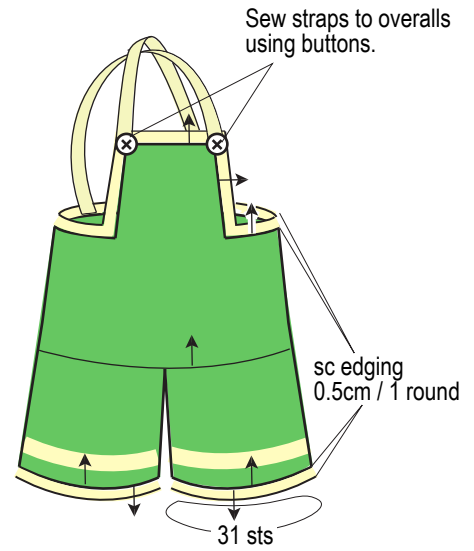


Trouser legs (make 2)

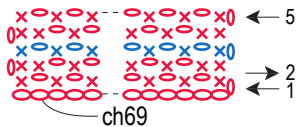

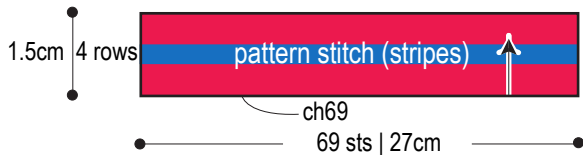
Scarf: Chain to begin. Work pattern stitch in stripes. Attach fringe to each end.

- = #070 navy
- = #172 brown
- = #184 green tea
- = #195 cardinal red
- = #638 cream

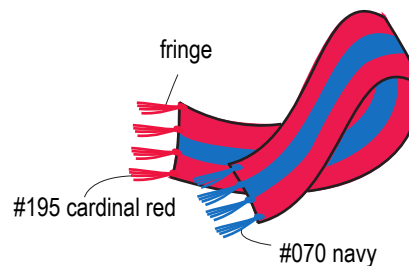
Scarf pattern stitch



Scarf (3.0mm hook)



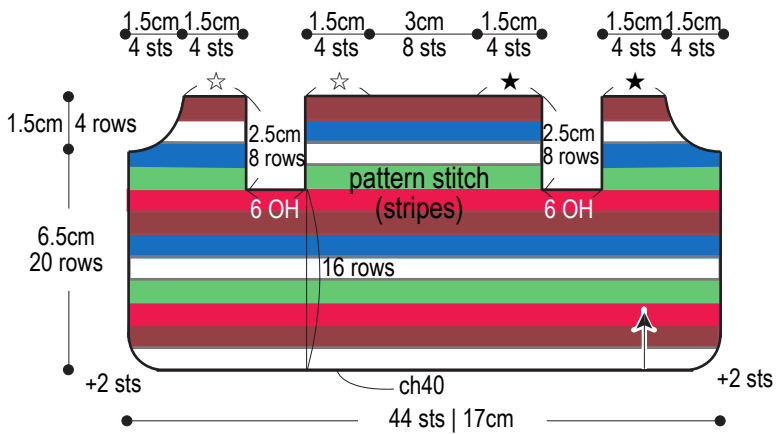
Finished scarf

Using 3 strands 4cm/1.57" long in each color (#070 navy and #195 cardinal red), fold in half and attach to end of scarf. Attach in 4 places on each end.

Vest (3.0mm hook)



