

# Warmth Gilet



## Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Warmth [68.3% wool, 31.7% nylon; 197 yds/180m per 1.23 oz./35g skein]; color #06 wine red, 3 skeins [90g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 4.5mm (US 7) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 4.0mm (US G) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- cross back width 33cm/12.99"
- length 59cm/23.23"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 16 sts and 24 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Knitting Tips

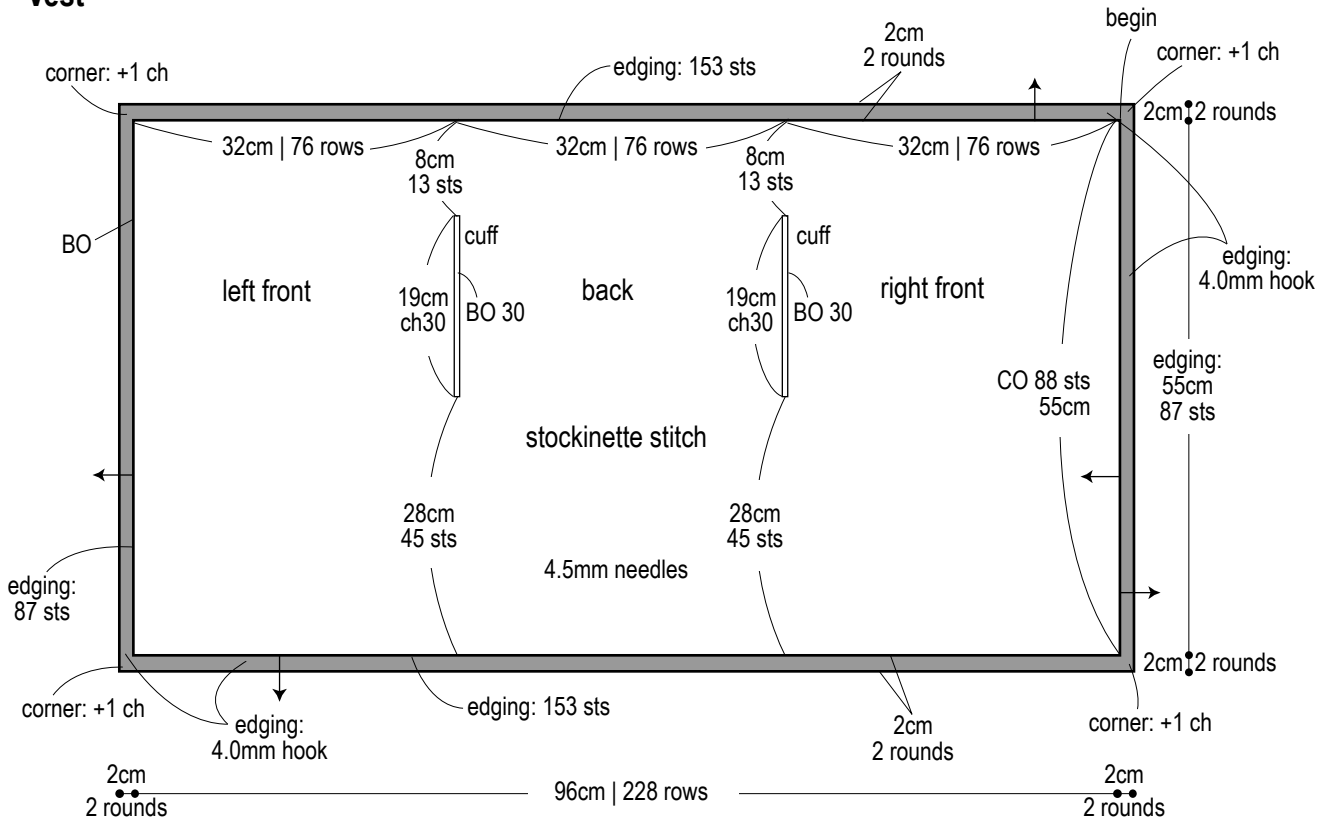
※Prior to starting, crochet 2 chains (30 sts each) with 4.0mm hook. These will be used for the cuffs later.

**Vest:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work 76 rows in stockinette stitch, up until holes for cuff. Knit another 76 rows, up until the second cuff area. Knit another 76 rows, then bind off in pattern. Work 1 round of single crochet edging around each cuff. Referring to schematic, work edging around entire outer edge of vest.

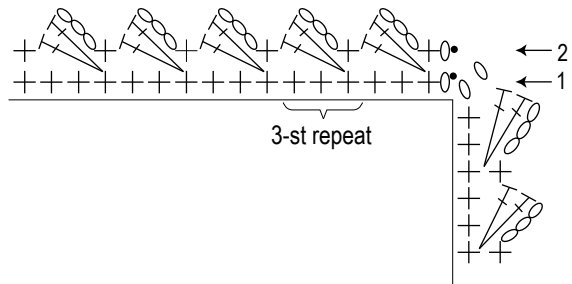
## Abbreviations:
