

212ss-09 Lace Skirt



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Cotton Lace #20 [100% cotton; 170 yds/155m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #202 ivory, 9 skeins [350g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.0mm (US steel hook 4) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 67cm/26.38" length of waistband elastic (20mm/0.79" wide)

Finished measurements:

- waist 66cm/25.98"
- length 46.5cm/18.31"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitches A, B, D: 41.5 sts and 15 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Skirt: Begin skirt section A by working into bottom loops of chain, then working in pattern stitch A and pattern stitch B. Work sections B and C in pattern stitch A, decreasing in pattern stitch C and C', respectively, before each of these sections. Make 2 identical skirt pieces, then seam sides with chain seam.

Belt: Working stitches into edge of section C, work in pattern stitch D in the round. Continue to belt. Fold belt to inside, and tack down with whipstitch, inserting elastic as you seam.

Finishing: Work edging in the round along hem.



ch = chain


rep = repeat(s)

sc = single crochet (US)


Pattern stitch C (2.0mm hook)




Edging (2.0mm hook)




Belt




Pattern stitch C' (2.0mm hook)




Pattern stitch D and belt (2.0mm hook)




Skirt (2.0mm hook)