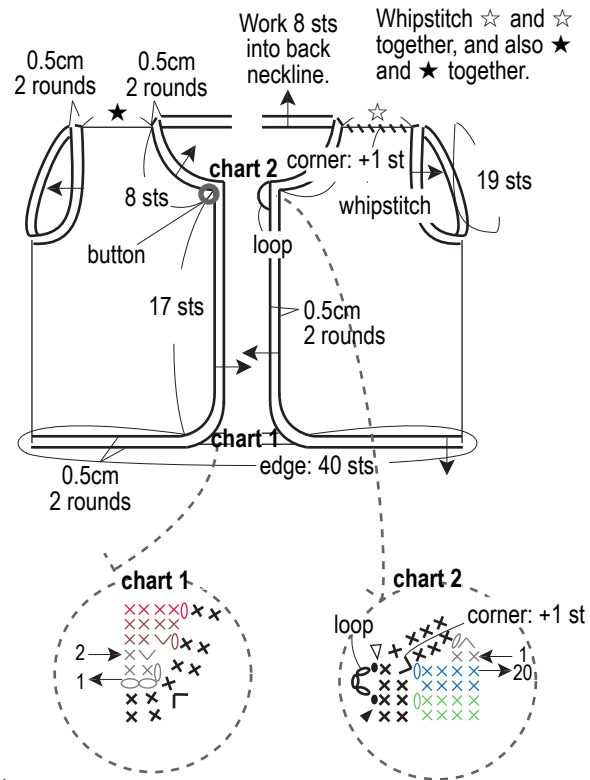
Front band, collar, hem & cuff edging

single crochet, 3.0mm hook, #070 navy

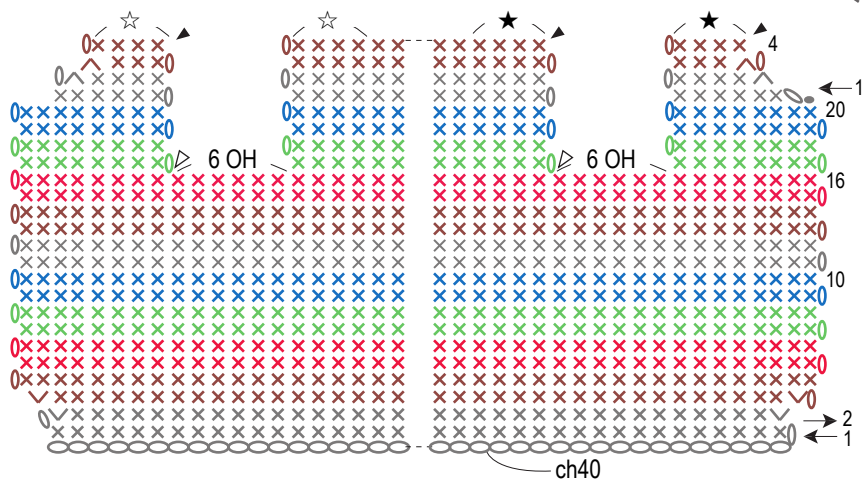
Crochet Tips

Vest: Chain to begin; work in single crochet (US) stripes. Starting from sleeve area, work right and left fronts as well as back separately.

Finishing: Place ☆ and ☆ together, as well as ★ and ★, and whipstitch. Work edging in the round around hem, front back, and neckline. Fasten loop to left front. Also work edging in the round around sleeves, forming cuffs. Attach button.



Vest pattern (3.0mm hook)

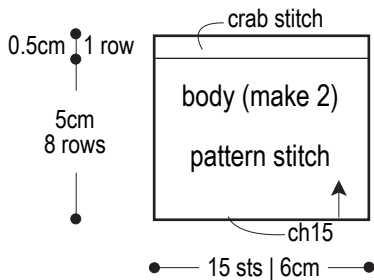


Crochet Tips

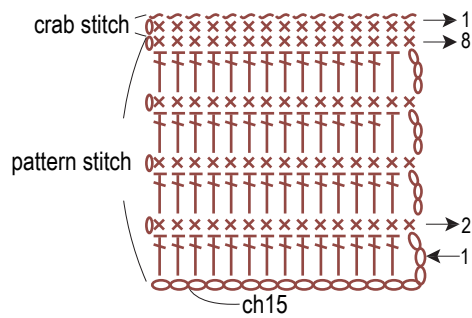
Body of bag: Chain to begin; work in pattern stitch and single crochet (US). Make 2.

Finishing: With wrong sides facing, seam 2 sides of bag with single crochet (US). Crochet loop where indicated. Braid yarn to create strap and seam ends of strap to each side of bag. Attach button.

Bag (3.0mm hook)

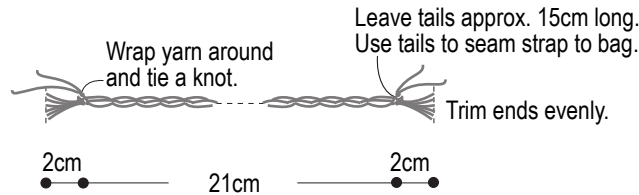


Pattern stitch for bag (3.0mm hook)

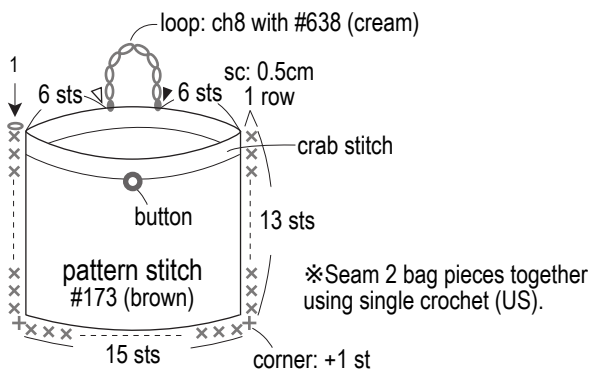

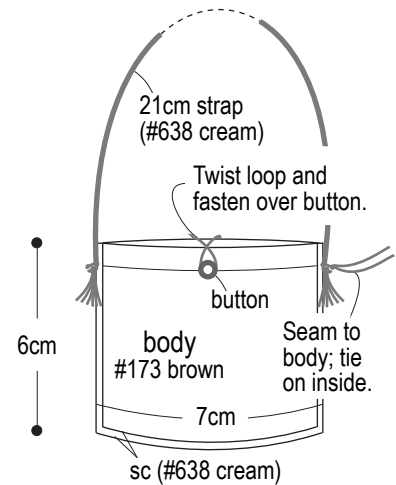
Make a 3-strand braid with 6 strands (each 35cm/13.78") long.



