

Striped Bouclé Tunic



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Sawayaka Bouclé [70% cotton, 20% rayon, 10% ramie; 80 yds/73m per 0.88 oz./25g skein];
 - color #1 white, 6 skeins [130g]
 - color #19 mint green, 8 skeins [180g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 94cm/37.01"
- cross back width 34cm/13.39"
- length 85cm/33.46"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 20 sts and 27 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

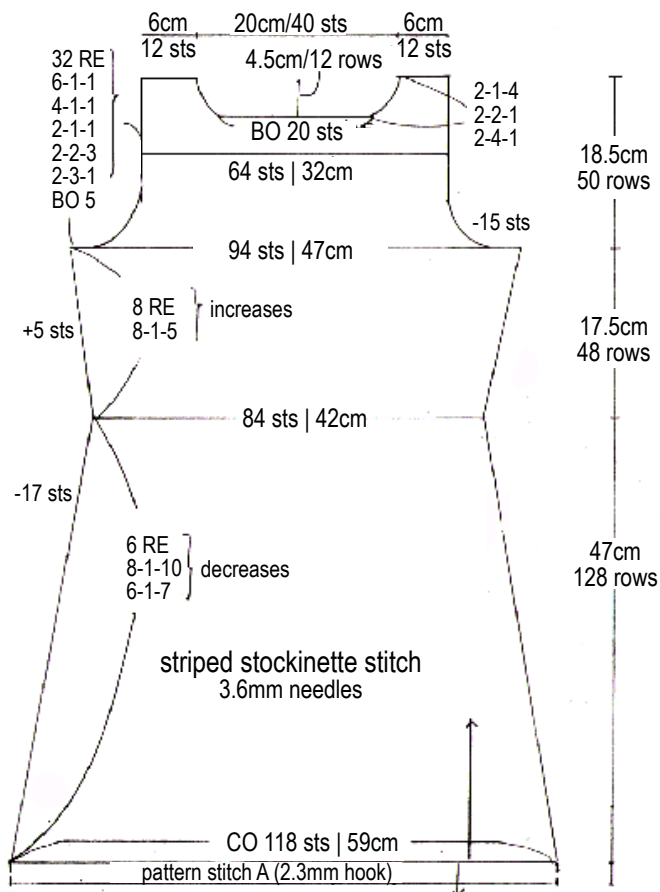
Knitting Tips

Cast on for front/back with long-tail cast-on method. Work up to shoulders, putting remaining stitches on stitch holders. Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Crochet collar edging in pattern stitch B. Crochet cuff edging in pattern stitch C. Crochet pattern stitch A around hem.

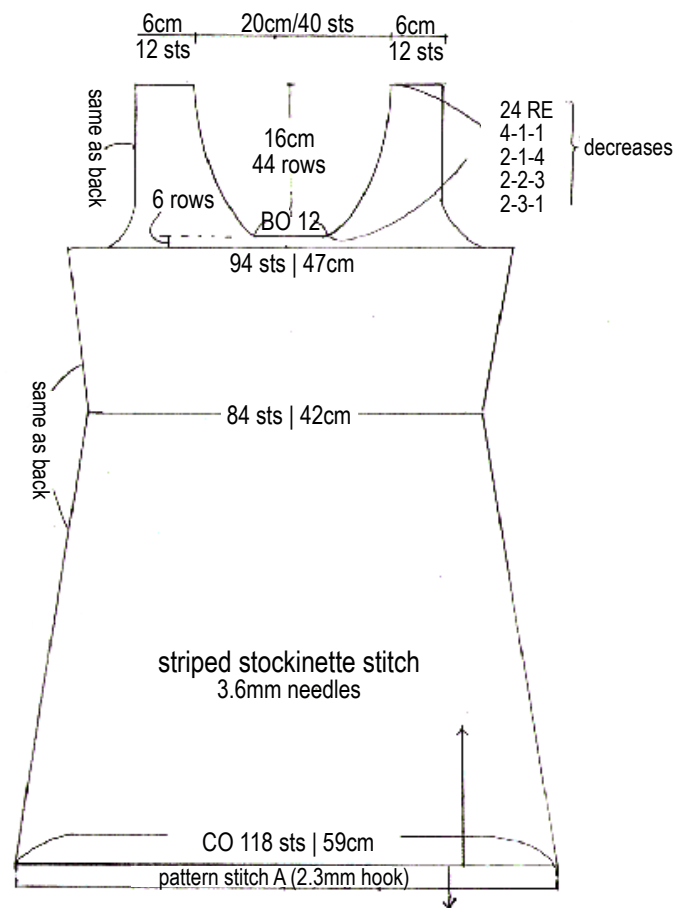
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
RE = row(s) even
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

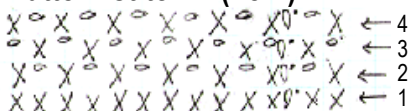

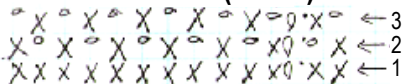
Color sequence {  = 8 rows mint green } 13-row repeat

Edging

Collar edging: pattern stitch B with mint green and 2.3mm hook.
