

212ss-27 Market Bag with Lace Appliqué



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Amian [100% washable Japanese paper; 94 yds/86m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #24 biscuit, 9 skeins [325g]
- Pierrot Yarns Fresco Lino Fine [100% linen; 164 yds/150m per 1.76 oz./50g skein]; color #109 sand beige, 2 skeins [100g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.0mm (approx. US B), 3.0mm (approx. US C or D), and 5.0mm (US H) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 piece lining fabric, 110cm/43.31" by 50cm/19.69"

Finished measurements:

- mouth of bag circumference 102cm/40.16"
- depth 27cm/10.63"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- single crochet (US): 12 sts and 13 rows
- half double crochet (US): 12 sts and 9 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

※Crochet bottom and body of bag with 2 strands of yarn held together. Crochet handles and lace motifs with 1 strand of yarn.

Bottom: Work chain to begin. Working first round into both sides of chain, work sc in the round, increasing as indicated.

Sides: Continuing from bottom, work slip stitch, then hdc in the round, increasing as indicated. Also work edging in the round.

Large and small lace motifs: Create magic ring, then work small and large motifs in the round following charts. Sew to sides of bag, keeping overall balance in mind.

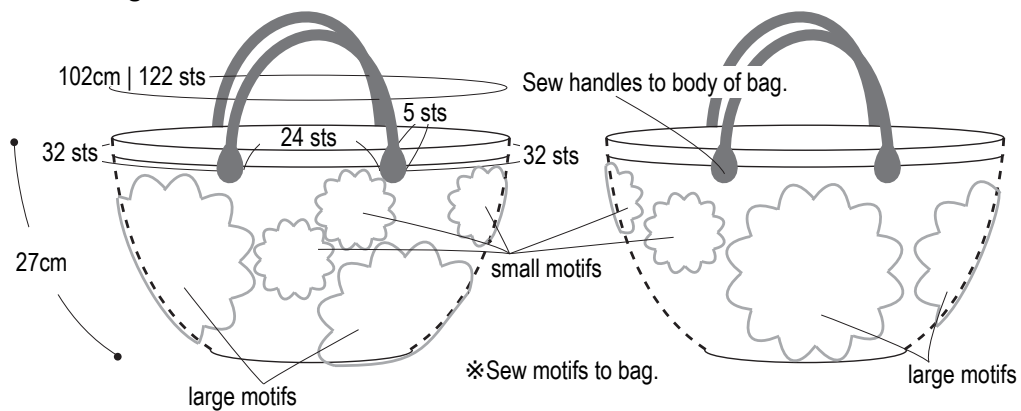
Handles: Work chain to begin. Work sc in the round, increasing as indicated. Fold each handle lengthwise as shown in schematic; whipstitch seam. Sew end of handles to bag as shown.

Lining: Sew lining, then sew to inside of the sides of the bag.

Abbreviations:

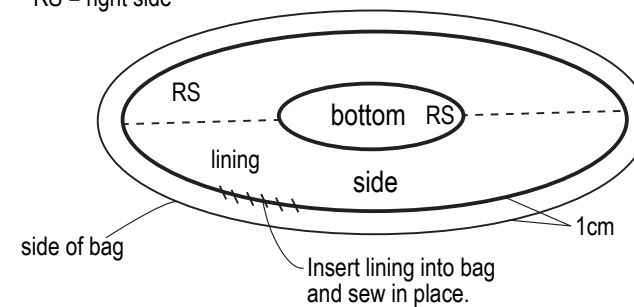
ch = chain
dc = double crochet (US)
hdc = half double crochet (US)
sc = single crochet (US)
WS = wrong side

