

28-2 Urara Bolero



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Urara [60% cotton, 20% acrylic, 20% rayon; 137 yds/125m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #302 beige, 6 skeins [220g] - *discontinued; please choose appropriate substitute*

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 88cm/34.65"
- cross back width 35cm/13.78"
- length 46.5cm/18.31"
- sleeve length 37cm/14.57"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 22 sts and 30 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

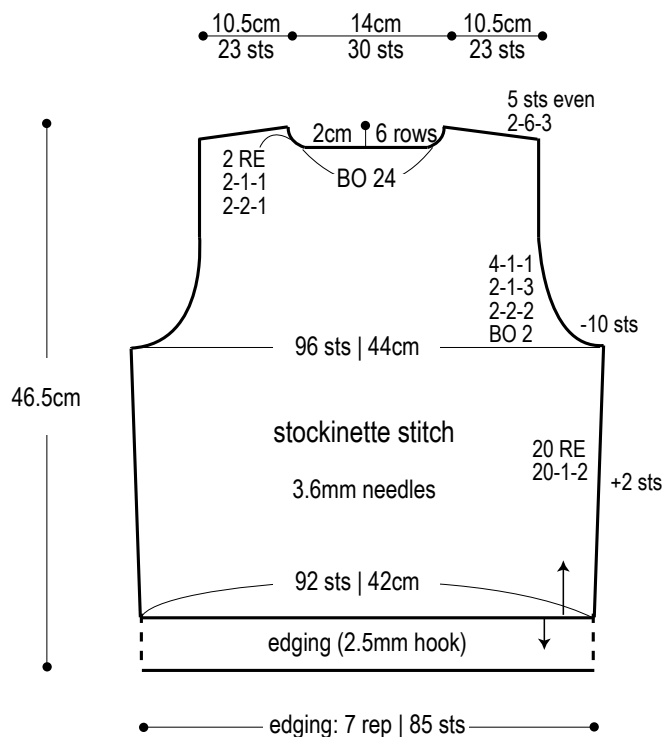
Body and sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in stockinette stitch according to schematic. Form curve at front hem by increasing with backwards-loop cast-on method.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with slip stitch. Work edging along neckline, front and back hem, and cuffs.

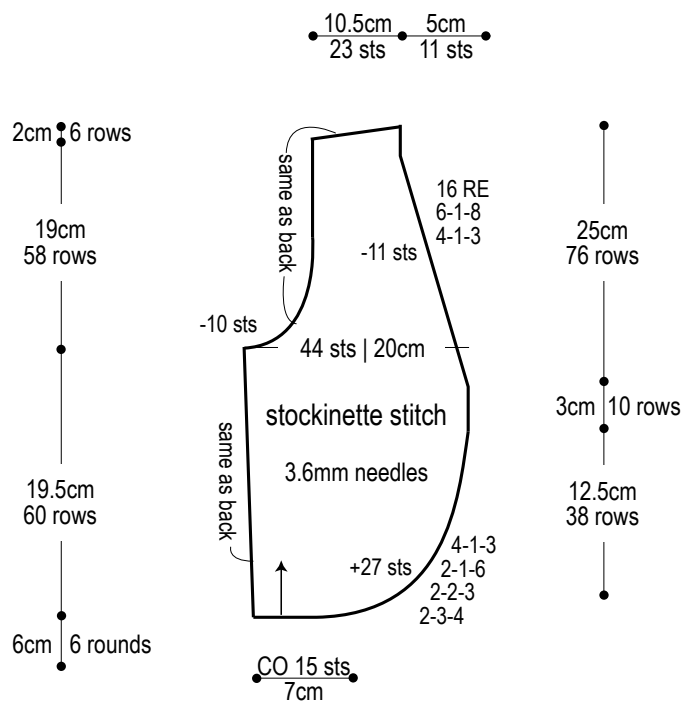
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
RE = row(s) even
rep = pattern repeat(s)
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

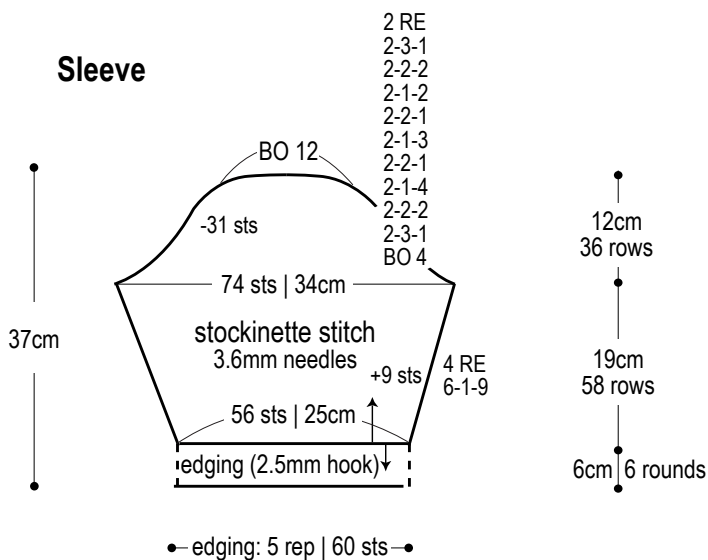

Front

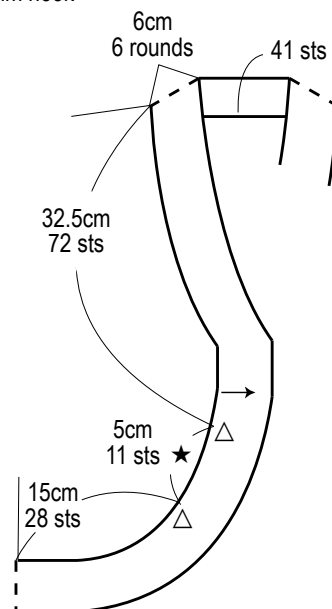


Sleeve
