

211w-27 Impeto Jacket



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Impeto [60% alpaca, 40% acrylic; 66 yds/60m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - kids' size: color #4 variegated green, 10 skeins [380g]
 - ladies' size: color #4 variegated green, 15 skeins [565g]

Tools/Notions:

- 6.0mm (US 10), 6.3mm (approx. US 10 or 10½), and 6.6mm (approx. US 10½) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- kids' size: 3 light wooden buttons (25mm/0.98")
- ladies' size: 3 dark wooden buttons (25mm/0.98")

Finished measurements:

- kids' size:
 - bust 78cm/30.71"
 - center back sleeve-to-cuff measurement 52cm/20.47"
 - length 67cm/26.38"
- ladies' size:
 - bust 98cm/38.58"
 - center back sleeve-to-cuff measurement 74.5cm/29.33"
 - length 82cm/32.28"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch (with 6.6mm needles): 12.5 sts and 17 rows
- pattern stitch (with 6.0mm needles): 14 sts and 17 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

※Kids' and ladies' sizes are worked in the same manner.




Body and sleeves: Cast on using long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch and stockinette stitch. At the same time that you are knitting the front body, work button bands in k1p1 ribbing, being sure to work buttonholes in right front band. Shape sides and raglan edges with fully fashioned decreases.

Finishing: Seam raglan edges with mattress stitch. Seam underarm gusset with Kitchener stitch, then continue seaming sides and sleeves with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline (including edge of front button band) and work collar in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern. Knit pockets in stockinette stitch and pattern stitch. Attach to jacket where indicated. Attach buttons to left front band.

Abbreviations:


BO = bind off
CO = cast on
k = knit
OH = on hold (i.e., place on stitch holder)
PU = pick up
RE = row(s) even
sl = slip stitch
YO = yarn over
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times




Pattern stitch

(6.6mm needles, kid's size)






Customize your buttons by threading various yarns or embroidery thread through the holes.

Pocket (make 2, kids' size)




Collar (k1p1 ribbing, kids' size)




*Use wooden button with decorative holes for kids' jacket. Buttons can be customized using various thread arrangements & colors.




Right sleeve




*Reverse shaping of right front and right sleeve for left front and left sleeve.



Collar (k1p1 ribbing, ladies' size)






Pocket (make 2, ladies' size)



$\boxed{\text{L}} \boxed{\text{O}} \boxed{\text{b}} = \text{sl2 over, k1, YO, k1}$




1. Insert right needle into third stitch on left needle. Slip third stitch over the first two on left needle.



2. Knit 1 stitch (from left needle).



3. YO, knit 1 (from left needle).



4. Finished stitch.