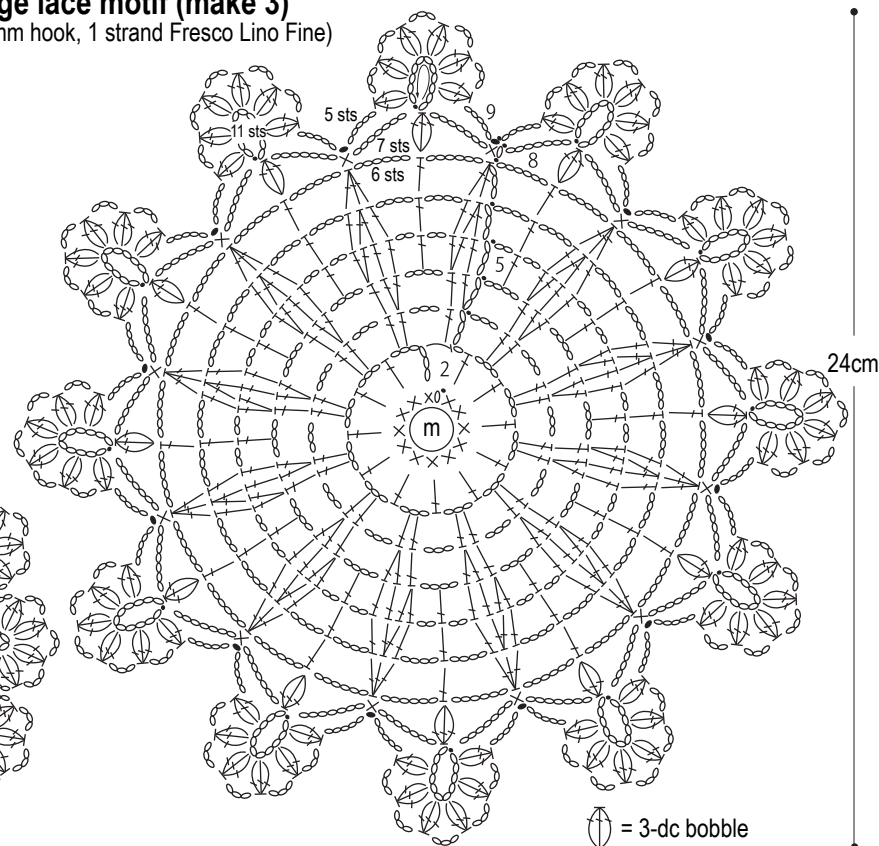
How to sew in lining

RS = right side



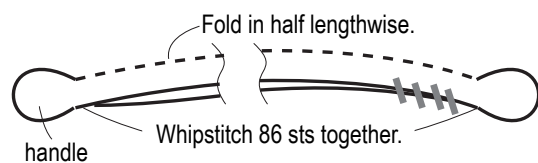
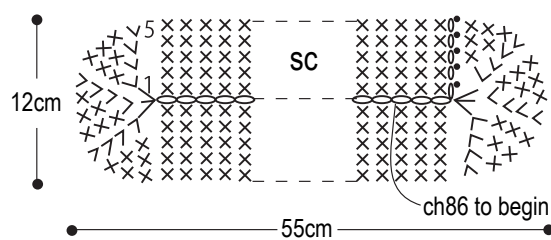
Large lace motif (make 3)

(2.0mm hook, 1 strand Fresco Lino Fine)



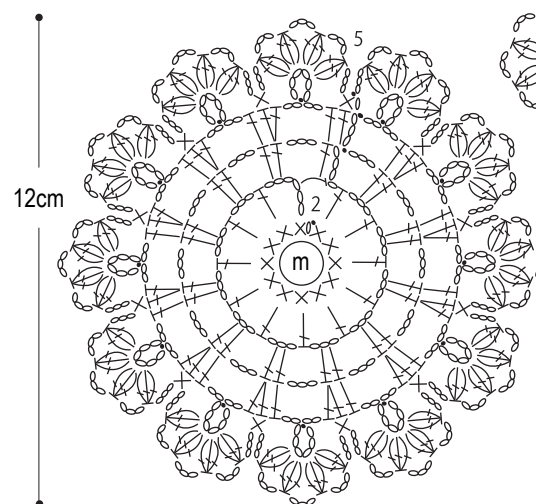
Handle (make 2)

(2.0mm hook, 1 strand Fresco Lino Fine)