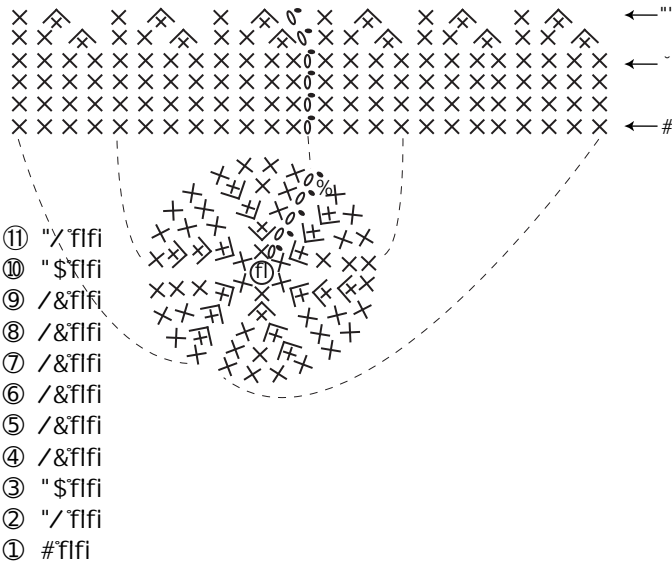

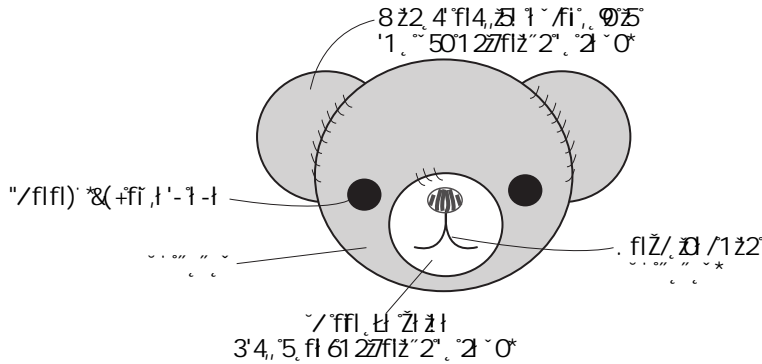
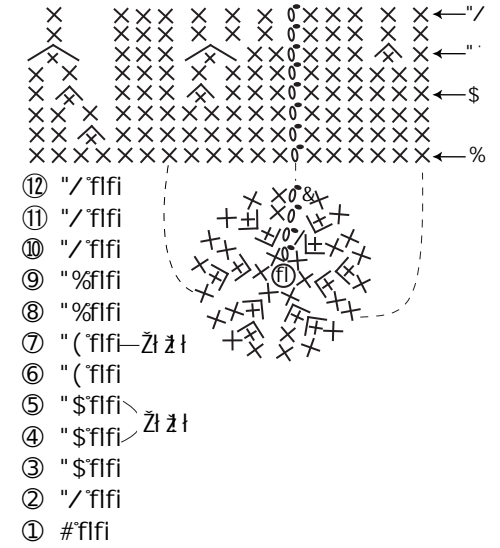

Head (make 1)

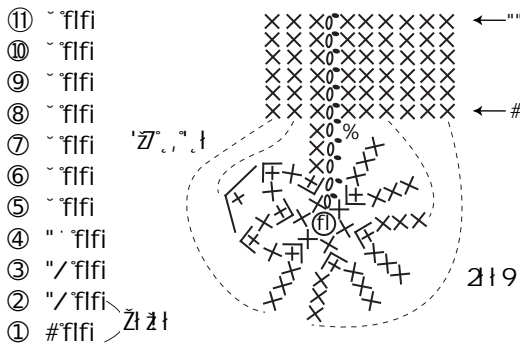


Torso (make 1)

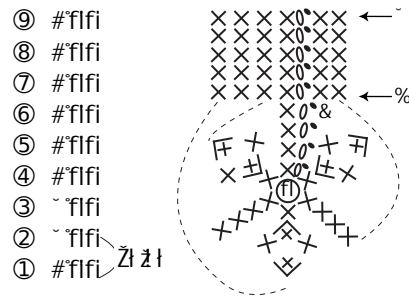

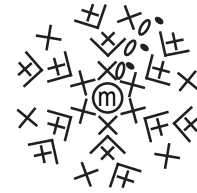
