

211F-18 Scallop Shrug



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Fine Merino [100% extra fine merino; 103 yds/94m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #214 crimson, 8 skeins [225g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.9mm (approx. US 6) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- center back neck-to-cuff 70.5cm/27.76"
- length 47cm/18.50"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 22 sts and 30 rows
- pattern stitch B: 1 repeat = 16 sts and 7 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

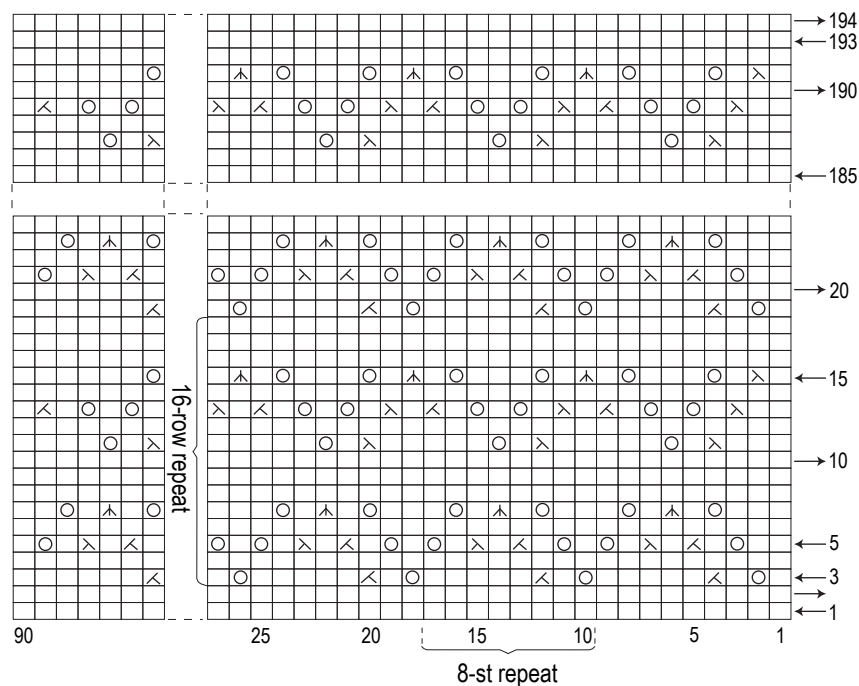
Shrug: Start from center back, casting on with crochet provisional cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch A. Work 92 rows even, then place markers. Decrease at each edge to shape sleeves. Work other half of shrug by picking up loose stitches from provisional cast-on edge. Work second half in the same manner as the first.

Finishing: Seam sleeves from cuff up to markers. For collar and hem, use slip stitch to pick up live stitches one stitch in from the edge. Work pattern stitch B in the round. For cuffs, also pick up stitches from body. Work pattern stitch B in the round.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
pm = place marker
PU = pick up
RE = row(s) even
= rows-stitches-times

$\square = \square \text{ knit}$