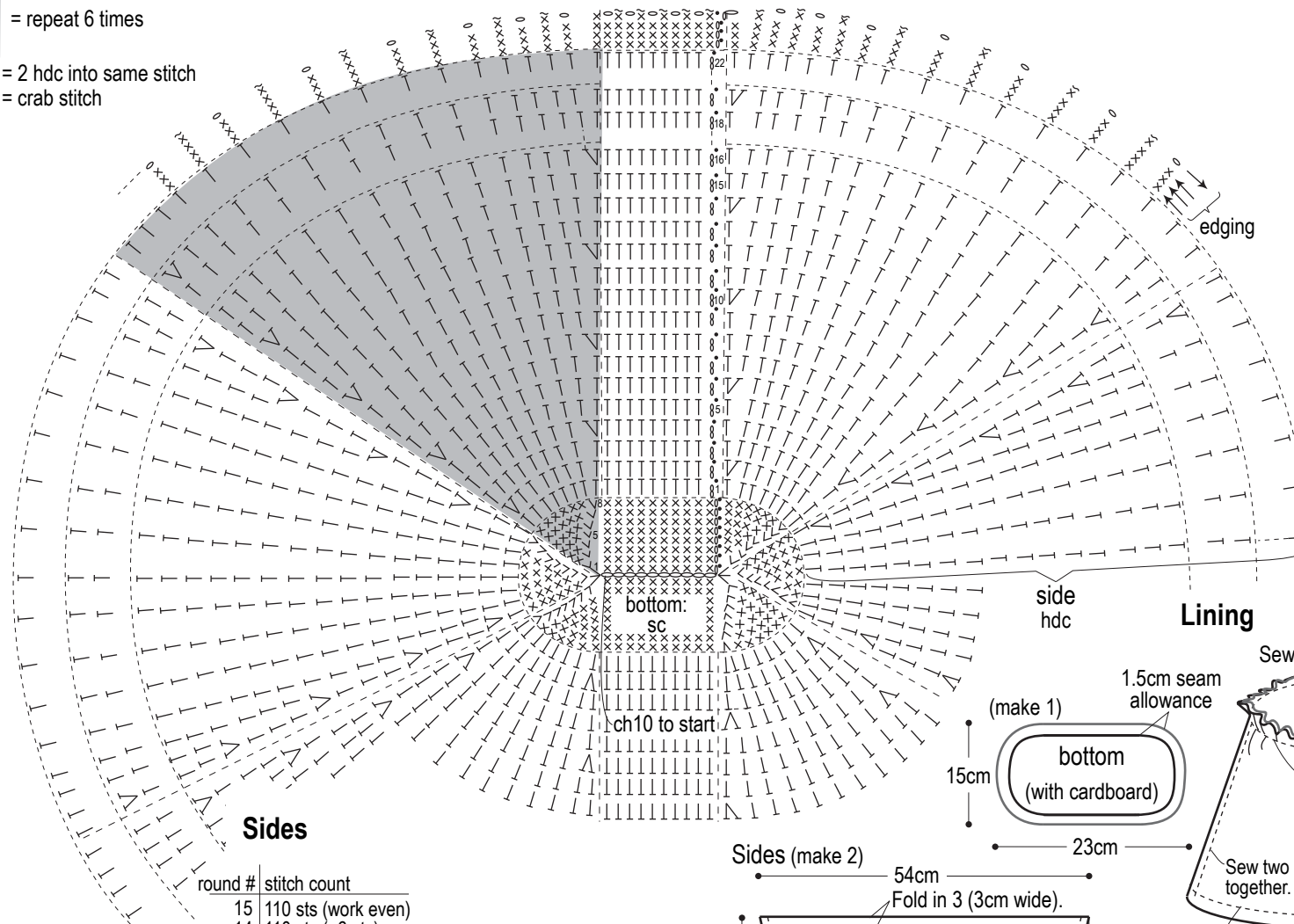


*On round 8 of large motif, ch11 after 3-dc bobble, then work slip stitch to close loop.

 ⌘ = crab stitch



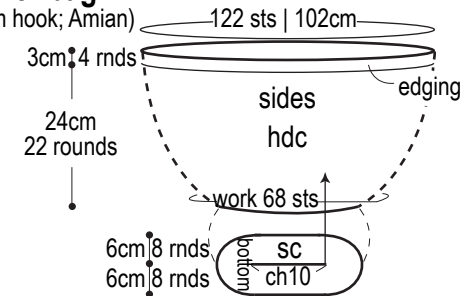

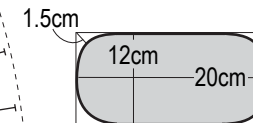

(5.0mm hook; Amian)

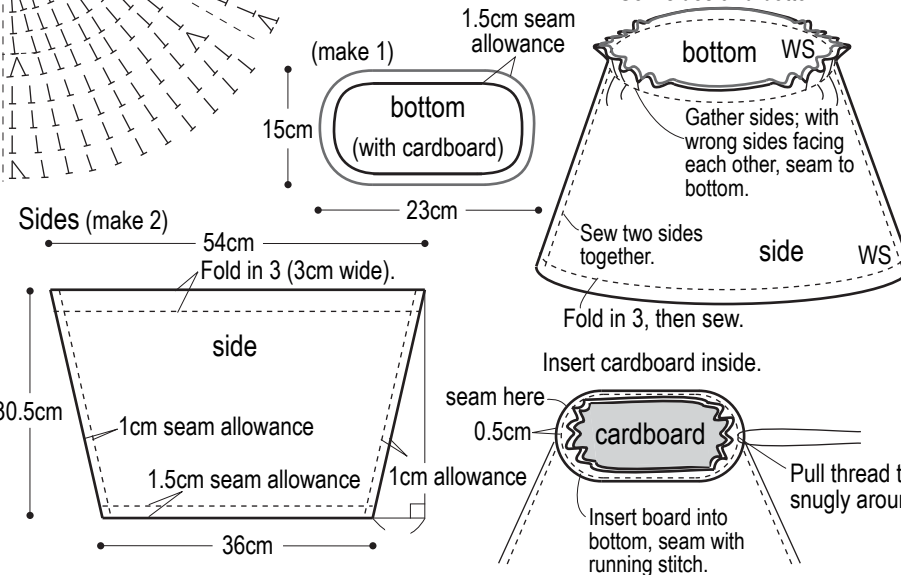


Cardboard bottom insert (make 1)



Lining

Sew sides and bottom.



Pull thread to draw fabric snugly around cardboard.
